

GETTING STARTED WITH TVP ANIMATION



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Welcome to TVP Animation! The software you're about to install is a powerful and unified environment for the creation of 2D animation. Combining real-time paint with animation tools into a single product, TVP Animation is the world's most powerful 2D animation and special effects software. From digital storyboarding and backgrounds, to pencil tests and inbetweening, to stunning final colored frames, TVP Animation provides the freedom and power to create anything you can imagine.

Important note: We recommend that you uninstall any previous versions of TVP Animation before beginning TVP Animation Installation. For instructions on how to do this, please see the Appendix at the end of this document.

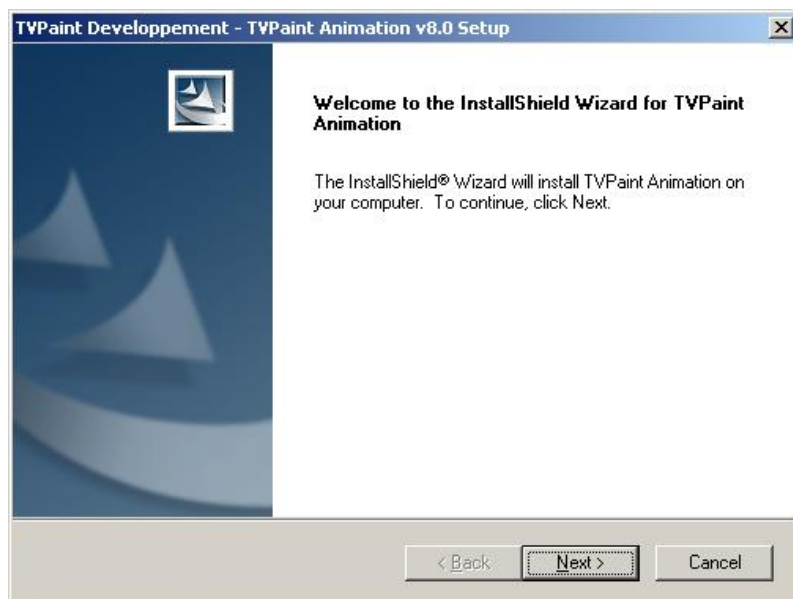
If you are already familiar with TVP Animation installation, please proceed directly to TVP Animation Licensing in Chapter 3.

Chapter 1: Installing TVP Animation v1.0 for Windows

Please ensure that you are running either Windows™ XP or Windows 2000. TVP Animation is not compatible with Windows NT4 or Windows ME systems.

From TVP Animation CD, double-click the *Install > PC > TVPaintAnimation_Installer.exe* installer program.

If you have downloaded the trial version of TVP Animation from the web, simply double-click the TVP Animation installer program.

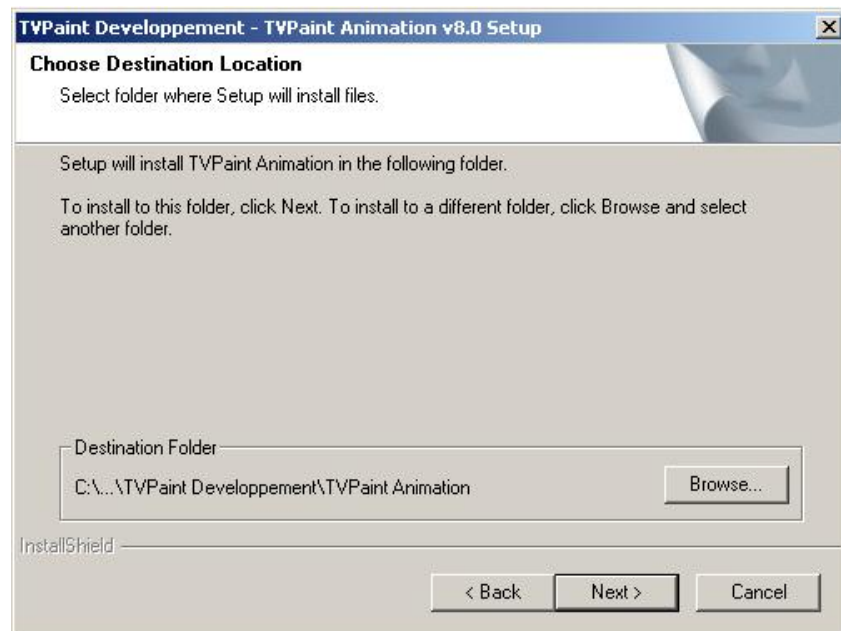


The TVP Animation installer will automatically start, and will prompt you with the above dialog. Click **Next** to continue.

