INSTALLATION & ACTIVATION

It is important that the game is installed correctly before playing. Installation is a one-time process that only takes a few minutes. Please follow the instructions below:

1. Double-click on the LEGOHarryPotter.dmg file and wait for the LEGO® *Harry Potter*™ icon to appear on your desktop.
2. Double-click on the LEGO® *Harry Potter*™ icon to open it.
3. Before doing anything else, read the file called **ReadMe** found in the **English folder**.
4. Drag the LEGO® *Harry Potter*™ folder onto the **Applications folder** that appears next to it. It will start to copy across.
5. Once the copy has finished, drag the LEGO® *Harry Potter*™ icon on your Desktop to the Trash. You may now delete the LEGOHarryPotter.dmg DMG file.
6. Once installation is complete, double-click on the LEGO® *Harry Potter*™ **application icon** in the LEGO® *Harry Potter*™ folder, which is found in the **Applications folder** on your hard drive. The pre-game Options window will appear showing the Activation Panel.
7. Enter your Product Key into the six empty boxes. Your Product Key is printed on the back of this manual. Once the Product Key has been entered, the **Save** button in the right-hand corner of the Panel will activate.
8. Click the **Save** button to save your Product Key.

Playing using Online Activation

Click the **Activate Online...** button in the Activation Panel. A dialog will appear confirming that your Product Key will be sent to Ferret's servers. Click the **Activate Online...** button in the dialog. After a few seconds a message will appear confirming that your game has been successfully activated. The Activation Panel will update showing you the number of machines you are allowed to activate the game on and how many machines you have currently activated. In future, you can play your game without an internet connection.



You can now move onto the "Getting Started" section below, which will take you through playing the game for the first time.

Getting Started

1. If LEGO *Harry Potter*™ is not already running, double-click on the LEGO *Harry Potter*™ application icon. By default this is to be found in the LEGO *Harry Potter*™ folder within the **Applications folder** on your computer's hard drive.
2. The pre-game options screen will appear. Click on the **Play** button. The game will launch.
3. When the title screen appears, press a key on the keyboard or button on a gamepad.
4. Select **New Game**.
5. You will be taken straight into the world of *Harry Potter*™ – starting with his dramatic arrival at number four, Privet Drive...





Gamepad Controls

LEGO Harry Potter™: Years 1-4 works fine with your Mac's keyboard, however we recommend using a dual analog stick gamepad. The diagram below is based on a standard controller and some gamepads may not map the controls indicated to the same buttons. In such cases the controls need to be set manually. This can be done in **Control Configuration** via **Options** on the **Main Menu**.


New Game

When you begin a new game of *LEGO Harry Potter™: Years 1-4*, you'll be taken straight into Harry's world—starting with his dramatic arrival at Number Four, Privet Drive.

Soon, you'll be collecting your school supplies from Diagon Alley, making your way to platform nine and three-quarters, and travelling to Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry aboard the Hogwarts Express.

Load Game

Choose **Load Game** if you have a previously saved game. You will rejoin the story at the point where you last saved.



HOGWARTS™ SCHOOL OF WITCHCRAFT AND WIZARDRY

Lessons

Just like any other young witch or wizard, you'll need to attend lessons in order to learn new spells and magical abilities. When you arrive at Hogwarts, find Nearly Headless Nick (who will guide you around Hogwarts).

Whenever you complete a lesson, a token will appear on screen. Once collected, these tokens allow you to use the spells and magic abilities you've learned. A new spell or ability may enable you to interact with (or cast on) objects that you couldn't before, and reach inaccessible areas. To explore Hogwarts in its entirety, you'll need to unlock a wide range of abilities and spell tokens. Keep attending lessons and, before long, you may know almost as much as Hermione!



Story Events

During each school year, you'll be required to play through a series of Story Events, which capture your favorite moments from the *Harry Potter™* stories—such as the mountain troll fight in the girls' toilets and Harry's discovery of the dark and mysterious Chamber of Secrets™. To complete a Story Event, you'll need to use the spells and magical abilities you've learned during the course of the game.

Once a Story Event has been completed, you can replay the Story Event or play the event in Free Play Mode. To do so, go to the Leaky Cauldron noticeboard.

You can leave Hogwarts and return to the Leaky Cauldron at any time. To do so, simply pause the game by pressing **ENTER** or **START** and select **The Leaky Cauldron**.

Polyjuice Potion Cauldrons

Once you've learned how to brew the Polyjuice Potion, you'll be able to use the gold Polyjuice Potion cauldrons scattered around Hogwarts to change into characters that you've unlocked or purchased.



To switch characters, walk up to a gold cauldron and drink the potion by pressing **H** or **3**. Then use **W**, **A**, **S**, **D** or **9** / **+** to select the character you want to change into and press **Y** or **2**. The spells and magical abilities of the character will automatically become available to you.

THE LEAKY CAULDRON

Once inside the Leaky Cauldron, you'll be able to replay previously completed levels, return to Hogwarts, or access Diagon Alley.

