Windows

- "Click" means one press of the mouse button. "Double-click" means two presses of the mouse button.
- Some instructions are phrased as "Press-Or-Hold". This means "hold down the control button and the Q button on the keyboard, and then release".

INSTALLING NIGEL'S WORLD

To run properly, Nigel's World requires:

(PC)

- an IBM PC or compatible (386DX/33 MHz or better)
- Microsoft Windows 3.1 or later
- a Sound Blaster 16 or compatible sound card
- a Super VGA video card with a resolution of 640 x 480 with 256 colors.
- 2 MB of RAM required
- a double speed CD-ROM drive

(Macintosh)

- a 256-color capable Macintosh with a 68030 processor
- System 7 or later

- 2 MB of RAM (4 MB free)
- 640 x 480 resolution
- a double speed CD-ROM drive

To install Nigel's World (Windows 95):

1. Place the CD-ROM in your CD-ROM drive.
2. You will see the Kalfish ControlCenter window. From here, you can choose to install, quit, or read about other Kalfish Select files.
 - On some systems, the Kalfish ControlCenter window may need to be moved to view the prompt screens. Drag the ControlCenter screen down far enough on your monitor that the prompts can be viewed.
3. If you choose install, the install process will be initiated. You will receive prompts during installation, if necessary.
4. When installation is complete, quit the ControlCenter.
5. Double-click the Nigel's icon.

To install Nigel's World (Windows 3.1):

1. Place the CD-ROM in your CD-ROM drive.

- From Windows Program Manager, select Run from the File pull-down menu.
- Double-click "Browse".
- Select your CD-ROM drive (usually D).
- Select "startgame", and then click "OK".
- The KidSoft ControlCenter window will appear, and from here, you may choose to install, quit, or read about other KidSoft titles.
- If you choose install, the install process will be initiated. You will receive prompts as necessary.
 - On some systems, the KidSoft ControlCenter window may need to be maximized to view the prompt screens. Drag the ControlCenter screen down far enough on your monitor that the prompts can be viewed.
 - The KidSoft ControlCenter window may minimize during installation, or may disappear behind any other open windows. If it has minimized, it must be restored in order to Quit. If it has reappeared behind other open windows, those windows will need to be minimized in order to quit the KidSoft ControlCenter.
- Click "Quit" inside ControlCenter when the installation is complete.

To install Nigel's World (Macintosh):

- Turn off all virus protection.
- Double-click the Nigel's World icon on the desktop.
- Double-click the Nigel's World icon in the window.

PLAYING NIGEL'S WORLD

- Place the CD-ROM in your CD-ROM drive.
- If you are using Windows 95, you can launch Nigel's World from the Taskbar by clicking Start, highlighting Programs, highlighting Lawrence, highlighting Nigel's World, and click. If you are using Windows 3.1, double-click on the Nigel's World icon in the Lawrence program group. If you are using a Macintosh, double-click the Nigel's World icon on the desktop, then double-click the Nigel's World icon in the window.

Play begins with an introduction to the Photography contest. After that, we see Nigel at home.

- To start play, click on the tea machine button on the right of the screen.

1. Nigel will then receive an assignment. He may choose to accept or deny the assignment (depending on whether "thumbs up" or "thumbs down" gets clicked).
2. If the assignment is accepted, Nigel will fly to the site...as soon as the correct continent is clicked on.

Nigel specializes in photos of people, landmarks, and animals. Once he finds his destination, he must budget his time to get all the photographs he needs, and get back to King's office by the deadline. As he makes all his deadlines, he gets points, and when all the assignments are completed, he gets up to the next level. Buttons become active and inactive as necessary.

Each level has tougher deadlines, and requires more knowledge of geography. If Nigel needs help, he can consult the *Encyclopedia*...but each use costs five points, and he can only get five clues per continent per assignment.

TECHNICALSUPPORT (PC):

My monitor is not displaying the graphics and animations properly. Check that the video driver is set to display at full a 600 resolution in 256 colors.

TECHNICALSUPPORT (Macintosh):

1. Turn off all virus protection before installing software.
2. Make sure you don't have duplicate versions of the same extension (QuickTime, QuickTime 1.0).
3. Close all other applications.
4. Turn off virtual memory and file sharing.
5. Set monitor to 256 colors with a resolution of 640 x 480.
