Adventurer by Rob Birnholz
Type1 - This all-caps italic font is good for headings or any print that you want to stand out.



Herald by Dave Nalle
TrueType and Type1 - This collection of heraldic shields is drawn from coats of arms and medieval sources. They demonstrate many aspects of heraldic symbology and make excellent accents or spot illustrations.

Washout WASHOUT THIN

Washout by Russell G. Taber
Type1 - Best for headlines, Washout is a complete typeface including upper and lowercase letters, numbers, and standard punctuation.

WoolyBull

WoolyBull by Russell G. Taber
Type1 - This is a heavy, fuzzy, and wavy typeface.

Patriot Command v1.0 by Antonio Lagana
The object of Patriot Command is to protect world cities from an onslaught of ICBMs that an unnamed whimsical fascist dictator decided to launch against the world. The world's only defenses are three Patriot missile silos which you command. Each Patriot missile is capable of creating an explosion large and powerful enough to destroy any enemy objects engulfed by it. Requires a Macintosh II or better with a 256-color/gray scale monitor.

Creepin' Critter Math by Bruce A. Pokras
Four cockroaches are crawling up a wall toward four picture frames containing possible answers to math problems at the bottom of the screen. The student has to swat the bug below the correct answer before one of the bugs disappears under its picture frame. If the wrong bug is swatted, the other three keep crawling, and give the student an extra chance.

KanaLab v1.0 by Tom Naughton
KanaLab is a program to help beginning students of Japanese learn the Hiragana and Katakana syllabaries. It introduces new characters a few at a time and then drills the student, using the digitized sounds of the characters. The program keeps track of which characters the student has difficulty with and drills those characters more frequently until all characters are equally mastered.

BabySmash v5.0 by Justin Cohen
Keep your young kids happy without them accidentally dragging your word processor into the trash can. It basically just puts up random shapes and plays random sounds when your kid smashes on the keyboard.

SAT Quizzer by Phil Sarin
This vocabulary quizzer includes a complete high-frequency word list according to Barron's. Additional vocabulary words besides those in Barron's list can also be added.

SndControl v2.2.2 by Riccardo Ettore
Like Apple's Sound Control Panel, SndControl allows you to change the sound your Mac utters whenever it needs to beep at you. Unlike Apple, this allows you to assign sounds to more than 30 distinct events, instead of just the beep.

The information is arranged like pages in a book (called a stack). Requires HyperCard or HyperCard Run-Time.

Font - Typefaces.
Types to expect are Type 1, Type 3, and TrueType.

INIT/CDEV
INIT (Initialization Resource - also called a startup document): Program that automatically loads into your computer upon each bootup.
CDEV (Control Panel Device): Files in the System Folder located in the Control Panel of the Apple Menu. Each CDEV corresponds to a particular System setting.
