A Note to Users With Low Density Disk Drives

As the Victory Pak was provided on high density diskettes, users with systems which require the game to be in low density diskette format (typically Plus and SE models) may exchange their diskettes for a low density version of the game by sending in their original diskettes to the following address:

Installing the Victory Pak

Note to owners of V for Victory: Gold • Juno • Sword: If you own Gold • Juno • Sword, please be careful not to install your Victory Pak files into the same folder as where you keep your Gold • Juno • Sword files. After installing the Victory Pak, please read the section entitled, "Combining the Victory Pak and GJS." This section will give you directions on how to combine these two products and play them under one folder.

Your Victory Pak game box should contain three diskettes (Disk 1, Disk 2, and Disk 3). Insert the diskette labeled "Disk 1" into your disk drive and double click upon the diskette icon. You should see a file entitled "Victory Pak Installer."

Double click upon this file. At this point you will be presented with a couple of introduction screens. Press the "Continue" button to move through these screens.

You will now be prompted by a dialog box asking you where you wish to install the contents of your Victory Pak files. You should first click on the **Desktop** button, followed by the **Save** button.

After you click on the Save button, the installation program will prompt you to insert your Victory Pak diskettes as needed. Please follow the on-screen prompts until installation is complete.

Starting V for Victory

After installation is complete, you may start V for Victory by entering your new V for Victory 3.11 folder and double clicking upon the file icon entitled, "V for Victory 3.11 non-FPU." Or, if your Macintosh has a math co-processor, you

may double click upon the file icon entitled, "V for Victory 3.11 FPU." The FPU version of V for Victory is specially designed to take advantage of a floating point unit (math co-processor) and will subsequently run faster than the non-FPU version of the game.

Combining the Victory Pak and GJS

If you own V for Victory: Gold • Juno • Sword, or purchase it in the future, please use the following instructions to combine the Victory Pak and GJS:

First, follow the instructions for installing Gold • Juno • Sword (the section in your Gold • Juno • Sword Installation and Information Guide entitled, "Installing V for Victory: Gold • Juno • Sword.") You should ignore the section in this guide entitled, "Playing Previous Game Sets Under GJS" as well as the yellow insert entitled, "Attention Utah Beach, Velikiye Luki, and Market Garden Owners."

Next, enter your "V for Victory 3.11" folder (or whatever the main folder is that you installed your Victory Pak files into). In this folder you will see three folders entitled, "Utah Beach", "Velikiye Luki", and "Market Garden." Move each of these folders into your "V for Victory 4.0" folder (or "V for Victory 4.01" folder, whatever the case may be). To move these folders, simply single click on each one, and then drag them into your "V for Victory 4.0" folder.

After you have finished moving these folders, you should start your Gold • Juno • Sword game. At the start up screen, the buttons, "Utah Beach", "Velikiye Luki", and "Market Garden" should all be active. If this is the case, you may throw away the rest of your Victory Pak files as you will not have further need of them.