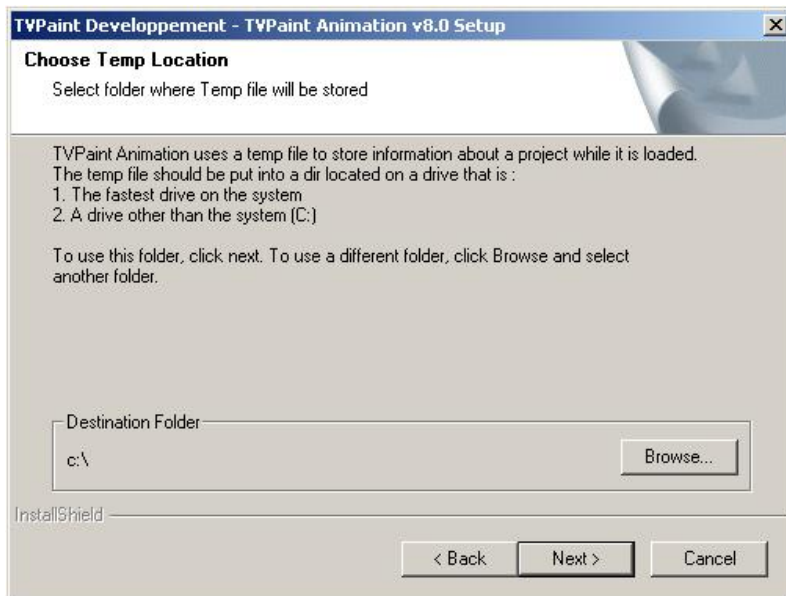
You will next be prompted to accept the standard TVP Animation End User License Agreement. Please read and accept the agreement by clicking on **Yes**.



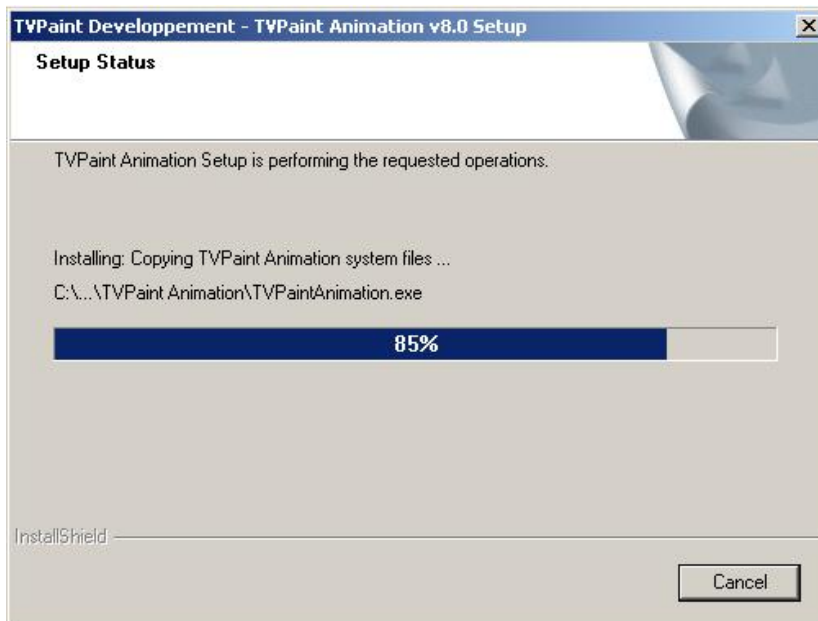
The TVP Animation installer will next ask you to confirm the installation path. By default, the system installs into the directory C:\Program Files\TVPaint Developpement\TVP Animation. If you wish to choose another place to install TVP Animation, click **Browse** and select an alternate directory.



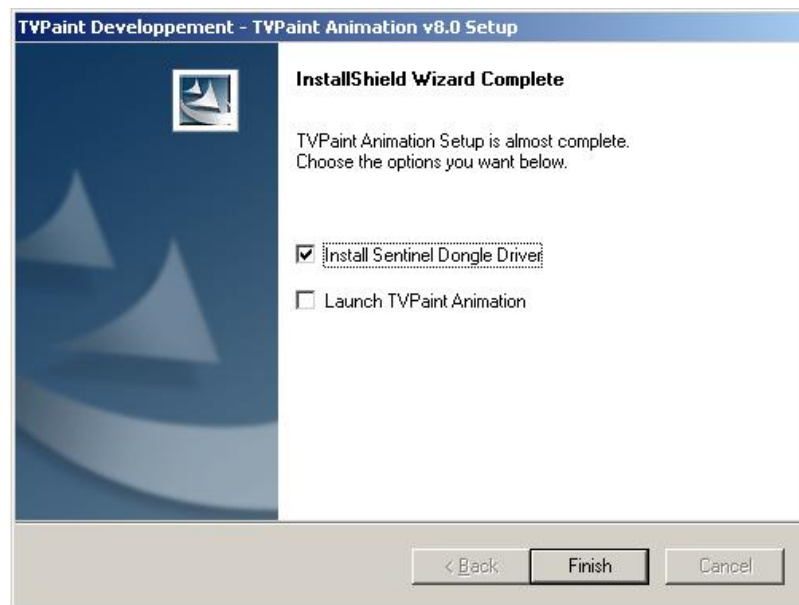
TVP Animation uses a temp file to store certain information about a project when it's loaded. In the install process, you will next be prompted to identify a place to put this temp file. Ideally, especially if you are working with large video files, this file should be placed on another disk, or an external disk array. To choose another disk or directory, click on **Browse** and select it.



