

Windows 3.1 & Windows for Workgroups 3.11 Installation Instructions:

1. Insert the disc into your CD-ROM drive and from the program manager, file menu select: RUN.
2. In the box that appears, type D:\INSTALL.EXE. (If your CD-ROM drive has a label other than D:, use that letter instead.) Press the Enter key.
3. Follow the instructions that appear on the screen. You may specify a location where you want support files installed or accept the default destination that appears on the screen. If you do not have QuickTime 2.01 or later installed on your system, the screen will prompt you to allow it to install QuickTime.


After you start *Artrageous!*, a guide will greet you with a brief introduction. If you don't want to hear the introduction, just click anywhere on the screen.

The Plaza

The world of *Artrageous!* is arranged around a central plaza. To move around the plaza, just move your cursor around the screen. When it turns into a big white arrow, you can click to go in the direction it's pointing.

Leaving the Plaza - Quick Time Virtual Reality

When you leave the plaza and approach a neighborhood (**Color, Light, Perspective, Composition, Life of Art, Database**), you'll enter a world of quick-time virtual reality. Your cursor will look like this:




You can move around this world by moving your cursor around the screen. For example, the more you move the cursor to the right side of the screen, the faster the world will spin to the right. Remember, you can move right or left, but not up or down.




Inside a Neighborhood

Once inside a particular neighborhood, the cursor will look like a big white arrow. When the cursor turns into a hand with a pointing finger, it means you've found a place to touch and explore.



Location Bar


Whenever you go into a neighborhood, the **Location Bar** keeps track of your journey. The **Location Bar** is located at the bottom of the screen. It shows your location in the hierarchy of the program. You can move up the tree, or go backward in your journey, by clicking on any location in the chain.

The Navigation Menu



Navigation Menu


Index

The **Index** provides instant access to each activity, painting, and artist in the program.




Database

The database contains articles about the people, terms, and trends in art.




Timeline
