

Windows® System Requirements

- 100 MHz or faster Pentium™ computer with 8MB of RAM or more
- Windows 95, 98, ME or XP
- Windows compatible sound card
- Double Speed CD ROM Drive or faster
- SVGA card (256colors) or better

Installing the program with Windows®

- Place Money Town Disc 1 in the CD-ROM drive.
- Select Start and then Run from the Windows Taskbar
- Type d:\setup and press ENTER. (If your CD-ROM drive is a different letter, type the appropriate letter.)
- Select Install Money Town

Starting the Program Windows®

- Place Money Town Disc1 in the CD-ROM drive.
- Select Start on the Windows Taskbar.
- Select Programs and then Money Town. Note: For additional help press F1.

Macintosh® System Requirements

- System 7.0.1 or higher
- 640x480 display
- Double Speed CD-ROM drive or faster

Running the Program on a Macintosh®

QuickTime™ must be installed on your system in order to run Money Town. If you do not have QuickTime or QuickTime™ Musical Instruments, double click the Install QuickTime icon.

- Insert Money Town Disc 1 into your CD-ROM drive.
- Double-click the Money Town Icon. Note: For additional help, Press ?.
