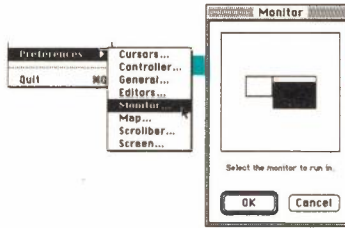

QUICK REFERENCE CARD

Selection tool		Selects or drags screens, objects, and media
Creation tool		Creates screens and objects
Path Creation tool		Creates paths between screens
Path Deletion tool		Deletes paths between screens
Rectangle tool		Creates rectangular hot regions
Ellipse tool		Creates elliptical hot regions
Polygon tool		Creates polygonal hot regions
Freehand tool		Creates freehand hot regions
Magic Wand tool		Creates hot regions of adjacent pixels of the same color
Global Magic Wand tool		Creates hot regions of all pixels of the same color
Default Multi-Window Display with Menus tool		Displays all the windows on the desktop and the menu bar
Single Window Display with Menus tool		Displays only the Apple Media Tool windows and the menu bar
Full Screen Windows with no Menus tool		Displays only the Apple Media Tool windows

Monitor Preferences

- Click the monitor you want the Apple Media Tool to use for running a project in the prototype mode (using the Run command from the Screen menu).



Map Preferences

- Click *Always snap to grid* to force the screen icons to snap to an invisible grid in the Map window.

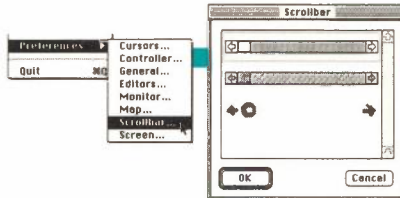


- Click *Always create thumbnail* to always create thumbnails of the screens in your project.



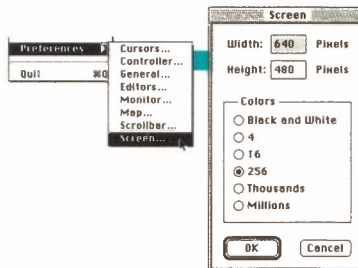
Scrollbar Preferences

- Click the desired scrollbar to select it. A green rectangle appears around your selection.



Screen Preferences

- Enter the *Width* and *Height* that the Apple Media Tool uses to display screens at run time.

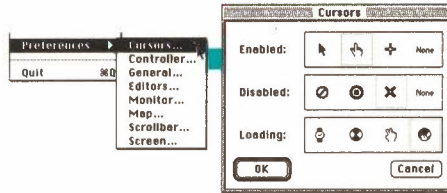


- Click one of the *Colors* radio buttons to select the color to be used in your project.

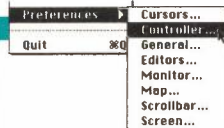
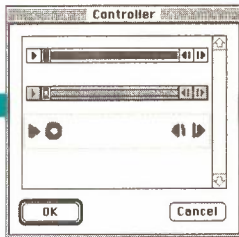

Cursors Preferences

- Click the desired Enabled, Disabled, and Loading cursor icon to select it. A green rectangle appears around your selection.



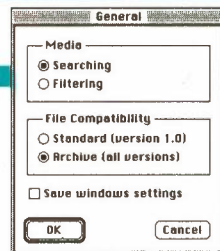
Controller Preferences



- Click the desired controller to select it. A green rectangle appears around your selection.

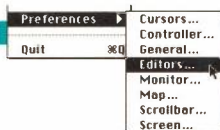
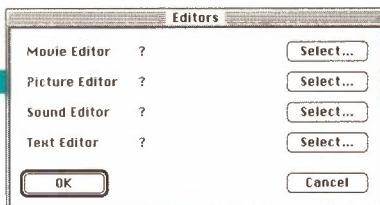
General Preferences

- Click **Searching** to select the first media element in the Media miniwindow whose name starts with the character string you type.
- Click **Filtering** to display only the Media elements in the Media miniwindow whose names start with the character string you type.



- Click **Standard** to save a version of your project in a temporary format while you are still in the process of building the project. The saving process is faster.
- Click **Archive** to save the final version of your project so it can work with future versions of the Apple Media Tool.
- Click **Save windows settings** if you want the Apple Media Tool to remember the size and locations of the different windows in your project.

Editors Preferences



- Click **Select** to specify a Movie Editor, Picture Editor, Sound Editor, and Text Editor that can be launched from within the Apple Media Tool.
