

# XimpleMOD Tracker Player

Open-source module player for Mac OS X

## *Final Version*

Double-click on the installer to install this program.

### A) About XimpleMOD

You use **XimpleMOD** to play **module tracks** in IT/S3M/MTM/MOD/UMX format. If you don't know what a module track is, see below.

### B) What are module tracks?

Module tracks are music formats. They store the music score. Unlike MIDI's where the composer is limited to some standard instruments, in MODs instruments are built-in on module files.

Additionally, modules also feature **samples** which are raw sound-data used in a song, sound effects, etc.

There are many module format, depending on the **tracker** used to compose the song. Maybe the most popular is MOD but there are also IT (Impulse Tracker), S3M (Scream Tracker 3), etc. XimpleMOD uses **BASSMOD** high-quality playing library (see below) which supports IT/S3M/MTM/MOD/UMX.
