MAC USERS:

To get started...

STEP 1

Confirm that your system meets the following requirements:

- Mac OS X 10.3.9 or later
- 512 MB RAM required (1 GB recommended)
- 750 MB available hard drive space
- Color monitor with at least 1024x768 resolution
- DVD-ROM Drive
- To print: Laser or ink jet printer
- To access software update feature: Internet access (fees may apply)

STEP 2

Install the Mac version of the Bondi Reader

- A. Insert the Bondi Reader Installer disc into your DVD ROM drive.
- B. Double click the Installer disc icon, that appears on your desktop
- C. Double click the **Installer.pkg** icon
- D. Follow the installation instructions, as they appear in the Installer dialog box...
 - Click the “**Continue**” button, in the “*Welcome to the Installer*” window
 - Read the *Software License Agreement*, then
 - Click the “**Continue**” button, then
 - Click the “**Agree**” (or “**Disagree**”) button
 - Select a Destination volume, then...
 - Click the “**Continue**” button
 - Click the “**Install**” button
 - Click the “**Close**” button
- E. Eject and remove the Installer disc

STEP 4 – ENJOY THE BONDI READER









Show Table of Contents	“c” key (C)
Show Search window	“s” key (S)
Page Forward	page down  or right arrow key 
Page Backward	page up  or left arrow key 
Top of Page	up arrow key 
Scrolls Down (Jump Down)	down arrow key 
Hop Down, One Page	space bar ()
Enter Flip Mode (double page view)	“f” key (F)
Enter Read Mode (single page view)	“r” key (R)
100 % Magnification	“1” key (1)
200 % Magnification	“2” key (2)
300 % Magnification	“3” key (3)
Fit Page, to Height of Window	“h” key (H)
Fit Page, to Width of Window	“w” key (W)
Print	Command and “p” key (⌘-P)
