


YEAR 2 LEARN[®]

Master SNOOPY'S COLORING BOOK

The Coloring Book game is entertaining for people of all ages and skill levels. Once the Coloring Book is opened, you have thirty different black and white comics to color. Four different versions of each comic can be saved, allowing for a total of 120 saved images.



Crayon Selection: When you select a color from the Crayon Selection, the crayon will pop up and the narrator will say the color's name.

Crayon Size: Click on the Crayon Size to select the crayon's desired drawing size. This size can be changed at any time.

Erase All Button: Click once on the Erase All Button to clear the screen of all colors.

Eraser Size: Click on the Eraser Size to select the desired eraser size. Once selected, the eraser can remove color from the comic.

Camera Buttons: To save a drawing for later use, click on one of the four Camera Buttons. When a picture is saved, it appears in the small window of the Restore Button.

Forward and Backward Arrow Buttons: Click on these buttons to move forward or backward one picture. It is important to note that the picture you are currently working on will be erased when you use one of these buttons. To save the current picture, click on the Camera Button.

Doghouse Button: Click on the Doghouse Button to quit.

Print Button: Click on the print button to print your picture!

IMPORTANT!!!!

If the computer's screen saver becomes active when you are using the Coloring Book, the screen saver will erase the colors from your current picture. To prevent accidental erasing, frequently use the Camera Button to save drawings.

GETTING STARTED:

Macintosh: This product is normally shipped with either one CD-ROM disk or a low density floppy disk (800K).

Windows: This product is normally shipped with either one CD-ROM or one high density floppy 3.5 disk (1.4 MB). If you only have 5.25" floppy drives (1.2MB), please give us a call so we can send you a set of 5.25" floppies. See **Replacement Disks** below.

The basic system requirements are:

Macintosh: Please see your configuration label on the side of the box you purchased.

Windows: Please see your configuration label on the side of the box you purchased.

MACINTOSH INSTALLATION:

1. Begin the installation process by inserting the disk into the appropriate drive.
2. When the disk opens, double click on the **INSTALLER** icon to launch the installation program.
3. After the installation menu appears, select the destination drive of this program by clicking on the **DRIVE** button. By default, the installation program selects the same disk that contains your system folder. This is usually your hard disk.
4. Click on the **INSTALL** button. If a message appears stating that there is not enough hard disk space, you must quit the installation process. To quit the installation, click the **OK** button on the message box and then click the **STOP** button on the installation menu. Free additional hard disk space and then restart the installation process at Step One (1).
5. Click the **STOP** Button only if you need to interrupt the installation process. The installation process takes a few minutes, so this may be a good opportunity to fill out your product registration card. When the installation is complete, you will see a message that the software has been successfully installed.
6. Click on the **OK** Button.

Congratulations! You have successfully installed the program.

WINDOWS INSTALLATION:

1. Insert the disk into the appropriate disk drive.
2. From the program manager, open the **File** menu and select the **Run** command. When the **Run** dialog box is displayed, click the **Browse** button.
3. Select the drive where the disk is loaded (located in the Drives drop-down). A list of files from the disk appears in the **File Name** dialog box.
4. In the list of files, double-click on **GO.EXE** to start the installation process.
5. The **SET UP** program will ask you to provide the path for the directory where you want to install the program. By default, the directory path is **C:\(name of program)**. If you want to install the software elsewhere, type in another directory path or drive destination.
6. Click on the **OK** button. The installation takes a few minutes, so this is a good opportunity to fill out your product registration card. As files are installed, you will be prompted to insert each program disk in turn. Insert the appropriate disk and click the **OK** button. After installation is finished, you will find a new program group named **YEARN 2 LEARN** in your Program Manager.

Insufficient Disk Space:

If there is not enough hard disk space to install the program, a message will appear on the screen with instructions. After clicking the **OK** button, you may specify another destination drive, or you may quit the installation by clicking the **EXIT** button. Free additional hard disk space and then restart the installation process at Step 1.




Image Smith Software License Agreement
