WINDOWS INSTALLATION AND START-UP

Make sure you have 45 MB of free hard-disk space.

These instructions assume that the AutoPlay feature of Windows 95/98 is turned on. (AutoPlay is usually enabled when you install Windows 95/98 on your computer. See your Windows documentation for more information.)

To set up the program:

1. Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive.
2. Click on Yes at the install prompt to begin the setup process.
3. Once you've completed the setup, the program will run automatically anytime you insert the program CD into the CD-ROM drive.

To start the program:

1. Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive.
2. Click on Play. Whenever you exit the program, you return to the desktop. You can restart the program directly from the desktop as long as the CD is still in the CD-ROM drive. (These instructions also apply if AutoPlay is turned off.)

To start the program from the desktop:

- Click on the Start button. Then choose Programs, The Learning Company, and 1st Grade in that order.

MACINTOSH INSTALLATION AND START-UP

Make sure you have 45 MB of free hard-disk space.

To set up the program:

1. Insert CD into your CD-ROM drive.
2. Double-click on Reader Rabbit 1st Grade Launcher, and follow the onscreen instructions.

To start the program:

1. Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive.
2. Open the Reader Rabbit 1st Grade folder on your hard drive, and double-click on the Reader Rabbit 1st Grade program icon.

To install Acrobat Reader, follow the onscreen instructions during the program setup process. Then choose Print from the File menu to print out the guide.


