

Player's Reference Guide

Macintosh Version

Introduction

This Reference Guide provides Apple Macintosh specific information not found in the *Wayne Gretzky Hockey* User's Guide. Please read the User's Guide; it provides valuable information for playing *WGH*. You may also disregard occasional references to MDOS in the User's Manual, as *WGH* takes full advantage of the Macintosh operating system.

Program Requirements

✓ Hard Disk Required

Due to the large size of the program, *WGH* should be installed and played from a hard disk. Playing from floppy disks is not recommended and the disks do not include a System Folder.

Installing

Wayne Gretzky Hockey™



Before installing *WGH*, make a backup of your disks or write-protect the disks.

✓ Hard Disk Installation

Copy *WGH* to hard disk as follows:

- ❶ Create a folder and name it **Wayne Gretzky Hockey**
- ❷ Insert the first *WGH* disk into the internal floppy drive and drag all of the files and folders into the Wayne Gretzky Hockey Folder.
- ❸ Repeat this procedure for the remaining disk (two disks for Color version).

After you have completed copying the program, you should have the following files in the *Wayne Gretzky Hockey* Folder:

- *Gretzky Hockey* Application
- Teams Folder
- Images Folder

Note: *WGH* requires the teams and images folders to be in the same folder as the application.

Starting WGH

Start *WGH* by double clicking on the application, or select the application and choose "Open" from the File menu. When starting, *WGH* looks in the same folder as the application for the "Teams" and "Images" folders. If either of these folders are missing, the program then searches for a floppy disk named *WGH*. If this disk is unavailable, or if it does not contain both the "Teams" and "Images" folders, an error message is displayed indicating which folders were not found. Select "Quit" to return to the finder and install the missing files/folders.

If the program has been installed correctly, a passcode screen with several figures of hockey players appears, along with a page number. Click on the hockey player that most closely matches the player image on the indicated page in the User's Guide. If successful, you will then be placed in the Game Setup Menu. Appendix A in the *Wayne Gretzky Hockey* User's Guide contains instructions for playing *WGH* immediately.

Game Setup

✓ Editing the Roster

When in the Edit Team Menu, click on an item to select it. When items in a column are selected, that column name will be highlighted.

✓ Changing Player Ratings

Select the rating and type in a new value. The new value will replace the current value. You can also select the rating by pressing the "up" or "down" arrow keys to increase or decrease the values. Do not alter Player numbers during games or game statistics will be incorrect.

✓ Changing a Player's Name

Select any player and type in the new name. The name you type replaces the current name. If you leave the name field blank, the original contents of that field will be restored.

✓ Changing Team Color

Color version only—Select "Edit Colors" in the Game Setup Menu. A dialogue box appears showing both teams, default jersey colors and 14 color selection blocks. Select the team you wish to change, then select the new jersey color by clicking on the appropriate color block. Team jerseys will change to the selected color. Repeat this process for the other team.

Game Control Options

✓ Controlling a Player

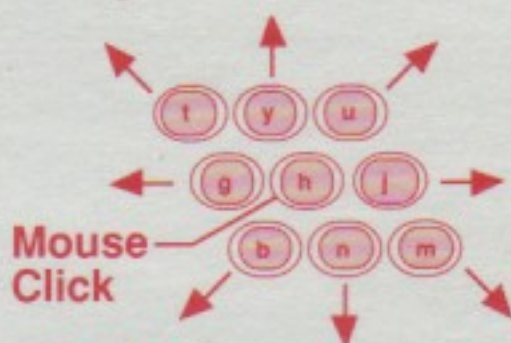
Controller type is chosen from the Game Setup Menu. You can control a player using either the **mouse** or the **keyboard**. In Two Player mode, one player must use the mouse while the other uses the keyboard.

If you choose **keyboard** from the Game Setup Menu, a dialogue box asks you to select the game control keys. You have three choices:

- Keyboard
- Arrow Keys
- Numeric Keypad

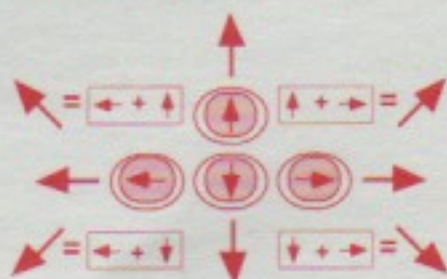
Keyboard

Pressing the designated keys will cause the controlled player to move in the following directions:



Arrow Keys

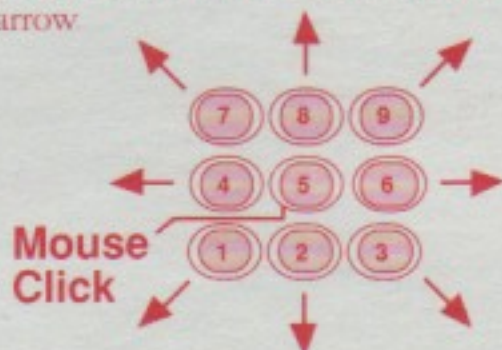
Pressing a designated key, or combination of keys, causes the player to move in the direction of the arrows.