If you do not have an alternate disk, simply select the default option, and click **Next**.



Once TVP Animation installed, you will be prompted with the following panel :



If you had previously installed TVP Animation, you *do not* need to re-install the sentinel driver. If that is the case, simply un-check the **Install Sentinel Driver** option, and click **Finish**. Otherwise, continue with the default options, to ensure the latest version of the Rainbow Sentinel driver is installed.

Installing the Sentinel Driver

If this is the first time you are running the TVP Animation installer, you need to install the Rainbow Sentinel USB dongle drivers on your system. This is done automatically at the end of the TVP Animation product installation. If you are unsure whether you have the driver installed, please continue with the driver installation



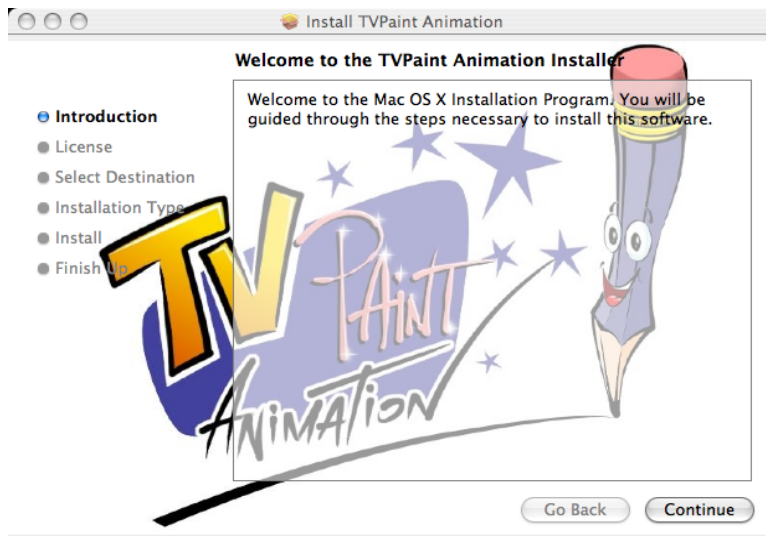
Note: please verify that you have unplugged your TVP Animation hardware key from your system before continuing

To install the driver, simply accept the default options.
This completes the TVP Animation v1.0 installation! A TVP Animation Icon, and also a link to the TVP Animation Reference Manual have been placed on your desktop.
Please now move on to Chapter 3 of this document for a step-by-step guide to licensing your new copy of TVP Animation.

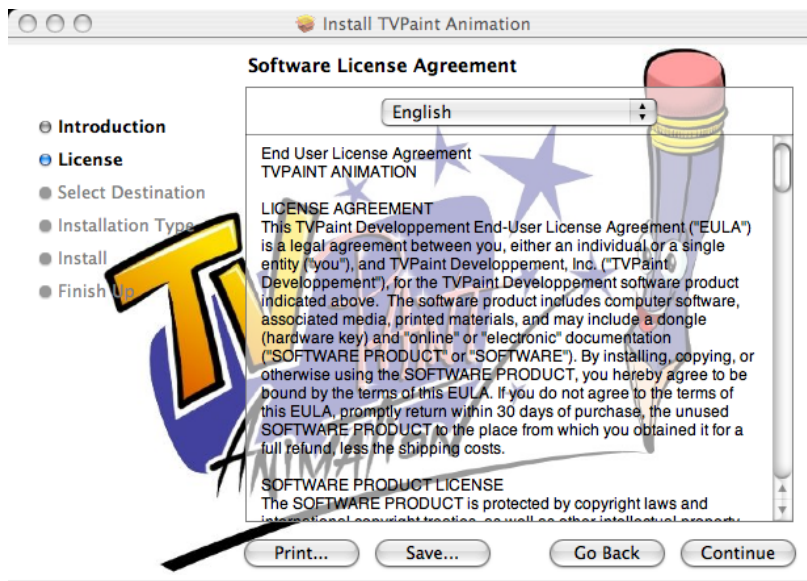
Chapter 2: Installing TVP Animation v1.0 for OS/X

Please ensure that you are running Apple OS X v10.3 or higher. TVP Animation is not compatible with earlier versions of OS/X, or with Mac OS 9.

From TVP Animation CD, double-click the *Install > Mac > TVPaintAnimation.pkg* installer file.

