

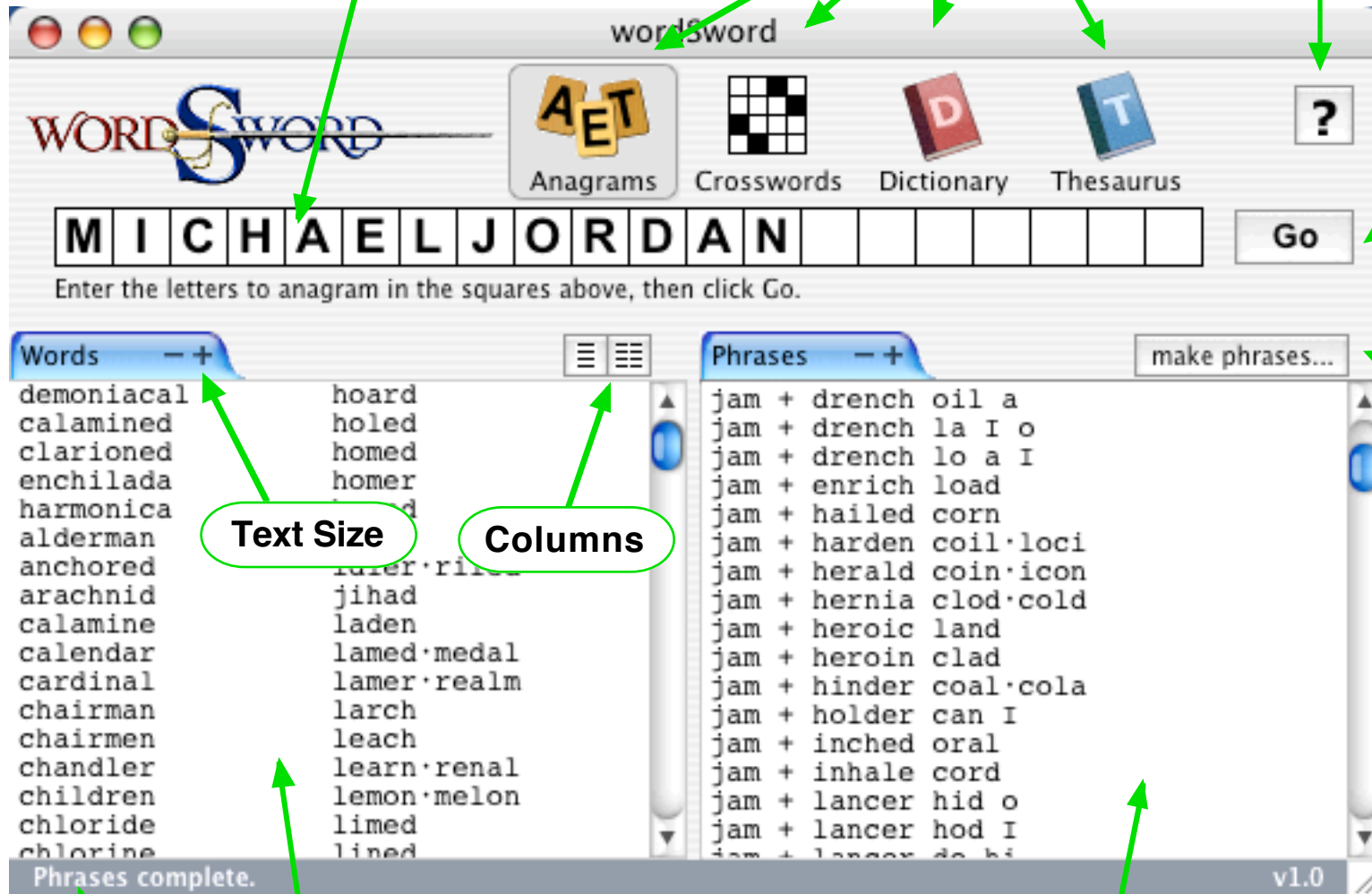

Instructions

Welcome to wordSword

There are four different “Modes” in wordSword:

- Anagrams

In Anagrams mode, you can search for jumbled words, find words within other words, or try to find ways to rearrange words or phrases into other words or phrases.

- Crosswords

In Crosswords mode, you can search for patterns of letters, such as six-letter words which start with “Z” and end with “R”.

- Dictionary

In Dictionary mode, you can look up word definitions.

- Thesaurus

In Thesaurus mode, you can find synonyms.

Special Notes

- Words which are spelled with exactly the same letters are grouped in Anagrams mode. For example, catering•creating•reacting. This makes it easier to spot anagram phrases than listing out all the combinations separately.

- In Anagrams mode, you can use a question mark “?” to represent any letter (a wildcard). For example, RSTDAEI? would find “asteroid,” “disaster” and “strained”.

- Double-click an anagrams word to get its definition.

- In Crosswords mode, when in Expert Text Entry (from the Options menu), you may use the following wildcards:

- * The asterisk will match any number of letters. For example, “*a*b*c*d*” will find “abdicated”.

- + The plus sign works in a similar way, but it must find at least one letter to be a match. So, “*a+b+c+d*” will not find “abdicated,” but it will find “roadblocked”.

- Finding anagram phrases is a very computer-intensive task. The program allows you to require that phrases include one or more words and to restrict phrases with many small words. These options can help the speed of phrase generation.
