

- Click inside the video frame to pause/re-start the clip.
- Drag the button at the bottom of the video frame to fast forward or rewind.

Passenger Log

- Click the bottom right-hand corner to advance a page.
- Click the bottom left-hand corner to go to the previous page.
- Click the name or picture of the character to view that passenger file.
- Click the arrow at the bottom right to see more history.
- Click "scenes" for scene list.
- Pause a scene by clicking inside the video frame.
- Click "history" to view history.
- Click the red bookmark at the center of the log to return to the passenger directory.



Installation

Windows 95 Users:

1. Insert the *Total Titanic: A Night to Remember* disc into your CD-ROM drive.
2. Click Start, then select Run from the menu.
3. Type your CD-ROM drive letter and type :\setup. For example, type d:\setup if your CD-ROM drive letter is D.
4. Click OK and follow the on-screen instructions for installation.

Macintosh Users:

1. Insert the *Total Titanic: A Night to Remember* disc into your CD-ROM drive.
2. Double click the icon for the *Total Titanic: A Night to Remember* CD.
3. Double click the "ANTR Installer" icon. Follow the instructions through for installation.

Starting

Please note that the *Total Titanic: A Night to Remember* disc must remain in your CD-ROM drive during use.

Windows 95 Users:

1. Click Start, select Programs, then select *Total Titanic* from the menus.
2. Highlight and click the icon for *A Night to Remember*.

Macintosh Users:

1. Locate the folder named ANTR folder on your hard drive.
2. Double click the icon for *A Night to Remember*.

Exiting

To exit *Total Titanic: A Night to Remember*, do any one of the following:

- For Windows users: Press CTRL-Q; For Macintosh users: Press CMD-Q.
- Move the mouse cursor to the top edge of your screen, then select Exit from the File menu bar.

Basic Navigation

- Click the Film/Commentary switch to select soundtrack.
- Click the Volume dial to select volume level.
- Click the Large/Small switch to select movie size.
- Click the Hide/Show button to hide or show control panel.
- Click the Search button to search the movie by word.
- Click the button to the right of the Search button to find the next instance of the word.
- Click the button to the left of the Search button to find the previous instance of the word.
- Click the button directly above the Search button to play or pause the movie.
- Click the button to the right of the Play/Pause button to go forward one frame.
- Click the button to the left of the Play/Pause button to go back one frame.
- Click the button to the far right of the Play/Pause button to go forward an episode.
- Click the button to the far left of the Play/Pause button to go back an episode.
- Drag the flag button below the movie image to fast forward or rewind.
- Click the Timeline button to select Timeline.
- Click the Help button to view Help.
- Click the Blueprint button to select Blueprint.
- Click Passenger Log button to select Passenger Log.

Timeline

- Use the timeline to track the course of the ship from its launch to the rescue of the survivors.
- Click a notch to select key episodes in the film.
- Drag the marker along the notches to advance the animation.
- Click the framed chapter title below the timeline to go to that episode in *A Night to Remember*.

Help

Click the Help button at the bottom center of the screen for on-screen navigation button explanations.

Blueprint

- Select a deck by clicking one of the nine cross-sections from the view at the top of the page.
- Roll your mouse over the selected deck to choose a specific room.
- Click any shaded area in the floor plan to view a location.
- Click "location" to view a description.
- Click "scenes" to view a list of corresponding scenes from *A Night to Remember*.
- Select a title from the scene list to view a video clip.
- Click the arrows to view more scenes or the previous list of scenes.