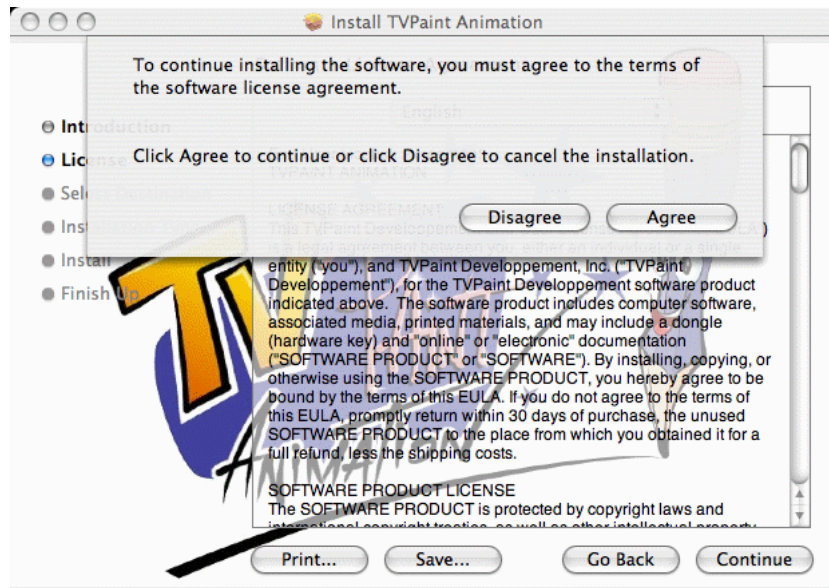


Once this is complete, double click the **TVP Animation.pkg** file on the desktop to install TVP Animation. (Note: If you have downloaded the trial version of TVP Animation from the web, double-click the compressed **.TGZ** compressed file to decompress it, and double-click the resulting **.PKG** installation file.)



Please note that if you're running the software on OS X 10.3, you will have to use Stuffit Expander 10 freely available at the following address : <http://www.stuffit.com/mac/expander/>

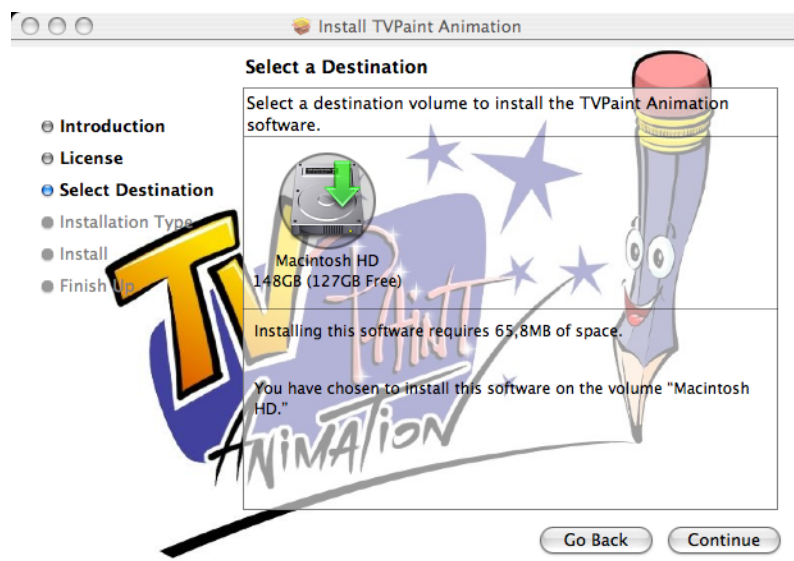
The TVP Animation installer will automatically start, and will prompt you with the above dialog. Click **Continue** to continue. You will next be prompted to accept the standard TVP Animation End User License Agreement.



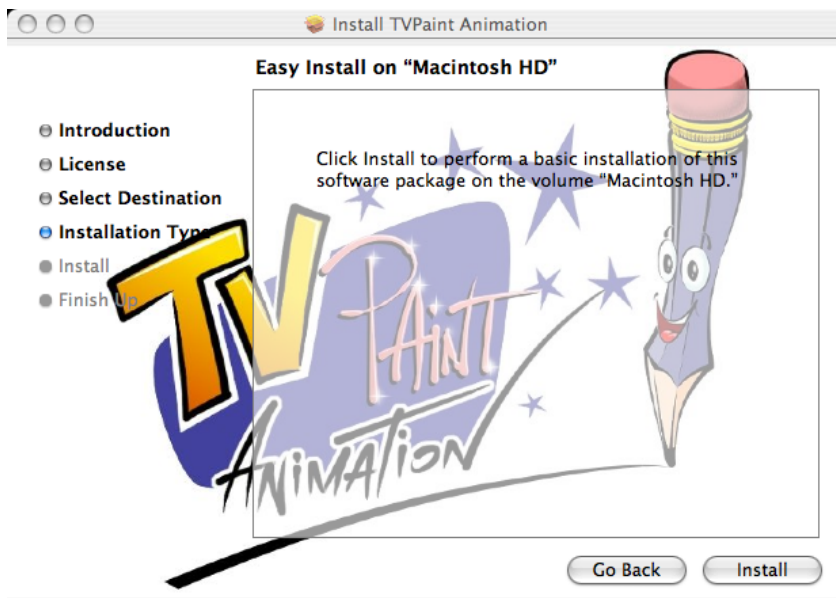
Please read and accept the agreement by clicking **Continue**, and then on **Agree**:



