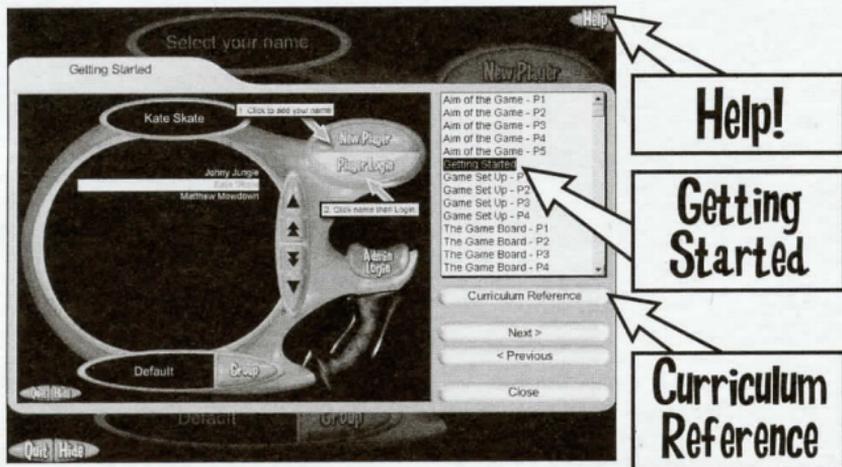




# Quickstart

## 1. Getting Started

For full Instructions on getting started, click on the "Help" button at the top right hand corner of the screen then on "Getting Started" from the contents.



## 2. Passwords

The Admin Login password is "Admin".

Player passwords may be viewed in the Admin section.

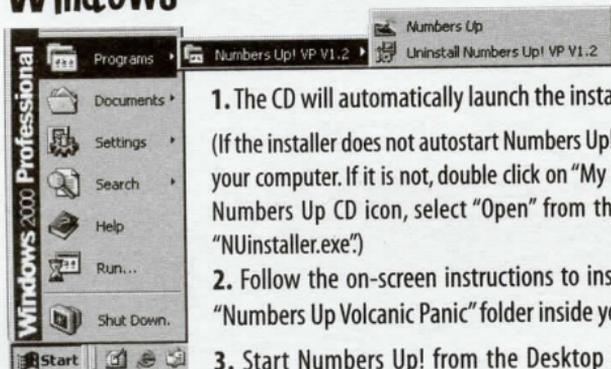
## 3. Curriculum Reference

# Installation

## Windows



1. The CD will automatically launch the installer program.

(If the installer does not autostart Numbers Up! may already be installed on your computer. If it is not, double click on "My Computer", right click on the Numbers Up CD icon, select "Open" from the menu, then double click "NUinstaller.exe")

2. Follow the on-screen instructions to install Numbers Up! into the "Numbers Up Volcanic Panic" folder inside your Program Files folder.

3. Start Numbers Up! from the Desktop Shortcut or Start Menu - Programs. (You may need to scroll down the programs list to see it.)

## MacOS



1. Double click the "Numbers Up" CD icon on your desktop.

### 2. Classic Users (System 8.1-9)

Drag the "Numbers Up Classic" folder to your hard drive.

### OSX Users

Drag the "Numbers Up OSX" folder to your hard drive.

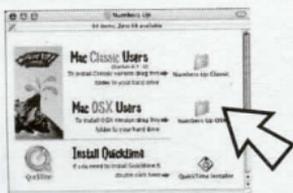
3. To run the software double click the "Numbers Up" icon in the folder on your hard drive. The software will not run from the CD.

### 4. Quicktime - Classic Users (System 8.1-9)

If you do not have Quicktime 5.02 or later installed on your computer double click the "Install Quicktime" button.

If you do not have Quicktime installed, you can still play the game but the program will generate an error each time it tries to play a movie. If this happens click "OK" then "Yes", to continue, or click "OK" then "No" to quit. To install Quicktime double click the "Install Quicktime" icon.

## OSX



### Quicktime - OSX Users

The Quicktime install is for "Classic" Users only. OSX will already have a recent version of Quicktime installed.
