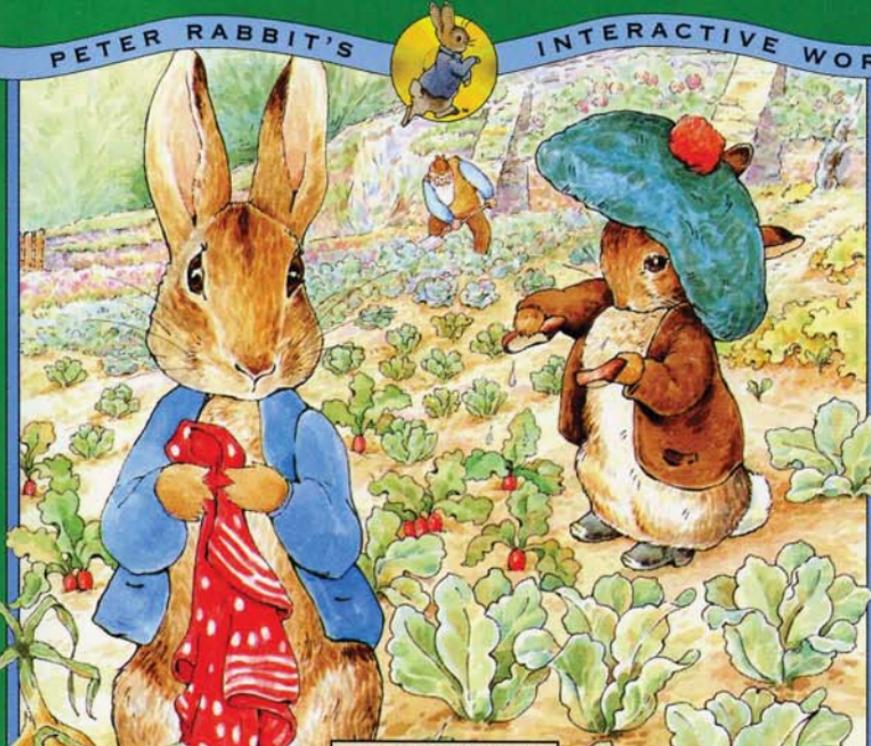

Installing in Windows

To setup and run *The Adventures of Peter Rabbit & Benjamin Bunny* in Windows 3.1:

1. Run Windows.
2. Insert the disc into the CD-ROM drive, label side up.
3. Open the **File** menu and select **Run**.
4. In the Command Line, type **D:\SETUP.EXE** and click **OK**.

Note: If your CD-ROM drive is another letter, substitute it for D in the Command Line. For example, type E:\SETUP.EXE and click OK.

5. Select American English or British English and click **OK**.
6. When the install program runs, type the destination directory and click **OK**. If you want to accept the default directory, **C:\PRABBIT**, just click **OK**. The install program copies the necessary files to your hard disk.

*Note: The program prompts you to install Microsoft video for Windows 1.1. Click **Continue** to install.*

7. Double-click the **Peter Rabbit** icon in the **Beatrix Potter** program group to run the program.

To setup and run *The Adventures of Peter Rabbit & Benjamin Bunny* in Windows 95:

1. Run Windows 95
2. Put the disc in your CD-ROM drive, label side up.
3. At the Peter Rabbit autorun screen, click **Install**.
4. Select **American English** or **British English** and click **OK**.
5. When the install program runs, type the destination directory and click **OK**. If you want to accept the default directory, **C:\Program Files\Mindscape\Peter Rabbit**, just click **OK**. The install program copies the necessary files to your hard disk for *The Adventures of Peter Rabbit & Benjamin Bunny*.

*Note: The program prompts you to install Microsoft video for Windows 1.1. Click **Continue** to install.*

6. To run the program, double-click the **Peter Rabbit Stories** icon in the **Beatrix Potter** folder, or click **Run** at the autorun screen.

Installing on the Macintosh

To setup and run *The Adventures of Peter Rabbit & Benjamin Bunny* on the Macintosh:

1. Insert the disc into the CD-ROM drive, label side up.
2. Double-click the **Peter Rabbit CD** icon.
3. Double-click the **Peter Rabbit Stories Installer** icon.
4. Select **American English** or **British English** and **Power Macintosh** or **Standard Macintosh** and click **Install**.
5. Click **Install** to copy the program files into the **Peter Rabbit Stories** folder.
6. Double-click the **Peter Rabbit** icon in the **Peter Rabbit Stories** folder on your hard drive .

The Options Menu

After the program loads, press **F2** in Windows or **Control+P** on the Macintosh to see the **Options Menu**.



From the **Options Menu** you can set your preferences. Choose from the following:

Sound Effects: Click here to turn sound effects on or off.