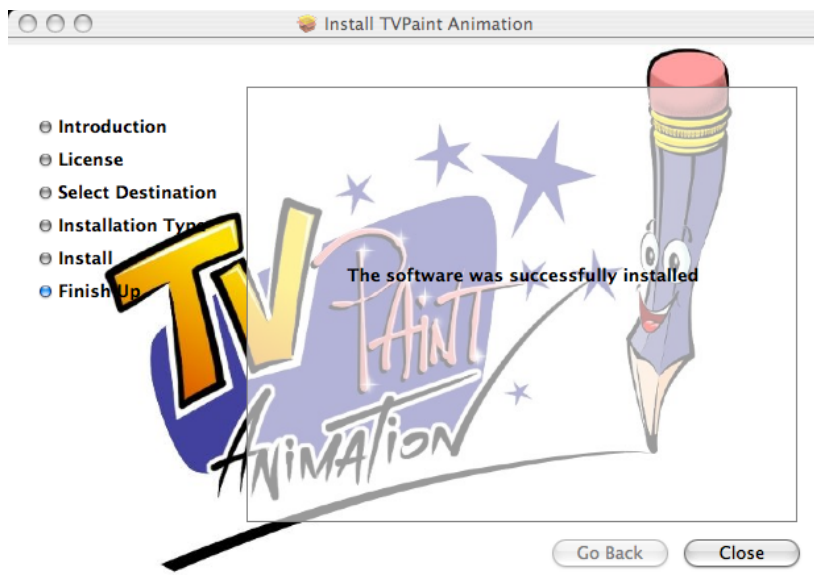
The TVP Animation installer will next ask you to confirm the disk upon which TVP Animation will be installed. Click on the picture of the destination disk of your choice. By default, the system installs TVP Animation – and the associated documentation - into the OS X Applications folder. If you wish to choose another place to install TVP Animation, click **Choose** and select an alternate directory.



Click **Continue** to continue with the installation. The TVP Animation installer will then prompt you to install the software.



Click on **Install** to install TVP Animation. After installation is complete, click on **Close** to close the dialog box.

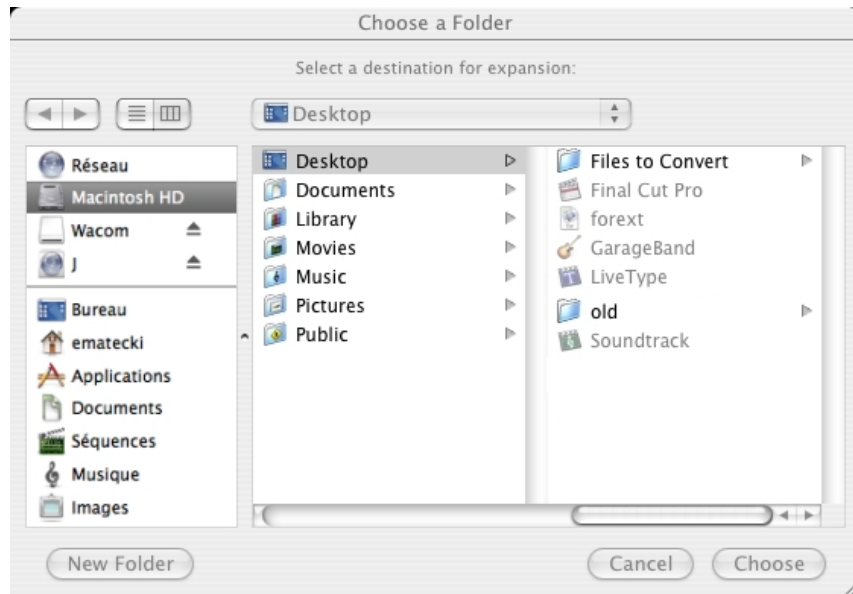


Installing the Sentinel Drivers

The next step in TVP Animation installation is to install the SafeNet Sentinel USB hardware key drivers on your Mac. These drivers allow TVP Animation to work with your USB hardware key ("Dongle").

