

# Thank you for purchasing Quicken Personal Finance Software 2007 for Mac.

This document contains important information that you may find helpful when installing and using Quicken 2007.

## System requirements

- Macintosh computer with a PowerPC or Intel Core processor
- Mac OS X, v10.3.9 "Panther" or v10.4.6 "Tiger"
- 50MB of available hard disk space
- Intuit checks and a laser or inkjet printer, if you want to print checks
- .Mac account if you want to back up your data file to an iDisk

Annual membership fee and Internet access required.

- Internet access is required for some features, including online banking

Online features require Internet access and are subject to change. Services vary among participating financial institutions or other parties and may be subject to application approval, additional terms, conditions, and fees.

## Before installing Quicken 2007

If you're upgrading from any previous version of Quicken, do the following things before installing Quicken 2007:

- Make a backup copy of your Quicken data file(s). If possible, store your backup copy on a removable disk or lock the backup copy. (To lock a file, select the file in the Finder, choose File > Show Info, and select the Locked checkbox.)
- Keep your Quicken data file in your Documents folder. This allows you to upgrade to new versions of Quicken without having to move your data file to a new location each year.
- Quit any previous versions of Quicken that are running.

## Converting from a previous version of Quicken

Any data file created with Quicken 3 or later will be converted to the Quicken 2007 format when you first open it. Quicken also backs up the file to Documents/Quicken Backup Folder/Old Quicken Data. Keep this backup copy in case you ever need to open the data file with your previous version of Quicken, because your converted Quicken 2007 file cannot be used with previous versions of Quicken.

Once you've installed Quicken 2007, we recommend that you remove any previous versions of Quicken from your hard disk. After you have done so, double-click your data file icon to launch Quicken 2007.

## Installation

To install Quicken 2007, insert the Quicken CD in your CD-ROM drive and double-click the Install Quicken 2007 icon. Do not copy the Quicken installer to your hard drive before running it; doing so may result in installation failure.

- Mac OS 10.4: The Finder may incorrectly display your Quicken data file as a folder after creating a backup file (File > Back Up > To Disk) or a copy of your file (File > Save a Copy). You can open either file by dragging it to the Quicken application icon. Restarting your computer, or logging out and then logging back in, will cause the Finder to refresh and display the file correctly.