Music: Click here to turn music on or off.

American/British English: You have the option to determine whether the story uses American or British spellings, pronunciations, and idiomatic expressions.

Child Lock: To prevent your child from opening the **Options Menu** and from exiting the program, turn this option on.

Printer Lock: To prevent your child from using the printer without supervision, turn this option on.

Read Phrases/Words: Select one of these two options to determine whether individual words or groups of words are read when your child requests rereading.

Add Child: Click this button to add your child's name to the **Bookplate** at the beginning of the program.

Remove Child: Click this button to remove a child's name from the **Bookplate**.

Reading Tips: Click here to read Dr. Paul Melmed's tips on educating your child at home.

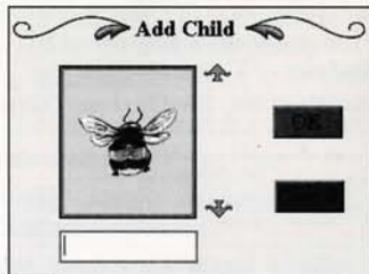
*Note: To change the volume of the sound in the program, press **Ctrl+1-7**; one being the softest, and 7 the loudest. Press **Ctrl+0** to turn sound off.*

Personalizing the Bookplate with Your Child's Name and Icon



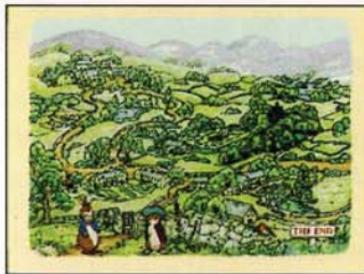
The help bird instructs you how to find your child's name. If more than one name has been entered, click the blue arrow until you come to your child's name. If your child's name has not been entered, press **F2** or **Control+P** on the Macintosh or **F2** in Windows for the **Options Menu**.

1. From the **Options Menu**, click the **Add Child** button and the **Add Child** dialog appears.



2. Type your child's name.
3. Use the arrows to find the picture you want to be on your child's **Bookmark** and **Bookplate**.
4. Click **OK** to return to the **Options Menu**.
5. After setting your preferences, click **OK** to return to the **Bookplate**.
6. Click the green arrow at the bottom right corner of the **Bookplate** to continue the program. After you fly over Peter Rabbit's world, the **Main Map** appears.

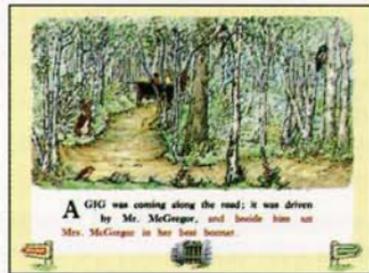
The Main Map



- To begin a story, click Peter Rabbit or Benjamin Bunny at the gate.
- To return to your place in the story, click the **Bookmark**. (Note: only available after you have been in the story.)
- To explore Peter Rabbit's world and access activities, click one of the cameos which appear as you move your cursor over the screen. Discover games, nursery rhymes, and hot spots as you play in Peter Rabbit's World.
- To exit the program, click **The End** sign, or press **Alt+F4** in Windows, or **⌘Q** on the Macintosh.

The Story Page

After you click Peter Rabbit or Benjamin Bunny from the the **Main Map**, he hops through the gate and the story begins. First the title screen and then the **Story Page** appears.



There are many fun things to do on each story page:

- Watch the characters animate while Beatrix Potter reads the story.
- To have the story read continuously to you, click the help bird on the first story page.
- To hear a page again, click the big blue letter.
- Click a red word to go to **Peter Rabbit's Glossary**.

- Click the red arrow at the bottom-left of the screen to return to the previous story page.
- Click the green arrow at the bottom-right of the screen to go to the next story page.
- Move your cursor over the screen. When the cursor changes from an arrow to a bird, your cursor is over a hotspot. Click the mouse button then watch and listen for what happens.
- If the hotspot is twinkling, it is a game.
- If a red arrow appears on a path, you can pan the diorama or go to a new one. Click your bookmark to return to the story.
- Click the gate to return to the **Main Map**.

The Glossary

When you are in the Glossary:

- To go to the words beginning with a specific letter, click that letter.
- To scroll through the words alphabetically, click the red and green arrows.
- To return to the **Story Page**, click the **Bookmark**.

Printing

- You have the option to print any of the puzzles, the dot-to-dots, the Gardening Tips, and Mrs. Bunny's recipes. Just click the printer icon in the lower right corner of your screen.
- To print the current glossary word, click the printer icon.

*Note: the printer icon does not appear when **Printer Lock** is ON.*

 - K. Version of Windows. Example: Windows NT, Windows 3.1, Windows 3.1.1, Workgroups, or Windows 95.