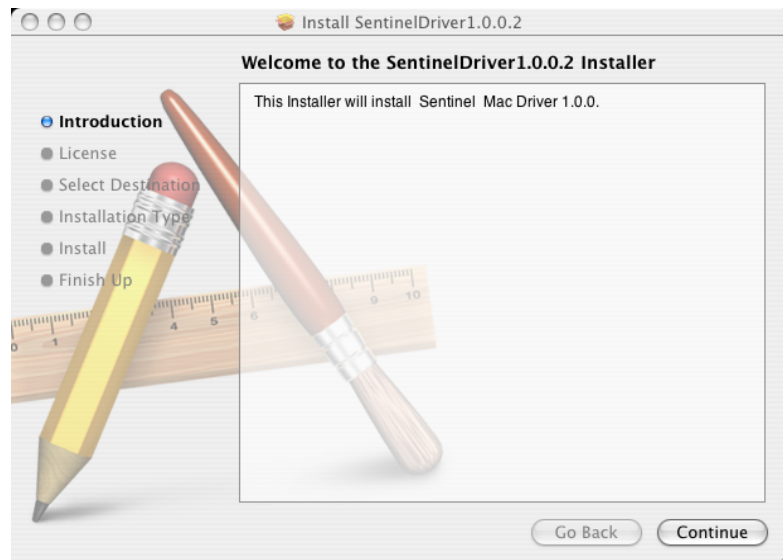
Important: before continuing, please verify that you have unplugged your TVP Animation hardware key from your system.

Please click on “Install OS X Sentinel Driver” from the interactive TVP Animation CD Startup menu. You will be prompted for a location for the extracted **SentinelDriver1.0.0.2.pkg** installer file. We recommend simply choosing your desktop folder:



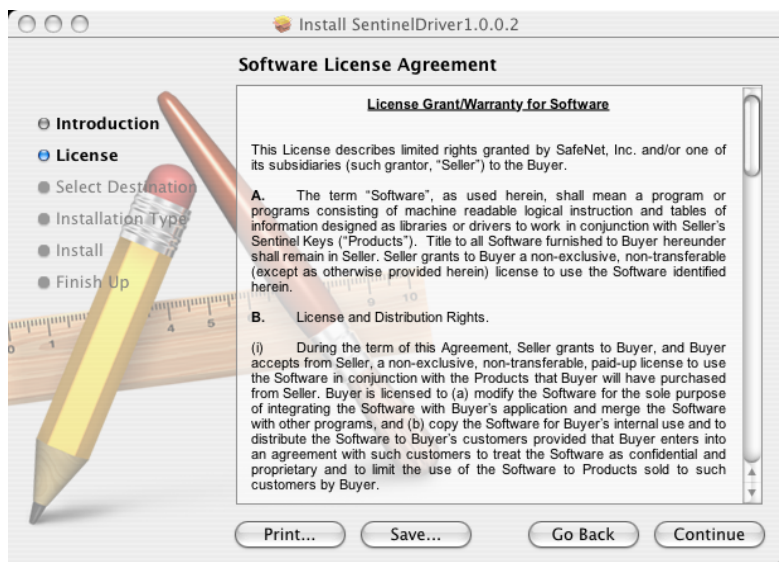
Double click **SentinelDriver 1.0.0.2.pkg** to begin the installation

You will next be prompted with the following dialog:



Click **Continue** again.

You'll now be prompted with the SafeNet License Agreement :

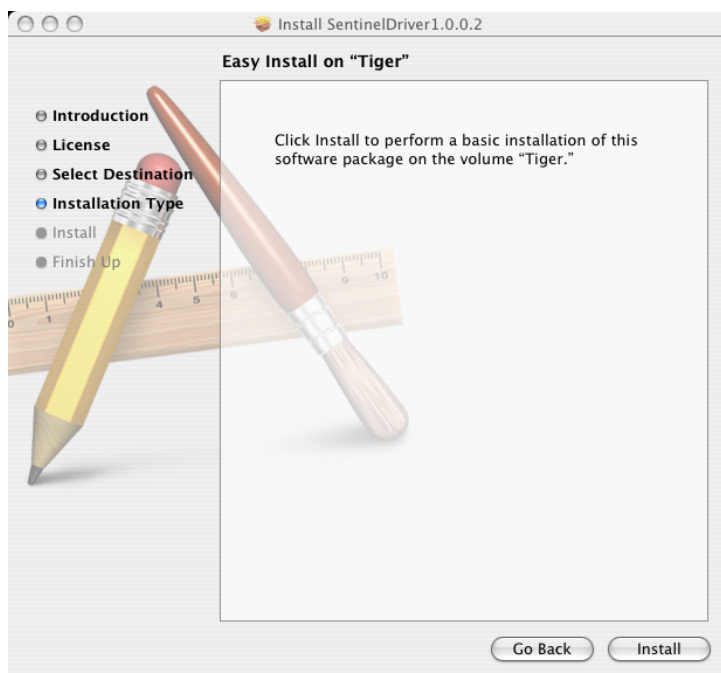


Click **Continue** again, and then **Agree** (if you) accept the terms of the license.



The Rainbow installer will next ask you to confirm the disk upon which the Sentinel drivers should be installed. Make certain to select your Startup or Primary Disk.

Click **Continue**. Next, click **Install** to begin software installation.



