Getting Started:

Fill out the Registration Card and return it to Inline Design. We use our database to inform our customers of upgrades and new games. We may even send you a newsletter once in a while.

Copy the Tesseract application to your hard disk. While Tesseract can be played from the floppy disk, for better performance we suggest you run the game only from your hard disk. Never play the game from the original disk!

Double click on the Tesseract application. Notice that there is no copy protection. There is no quiz. You do not have to name all 50 states to begin. (Well, OK. What are the 50 states?)

You will find the instructions for playing Tesseract in the game itself. You might want to go through this on-line manual before beginning. Access the instructions either by clicking the **Instructions** button on the title screen, or by selecting **Instructions...** from the **Apple** menu.

Tesseract requires at least System version 6.02 to run properly. Nevertheless, we strongly urge you to consider running System version 6.05 or higher as there have been countless improvements to the System software. Tesseract is fully compatible with System 7.0.

If you encounter problems, you are probably running the DiskLight INIT from the Norton Utilities package. The only solution is to remove the DiskLight INIT from your System Folder and restart. We have notified Norton about the problem and they should be fixing it as you read this.

To move the Tesseract window, simply place your cursor at the top of the window. The cursor will change to a hand. You can then drag the window anywhere you like. The **Center Window** command in the **Option** menu will return the Tesseract window to its front and center location.

Support:
