Burning Monkey Casino!


## INSTALLATION AND LAUNCH

Make sure the display resolution is set to 640x480. (This won't change your whole screen resolution, just the game window.)



## SLOTS

- 7 Your bankroll
- 8 Back to the lobby!


### Keyboard shortcuts:

- 1: Hold the first reel. (Hold machines only)
  - 2: Hold the second reel. (Hold machines only)
  - 3: Hold the third reel. (Hold machines only)
  - 4: Hold the fourth reel. (Four/five reel hold machines only)
  - 5: Hold the fifth reel. (Five reel hold machines only)
- Return: Pull handle.  
escape: Leave game.

## THREE CARD MONTY

Keep your eye on that queen! Pick the queen out of three cards after a healthy shuffle, and you'll be raking it in. Pick the wrong card, and you'll feel like a chimp chump.

*NOTE: You cannot ever win on NY Street rules. Really. Some people may take this as a challenge to their gambling skill, but you honestly can't win. However, you don't have to tell your friends this.*




- ① Your bankroll

# POKER

It's the classic card game! Make the best hand you can with one draw.



- ① Your bankroll
- ② Click "Deal" to deal a new hand  
Click "Draw" to draw
- ③ Click to hold this card  
*Only available after initial deal*
- ④ Change bet
- ⑤ Change machine
- ⑥ Back to the lobby!

## Keyboard shortcuts:

- 1: Hold the first card.
  - 2: Hold the second card.
  - 3: Hold the third card.
  - 4: Hold the fourth card.
  - 5: Hold the fifth card.
- Return: Deal or draw.  
escape: Leave game.

Winning poker hands include:

**Pair** - two cards with the same rank.

**Two Pair** - two distinct pairs of same-ranked cards.

**Three Of A Kind** - three cards of the same rank.

**Straight** - all five cards in a sequence, such as 3-4-5-6-7.

**Flush** - all cards share the same suit.

**Full House** - a three of a kind and a pair.

**Four Of A Kind** - four cards of the same rank.

**Straight Flush** - all five cards share the same suit and are in sequence.

**Royal Flush** - the highest straight flush. 10, Jack, Queen, King, and Ace of one suit.

It's monkey scratch fever! Pick your card type and a lucky scratcher, and scratch your way to quick winnings!



- 1 Your bankroll
- 2 Pick card type
- 3 Choose a lucky scratcher!
- 4 Buy a card!
- 5 Scratch here!
- 6 Back to the lobby!


Keyboard shortcuts:

# BLACKJACK

Hit me! This classic gambling game has you trying to get as close to 21 as you can without going over. Aces count as 1 or 11, and face cards count as 10.



① Your bankroll

② Change bet

③ Deal a new hand  
Hit / take another card

④ Stand / end turn

⑤ Double your bet,  
take one card and stand

⑥ Split a pair of cards into  
two separate hands  
*Requires a secondary bet!*

⑦ Current hand totals

⑧ Your hand

⑨ Dealer's hand

⑩ Back to the lobby!

## Keyboard shortcuts:

S: Split pair

D: Double Down

Return/Space: Deal/Hit

Delete: Stand