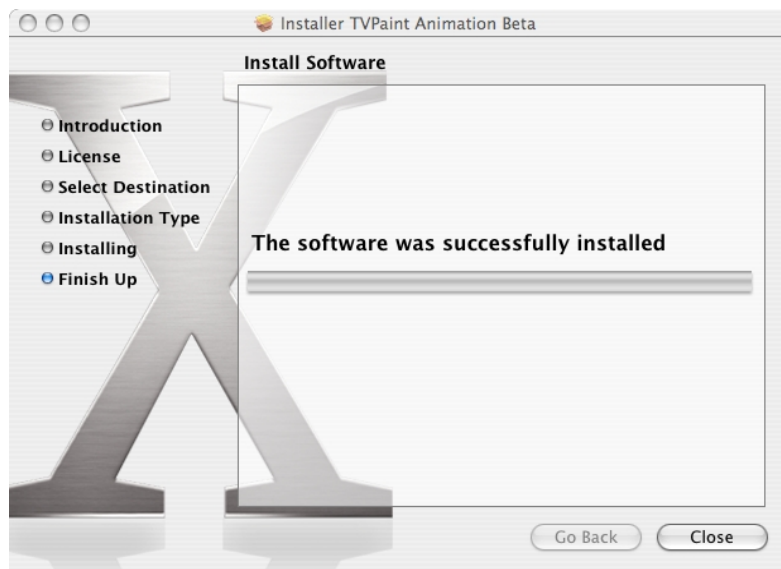
The installer may prompt you for your password, to ensure you have administrative access.



Type in your password. If you do not know your password, do not have administrative access, or for further information about logging into an administrator account, please consult your system administrator, or your OS X documentation.



Select **Continue Installation** to finish the installation.



Please now move on to Chapter 3 (Below) for a step-by-step guide to licensing your new copy of TVP Animation.

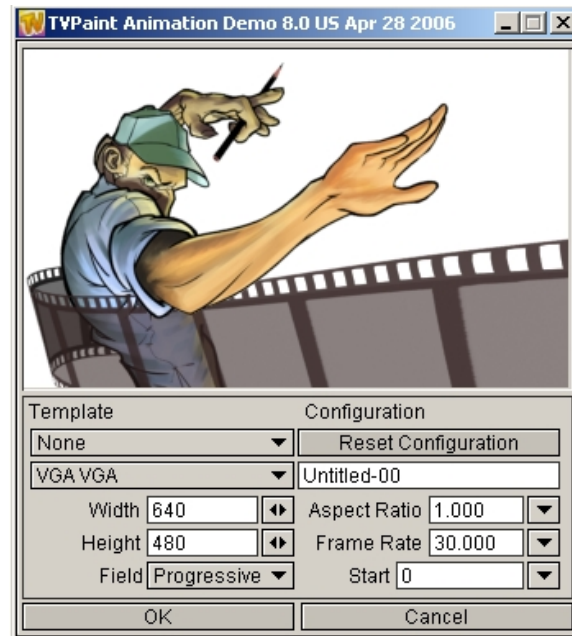
Chapter 3: Licensing TVP Animation (Windows & OS X)

In this Chapter, we'll get your copy of TVP Animation licensed and running.

To start, plug your TVP Animation USB hardware key to one of the USB ports on the back of your system, or into an available USB port on your Apple Keyboard.

(If you are running on a Macintosh, choose **Restart** under the Apple menu to restart your system at this point).

Once you've re-started, and are back to the desktop, you're ready to start working with TVP Animation. Double click the TVP Animation Icon from the link on the desktop (Windows) or from the Applications folder (Mac) on your desktop to run the program. You can also drag-drop the TVP Animation Application onto the OS X dock, for easy access.

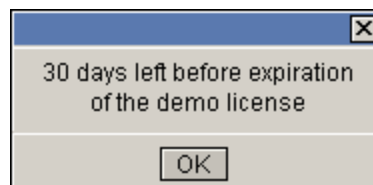


As TVP Animation starts up, you will be prompted with the above Configuration dialog; just click **OK** for now. (Please consult the TVP Animation Reference Manual for further information about the options present in this dialog)

If you have purchased TVP Animation, and have your Hardware Key in-hand, please skip the next Chapter (TVP Animation Demonstration Mode) and go straight to the Chapter on licensing (further below).

TVP Animation Demonstration Mode

If you have not yet purchased TVP Animation, the software will automatically grant you a 30-day 'demonstration' license to evaluate the software.



To purchase the software, download tutorials, or just visit the TVPaint website, at any time you can click on the following button in TVP Animation interface, which will launch a web browser and bring you directly to the TVPaint Website.



Please note that each time you start TVP Animation for the 30-day period, you will be informed of the number of days left in your trial period.

Licensing TVP Animation

When you have purchased TVP Animation, and are ready to license TVP Animation permanently, please first ensure that the TVP Animation hardware key is attached to your system, on one of the USB ports. Please also ensure that you have *rebooted* your system if you just installed the Sentinel hardware key drivers.