Go to Hogwarts

To return to Hogwarts and continue your current game, go through the door leading to Muggle London.

Leaky Cauldron Noticeboard

To replay a level that you've already completed, go to the noticeboard in the Leaky Cauldron. The noticeboard will display the levels that you have already completed. Use **W**, **A**, **S**, **D** or **9** / **+** to highlight the level you want to play again and press **Y** or **2** to select it.

Free Play Mode

Selecting Free Play Mode enables you to play levels with a large group of characters—and gives you the opportunity to use their unique spells and abilities to unlock and access new areas.

Go to Diagon Alley

To access Diagon Alley, walk through the door that leads to the magical brick wall.




DIAGON ALLEY

Diagon Alley is the place for all your wizarding needs.

Eeylops Owl Emporium

Red Bricks are delivered to Eeylops once they have been posted via Owl Post. You'll be able to purchase the Red Brick extras displayed in the emporium using LEGO studs. See page 18 for more information about Red Bricks.



Wiseacre's Wizarding Equipment

If you visit Wiseacre's Wizarding Equipment, you will be able to view and purchase all the spells you have collected so far. Purchasing unlocked spells with LEGO studs will add them to your spell list (although purchased spells will only be available to certain characters). In some instances, purchased spells will upgrade your existing spells. See page 17 for more information about spell and ability tokens.

If you visit the upper level of Wiseacre's Wizarding Equipment, you'll be able to access the cheat code entry area. If you have a cheat code you can enter it here and see what it unlocks.

Madam Malkin's Robes for All Occasions (Character Customizer)

Provided you've collected the relevant token and have enough studs, you'll be able to purchase characters from Madam Malkin's Robes for All Occasions.

You can also customize your characters in Madam Malkin's by walking them into one of the upstairs changing rooms. Use **W** **A** **S** **D** or **9** / **+** to select the character part you wish to change, and to cycle through the available replacement parts.

The more characters you purchase, the more LEGO accessories will become available to you.

To play as a customized character, you will need to activate a gold Polyjuice Potion cauldron and select the relevant character from the character list. See page 8 for more information about selecting characters.



Gringotts Bank™ (LEGO Builder)



Enter Gringotts Bank and discover the LEGO Builder.

Deep inside Gringotts, you will find locked vaults. These vaults may be unlocked individually provided you have enough Gold Bricks to build their doors. Once you've opened a vault, you'll find a Portkey—which will transport you to a unique LEGO Builder level.

Within each LEGO Builder level, you'll find a set of LEGO objects. By completing a task successfully, you'll be able to unlock these—and other bonus LEGO objects—and use them to build your own creations within the level.

Unlocking and completing LEGO Builder tasks will increase the number of LEGO objects in your collection.




ON-SCREEN INFORMATION

The game screen provides some information about your current status and progress in the story.



- 1 Active Character** There are many different characters that you can control while you're at Hogwarts; you'll see an icon of the character you're currently playing as displayed at the top of the screen.
- 2 LEGO Stud Total** The number of LEGO studs you've collected is displayed next to your character's icon. You can use LEGO studs to unlock extras, characters and Gold Bricks, as well as spells.
- 3 Health** The four hearts show your character's health. Once all hearts are gone the character will break into pieces and you'll lose some LEGO studs!
- 4 Currently Selected Spell** This shows which spell or special ability was last selected on the Spell Wheel. After learning lots of spells, even the best witches and wizards need a reminder!
- 5 True Wizard Meter** Whenever studs are collected, the True Wizard bar will appear on screen and start to fill up. If you fill the bar for each level, you'll receive a special bonus!



SPELLS AND MAGICAL ABILITIES

Tagging Characters

To tag other characters, press **J** or **4**. Switching between characters allows you to use each character's unique abilities—enabling you to explore Hogwarts and complete Story Events.

Spell-its

Gone are the days when LEGO bricks needed to be built by hand! Once you have your wand, you can stand next to piles of twinkling, jiggling, LEGO bricks and press and hold **H** or **3** to make the bricks magically build themselves.



Spell-casting

To cast a non-specific spell, press **G** or **1**. To cast the spell or access the ability currently selected on the Spell Wheel, press **H** or **3**.

If you want to choose a specific spell or ability, press and hold **J** or **4** to bring up the Spell Wheel. While holding down **J** or **4**, you can move round the Spell Wheel using **W**, **A**, **S**, **D** or **9** / **+**. Highlight the spell or ability you require, then let go of **J** or **4**. You will now be able to cast the selected spell or access the selected ability.

- To target a specific object with a spell or weapon, press and hold **G** or **1**, and use the on-screen indicator to highlight it. When the object is highlighted, release **G** or **1** to cast.
- To cast *Wingardium Leviosa*, target the object with the on-screen indicator and keep **G** or **1** held down.
- Although Muggles and Squibs cannot perform magic, you can make them bash objects by pressing **G** or **1**.

Special Abilities

Certain characters have special abilities. Once these abilities are learned or unlocked, they will be added to that character's Spell Wheel.

