## Important Health Warning About Playing Video Games

### Photosensitive Seizures

A very small percentage of people may experience a seizure when exposed to certain visual images, including flashing lights or patterns that may appear in video games. Even people who have no history of seizures or epilepsy may have an undiagnosed condition that can cause these “photosensitive epileptic seizures” while watching video games.

These seizures may have a variety of symptoms, including lightheadedness, altered vision, eye or face twitching, jerking or shaking of arms or legs, disorientation, confusion, or momentary loss of awareness. Seizures may also cause loss of consciousness or convulsions that can lead to injury from falling down or striking nearby objects.

Immediately stop playing and consult a doctor if you experience any of these symptoms. Parents should watch for or ask their children about the above symptoms — children and teenagers are more likely than adults to experience these seizures. The risk of photosensitive epileptic seizures may be reduced by taking the following precautions: sit farther from the screen; use a smaller screen; play in a well-lit room; and do not play when you are drowsy or fatigued. If you or any of your relatives have a history of seizures or epilepsy, consult a doctor before playing.

### Precautions to take during use

- Sit a good distance away from the monitor.
- Avoid playing if you are tired or have not had much sleep.
- Make sure that the room in which you are playing is well lit.
- Rest for at least 10 to 15 minutes per hour while playing a video game.

# INSTALLATION

As part of the Mac App Store purchasing process, the game has already been installed on your computer. Read the **Getting Started** section to start playing the game.

# GETTING STARTED

1. If *F1 2013: CLASSIC EDITION* is not already running, double-click on the **F1 2013: CLASSIC EDITION application icon**. By default this is to be found in the **Applications folder** on your computer's hard drive.
2. The *F1 2013: CLASSIC EDITION* pre-game **Options window** will appear. Click on the **Play button**. The game will launch.
3. If you have Game Center (OS X 10.8 or later) and are not already signed in, a dialog will appear asking you if you want to sign in. If you do not wish to sign into Game Center, click **Cancel** and continue to point 5 of these instructions.
4. If you wish to play using Game Center, enter your Apple ID and Password and click **Sign in**.
5. After the splash screens and videos, the **Start screen** will appear. Press the **Return** () **key**.
6. A dialog box will appear asking you to create an autosave file. Highlight **Yes** and press the **Return** () **key**.
7. A dialog box will appear asking you to enter a first name for your driver. Press the **Return** () **key**, type a name and press the **Return** () **key** again.
8. A dialog box will appear asking you to enter a surname for your driver. Press the **Return** () **key**, type a name and press the **Return** () **key** again.
9. A dialog box will appear asking you to select a region of origin for your driver. Select a region and press the **Return** () **key**.
10. If you have selected any region besides **Other**, a dialog box will appear asking you to select a country of origin for your driver. Select a country and press the **Return** () **key**.
11. A dialog box will appear asking you to select a difficulty level. If this is your first time playing, we recommend you select **Not too much, I'm new to this and need to get up to speed**. Press the **Return** () **key**.
12. Three team icons will appear. Highlight a team and press the **Return** () **key** to join it. You can view more information on a team by highlighting that team and pressing the **Shift** () **key**. Press the **Escape** () **key** to close the information window.
13. A dialog will appear informing you that by completing the various "Young Drivers Tests" you will unlock a selection of teams to choose from to begin your career. Press the **Return** () **key**.
14. You will find yourself at the Yas Marina Circuit in Abu Dhabi, where your race engineer is explaining how to drive a FORMULA ONE™ car...

## WELCOME TO F1 2013: CLASSIC EDITION

*F1 2013: CLASSIC EDITION* features all the stars and cars from the 2013 FIA FORMULA ONE WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP™. Compete for motor-sport's ultimate prize over five seasons in career mode, test your mettle in time attack mode and relive the finest moments of the sport in F1 classics mode, as you become immersed in the world of FORMULA ONE.

*F1 2013: CLASSIC EDITION* includes a host of new improvements and enhancements, including new handling to reflect the 2013 season cars and tyres plus all of the 2013 season rule changes. Additional new features include F1 classics — a brand new game mode which features classic FORMULA ONE cars and the drivers who made history in them — and scenario mode where you'll complete challenges that reflect the on-track progress of a FORMULA ONE driver from rookie to retirement.

## STARTING OUT

### AUTOSAVE

*F1 2013: CLASSIC EDITION* will automatically save your game at specific points. You can disable the autosave feature by entering the **My F1** menu (**Main Menu** ⇒ **My F1**) and editing your profile settings.

### MENU NAVIGATION

Use  /  to navigate the menus. Press  to confirm/select or  to cancel/back up. On some menu screens there are additional options available — look for prompts to use  and  or  and .

### GOLDEN QUESTIONS

Upon starting the game for the very first time, you will be asked a series of questions (see **Getting Started** on p. 3). These are used to create your profile and set up an initial difficulty level for you.

You can edit your profile at any time by accessing the **My F1** menu (**Main Menu** ⇒ **My F1**).

### DRIVING ASSISTS

You can change your driving assists by selecting **Difficulty Level** from the **Race Settings** screen prior to entering a session. Alternatively, driving assists can be modified from the in-race **Pause** menu.

# REPLAYS & FLASHBACKS

## REPLAYS

You can view a replay at any time by selecting the option from the in-game **Pause menu**. You can also view a replay of your race once it has ended.

## FLASHBACKS

Recover from mistakes seamlessly by using *F1 2013: CLASSIC EDITION*'s flashback system. Press **F1** to enter an instant replay and rewind your race to a point before the incident, then press **F9** to flashback to that point and resume racing.

Remember that you have a limited number of flashbacks per session, so use them wisely!

## NEW

## MID-SESSION SAVE

Mid-session save allows you to save your game at any point during a session and then return to it at a later time. With mid-session save, you now have the opportunity to complete a full race weekend at your own convenience.

To access mid-session save, simply pause the game during a race weekend and select **Mid Session Save**. From here you can save, load or save and exit to the **Main Menu**. If you enter a game mode with an existing mid-session save, you will be asked if you would like to resume from your save or create a new session.

# THE ON-TRACK GAME SCREEN

The game screen provides a wealth of useful information about your car and the current race. Please note that some screen elements require a player input or event to occur before they will be displayed.


You can set up a custom control configuration by setting the **Control Config** to **Custom** (**My F1** ⇒ **Driving Controls** ⇒ **Control Config**).



## WHEEL
