

ARTHUR'S TEACHER TROUBLE™

Welcome to the world of Brøderbund's Living Books™. You and your child are about to experience a fun and fantastic learning environment where characters and objects come alive and bring a whole new dimension to storytelling.

Starting Up

To play this Living Book, begin at the Windows Program Manager. If you are not familiar with the Program Manager, consult your Windows manual. You must have at least Windows 3.0 (with Multimedia Extensions) or Windows 3.1 to play Arthur's Teacher Trouble. Insert the CD-ROM disc (located in the protective case in your package) into your CD-ROM drive (using a disc caddy if appropriate).



Arthur's Teacher Trouble


Create a new icon for Arthur's Teacher Trouble by choosing the "New" option under "File," or just run the program by selecting the "Run" option under "File." In either case, type the following in the line labeled "Command:"

x:\Install.exe or, just x:\Arthur.exe

(where "x" is the designation of the CD-ROM drive). If you chose to create an icon, a new icon will appear in your Program Manager folder. Double-click on that icon to begin playing. If you chose to run the program, the book will begin playing. You can also run the program from the File Manager.

Choose a Language

First, select the language you would like to use from those listed at the top of the main selection screen. Once you start the story, all the words — written and spoken — will be in the language you've selected. The selection screens and introduction, though, will always be in English. After you've chosen a language, you can begin by selecting "Let Me Play" to play within the story (interactive mode), or selecting "Read To Me" to have the story read to you (passive mode).



You can also press "1" or "2" on your keyboard at any point in the story to change the language (to English or Spanish, respectively) of the page you are on.

READ TO ME

When you make this selection, your cursor will disappear as you see the story unfold page by page. Your cursor will only reappear when you return to the main selection screen after the story has finished. You can also use the space bar to exit the story. Use the right or left arrow keys on your keyboard to skip ahead or see an earlier page in the story. When having the story read to you, you can immediately switch to "Let Me Play" mode by pressing "P" on your keyboard.

LET ME PLAY

When you click on this button, you'll be able to start exploring each page after its introduction. Use the mouse to select different items you'd like to see come to life on screen. There are many hidden buttons on every page, so be sure to search carefully before turning each page. For example, be sure to click on the calendar on page one. When playing in the story, you can switch to "Read To Me" mode by pressing "R" on your keyboard.

OPTIONS

Clicking on this button takes you to the options page where you can go directly to any page in the book in interactive ("Let Me Play") mode. You cannot jump into the story in passive ("Read To Me") mode. To go directly to a page, click the forward and back arrows until you see the page you want. Then click "OK" to go to that page.

Turning Pages

To turn pages, select the forward or backward arrows located in the lower right and left corners of the screen, or press the right or left arrows on your keyboard. To return to the main selection screen, click on the page number on the middle bottom of the screen or press the space bar.