Pet Abilities

Some characters, such as Ron Weasley™, can use their pets to complete puzzles. For example, while playing as Ron, you can select the Pet Ability from the Spell Wheel to take control of his pet rat, Scabbers™ (who will be able to climb inside small pipes and reach previously inaccessible items or areas).

Invisibility Cloak

Once he has received it, Harry can use the Invisibility Cloak to sneak past Prefects and teachers. To put on the Cloak, select the **Cloak Icon** from the Spell Wheel. Remember: wearing the Cloak will limit Harry's movements and available abilities.



Dig Ability

Certain characters will be able to dig up LEGO objects. To start digging, stand your character over the Paw

Prints that will appear above certain patches and press and hold **[G]** or **[1]**.



Potion Cauldrons

As you move through the game, you will come across black potion cauldrons with ingredient icons orbiting their rims. Adding all of the correct ingredients to a cauldron will cause it to bubble over and the relevant potion to become available. Be careful! Incorrectly brewed potions can have unpredictable side effects. If you don't use the correct ingredients, you'll have to face the consequences!



- If you find a potion ingredient, you can pick it up by pressing **[H]** or **[3]**.
- To place a potion ingredient in a cauldron, stand close to the cauldron and press **[H]** or **[3]**.
- To drink a potion, stand next to a bubbling cauldron and press **[H]** or **[3]**.

ITEMS

LEGO Studs

LEGO studs are the currency of *LEGO Harry Potter™: Years 1-4*. They come in three values:

- silver (adds 10 to your stud total),
- gold (adds 100 to your stud total) and
- blue (adds 1,000 to your stud total).

You can use studs to unlock new characters, spells, Red Brick extras, and Gold Bricks.



Hogwarts Crests

Hogwarts crest pieces will be awarded to you for solving puzzles and accessing hidden areas within Story Events. When you obtain four crest pieces from a particular level, the pieces will join together and form a large Hogwarts crest. Completing a crest will result in a Gold Brick reward.



Spell and Ability Tokens

Tokens give the player new spells and abilities, or upgrade previously learned spells. Some tokens will unlock automatically; others must be purchased from Wiscacre's Wizarding Equipment with LEGO studs.

Character Tokens

During the course of the game, you may come across hidden character tokens. Once a character token has been found, the relevant character will become available in Madam Malkin's Robes for All Occasions in Diagon Alley and the player can purchase them using studs.

Students in Peril


Be on the lookout for unfortunate students who may have got themselves into a spot of bother. Helping these students will reward you with a Gold Brick.

Red Bricks

Red Bricks allow you to activate special extras—which you can use to help you progress through the game. Whenever you find a Red Brick, you must send it to **Eyloyps Owl Emporium** in Diagon Alley using Owl Post.


To post a Red Brick, walk up to it and press **[H]** or **[3]**. Then carry it to the nearest owl perch and press **[H]** or **[3]**.

Once a Red Brick has been delivered to **Eyloyps Owl Emporium**, you can purchase it with studs. To activate an unlocked brick, press **[ENTER]** or **[START]** (to pause the game) and then select **Extras**. Highlight the extra you want to use from the available list, press **[ENTER]** or **[2]**, and toggle to turn the extra on or off.



Gold Bricks

Gold Bricks can be used to unlock rewards and bonus content. Gold Bricks are awarded for completing puzzles and tasks during lessons and Story Events, but additional Gold Bricks can be purchased (using LEGO studs) from the ground floor of **Eyloyps Owl Emporium**.



True Wizard Bar

Collect LEGO studs in each area of **LEGO Harry Potter™: Years 1-4** to fill up the True Wizard Bar. If you manage to fill the bar with studs before the end of the level, you'll be rewarded with a Gold Brick.



Super Kits

As you collect Hogwarts crest pieces in each year, you will be rewarded with a Super Kit piece which will be added to the cellar in the Leaky Cauldron. Collect all 24 crest pieces and you will be able to build a Super Kit to mark your achievement.

PAUSE MENU

Press **[ENTER]** or **[START]** during gameplay to freeze the game and access the Pause Menu. Use **[W]** / **[S]** or **[9]** / **[+]** to navigate the Pause Menu. Press **[ENTER]** or **[2]** to confirm your selection, and press **[ESC]** or **[3]** to go back a step.

- **RESUME** Return to gameplay.
- **OPTIONS** Change in-game sound effects, display settings and music volumes.
- **EXTRAS** Activate or deactivate Red Brick Extras.
- **EXIT** Depending upon where you are in the game, you may choose to exit to one or all of the following:

- **Return to Hogwarts** Allows you to exit any Story Event and return to Hogwarts castle.
- **The Leaky Cauldron** Will return you to the Leaky Cauldron (where you can select different game modes, visit the Diagon Alley shops, or explore Gringotts Bank).
- **Quit Game** Will return you to the Main Menu.
- **Save and Exit** In Free Play and Replay Mode, this option saves your progress as you exit a level—allowing you to save items you have collected without having to complete the level in its entirety.