Run TVP Animation, and you will be prompted with the following dialog:



Please note the LOCK CODE present at the top of the dialog. You need to submit this LOCK CODE to TVPaint, in order to receive an UNLOCK CODE.

As prompted, please click on the words **CLICK HERE** directly in the dialog box to automatically open a browser on your system (Windows and OS X), which will automatically link to the TVPaint registration page on the Internet:

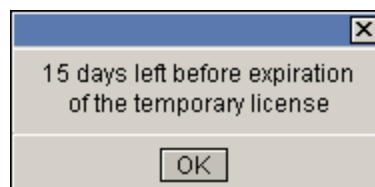

Your Unlock code will be sent to the email address you typed above.

Please enter all required information, and click **Request Unlock Code**. Your Unlock Code will be sent to you via email.

Alternately, you may email or fax the required information (Name, Company, Address, Telephone, Email, LOCK CODE, and Dongle Serial Number) to TVPaint. All information is required for TVPaint to provide you with an Unlock Code.

Since you already have a your hardware key attached, however, while awaiting your final Unlock code, for now please click on the **Later** button. This will allow you to run TVP Animation for up to 15 days (with no restrictions) or until you have received your Unlock Code:



When you have received your product unlock code, simply run TVP Animation again, provide your user name, organization name, and the Unlock Code, and click **Register**. TVP Animation will then be registered, and permanent.

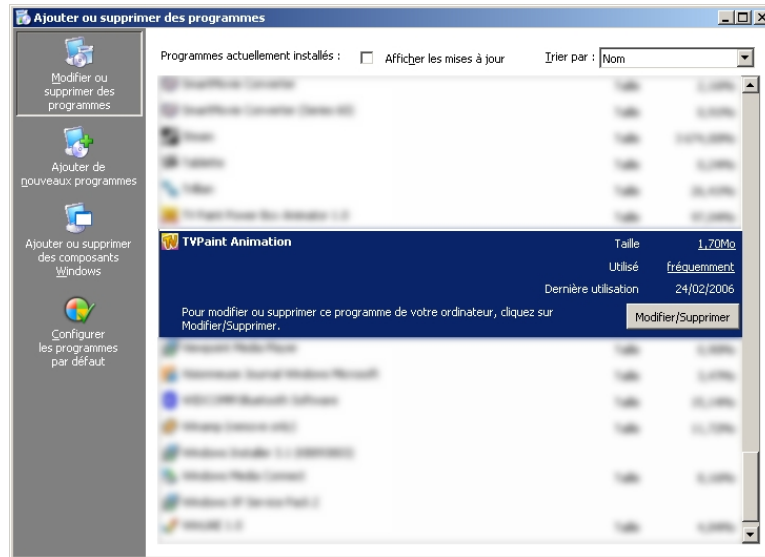

Appendix : Removing Earlier Versions of TVP Animation

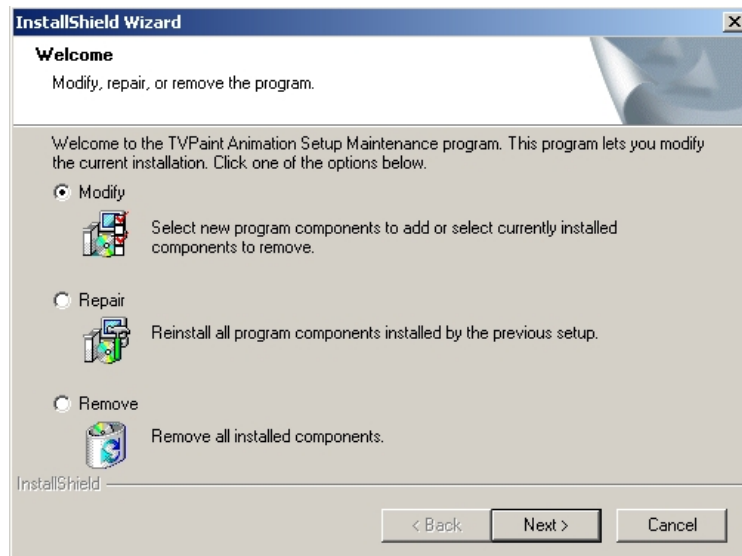
TVP Animation for Windows

Please note that if you have a previously-installed version of TVP Animation, it is very important that you uninstall it first.

To do this, in the Windows control panel, go to the “Add or Remove Programs” panel, select TVP Animation, and press the “Change/Remove” button:



This will offer you a variety of options. Select the bottom-most option, “Remove”. This will remove TVP Animation entirely from your system.



You're now ready to install TVP Animation v1.0!

TVP Animation for OS X

To uninstall TVP Animation for OS X Simply drag the TVP Animation icon (or the TVP Animation Folder, if there is one) from the Applications Directory into the Trash.

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
