

INSTALLING QUARKXPRESS™ 3.31

The information on this card replaces the information on pages 4–5 in the *Getting Started* booklet included with your QuarkXPress for Power Macintosh documentation. Please substitute the instructions below for those in the booklet.

Your Installer diskette includes an Installer Notes file. Read this file for late-breaking installation information.

Step 1 – Preparing to Install QuarkXPress

Some system extensions, Control Panels, and virus protection software may interfere with the installation of QuarkXPress. If you do not disable these items, the installation may proceed without problems, but you may get an error message when you try to open the application.

To prevent problems with the installation process:

- Temporarily remove all unnecessary system extensions and Control Panels from your System Folder and restart your Power Macintosh. Do NOT remove the Apple CD-ROM Extension or third-party drive extensions that enable your CD-ROM drive to recognize a CD-ROM.
- If you use a virus detection program, first use it to check your QuarkXPress program disks, then disable it before installing QuarkXPress.

Step 2 – Registering QuarkXPress

Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive, or mount the CD from a networked drive. (This does not apply when installing from the diskette version of QuarkXPress for Power Macintosh.)

Insert the QuarkXPress for Power Macintosh Installer diskette and double-click on the QuarkXPress Installer icon. Follow the instructions on your screen.

1. Enter your QuarkXPress serial number (a two-letter prefix followed by an eight-digit number printed on the QuarkXPress for Power Macintosh Installer diskette and your User Registration Disk). If your product has

been preserialized, you will not be asked for the serial number. Fill out the rest of the registration screen with the appropriate information. The Contact Name you enter in the **Product Registration** dialog box is used for all correspondence from Quark.

The Company Name is the official licensee and is displayed on the QuarkXPress startup screen. If no Company Name is entered, the Contact Name is displayed.

2. Check to be sure that your mailing address is correct. This is the name and address that Quark will use to contact you in the future.
3. Fill out the remaining screens with your user information. The User Information Survey is used by Quark to determine future product enhancements. System Information is used by support technicians should you need to contact Quark Technical Support.
4. Insert the User Registration Disk when prompted. A copy of the User Registration File will be placed on the diskette. Write your name and phone number on your User Registration Disk before returning it to Quark. If your User Registration Disk cannot be read, we will use this information to contact you. Use the prepaid disk mailer to return your User Registration Disk to Quark.

Step 3 – Installing QuarkXPress

After completing the registration procedure, insert the QuarkXPress for Power Macintosh Installer diskette when prompted and continue with the installation of the QuarkXPress application and auxiliary files. Follow the instructions on your screen.

- You can selectively install groups of files and XTensions™ by clicking the check marks in front of the file names. If a file name is checked, that file will be installed. You can install a file later by drag-copying it to your hard drive.
- The installation procedure will copy XTensions and word processing filters into an automatically created folder called “XTension.” QuarkXPress will run both XTensions that are loose in the QuarkXPress folder and XTensions in this folder.

- To store unused XTensions, create a folder called “Other XTensions” inside the QuarkXPress folder and move unused XTensions into it. By storing unused XTensions in this subfolder, you increase the amount of RAM available for QuarkXPress functions. See Appendix B in the *Reference Manual* for more information about XTensions.
- QuarkXPress also creates a folder called “PDF,” which contains Printer Description Files. PDFs in this folder will automatically be displayed in the **Printer Type** pop-up menu (**Page Setup** dialog box). The PDF folder allows you to store only those PDFs that you use. QuarkXPress will access PDFs that are loose in the QuarkXPress folder and PDFs in the PDF folder. You can create a folder called “Other PDFs” to store the PDFs that you don’t use.
- QuarkXPress now supports PPDs (PostScript Printer Descriptions, version 4.0 or later), created by Adobe, in addition to PDFs. QuarkXPress will access PPDs from the “Printer Descriptions” folder located in the Extensions folder inside the System Folder. You may create a “Printer Descriptions” folder if none exists, or you may install a LaserWriter 8.x driver, which creates the folder for you.
- The QuarkXPress Installer installs the file **AppleScriptLib** in the Extensions folder inside the System Folder. This shared library is required for QuarkXPress for Power Macintosh to function. If you accidentally delete this file, you can drag a new copy directly from the CD-ROM to your System Folder. (Refer to Apple’s documentation for more information about shared libraries and the Power Macintosh.)

Step 4 – Completing the Installation Process

When the QuarkXPress Installer finishes the installation, return your system to its normal configuration.

- If you removed any system extensions and Control Panels before you installed QuarkXPress, return them to your System Folder.
- If you disabled any virus protection software, enable it before continuing.

Restart your Power Macintosh before attempting to open the QuarkXPress application.

Release Notes

When you install QuarkXPress, a file called “Release Notes 3.31” is also copied to your QuarkXPress program folder. This stand-alone document contains information about QuarkXPress for Power Macintosh features that were added after the documentation was printed. Open the document by double-clicking on it in the Finder. Once the document is opened, follow the instructions that are displayed. You can print this document by choosing **Print** from the Release Notes’ **File** menu.

Installing Multiple Copies

When installing more than one copy of QuarkXPress for Power Macintosh, you can reuse the registration data from the first installation in subsequent installations.

1. Click the **Copy Registration** button in the first dialog box to use the registration information from your first installation.
2. Eject the QuarkXPress for Power Macintosh Installer diskette.
3. Insert the User Registration Disk from your first installation and open the registration file. The **Product Registration** dialog box is displayed with the user information already entered in the fields.