Mouse Click = Press the Space Bar

Numeric Keypad

Pressing a designated key causes the player to move in the direction of the arrow

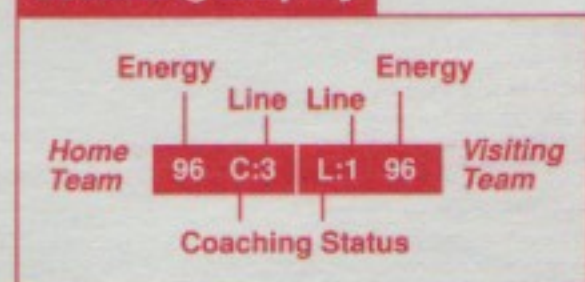
When you choose **Mouse** from the Game Setup Menu, the controlled (white/clear helmeted) player follows a cursor on the screen. Pressing the mouse button passes, checks, or shoots. [See Section 3 in the User's Guide]

Note: In Two Player games, Player 2 will have only the "white/clear" helmet as an indication of the controlled player.

✓ Coaching Controls

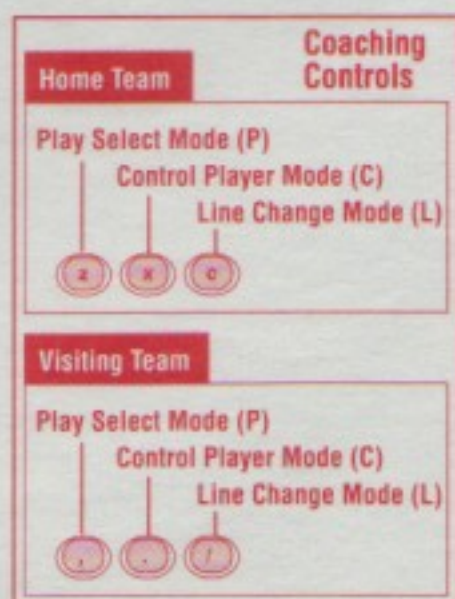
The Status Display is centered in the lower portion of the rink. The Coaching modes are: **P** (Play Select), **L** (Line Select), and **C** (Control Player).

Coaching Display



When penalties occur, penalty clocks are displayed on either side of the Coaching Display.

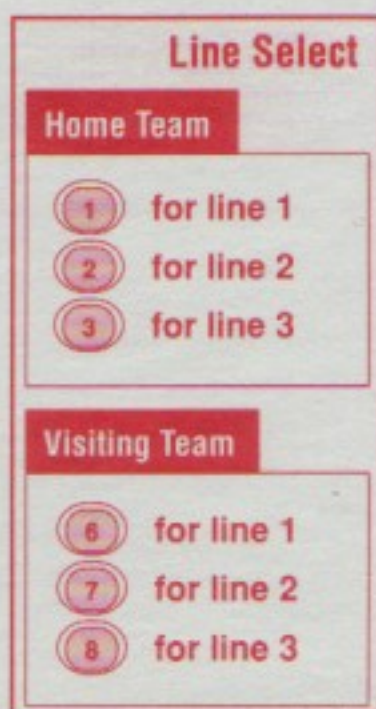
Coach or **Coach & Play** Mode must be selected in the Game Setup Menu to enable the following keys:



Use the following keys to select plays when in Play Select mode (**P**)



Use the keys below to select a line, when in Line Select mode (**L**).



Use the keys to the right to select a Player when in Control Player Mode (C).

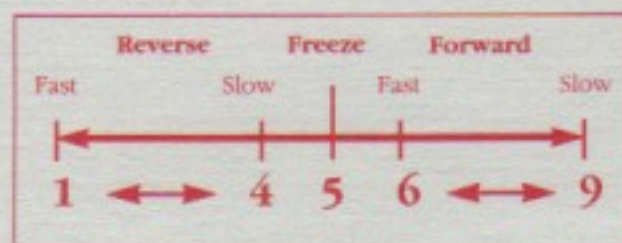
✓ Pulling the Goalie

Use the following keys to pull a goalie.

✓ Instant Replay

Exiting to the Timeout Menu and selecting Instant Replay allows you to replay the action. You can view the action in forward or reverse at various speeds. Pressing 5 freezes the action.



Miscellaneous Options

✓ Timeout menu

Typing ⌘-T while the game is in play brings up the Timeout Menu.

✓ Sound On/Off

Typing ⌘-S during the game toggles the sound on and off. When the sound is on, a box with a musical note is displayed in the upper spectator section of the rink.

✓ Here-Comes-the-Boss Display

Type ⌘-B while the game is playing to kill the sound and put up a spreadsheet window. Click the mouse to resume play.

✓ Moving the Window

When the Timeout Menu is displayed, you may reposition the game window. If running under Multifinder, you may also switch to another application from the Time Out Menu. You cannot switch applications while the game is playing.

✓ Quick Exit

Type ⌘-Q to quit the game quickly



This use of this option will not allow you to Save the current game.

✓ Pause

Pause the game by typing ⌘-P. Typing ⌘-P again will resume the game.

✓ Face off

Type ⌘-F while the game is playing to initiate a face off. The Timeout Menu will appear and when you return to the game, the teams will face off.
