BLACKHAWK

BlackHawk by John Singer

TrueType and Type1 — BlackHawk font is a complete upper case alphabet with numbers and some punctuation based on an "old West" type font.

Delilah

Delilah by Patricia Lillie

TrueType and Type1 — Delilah is a narrow, bold display face with upper and lower case letters, punctuation, basic symbols, and alternates for some uppercase letters. No diacritical or special symbols. The letters are rectangular and tightly spaced.

Greeting v1.5 by Sam Wang

TrueType and Type1 — Here's a new and unusual typeface to use as body text.



Jugend by RAGNAROK

TrueType and Type1 — This is a decorative caps font based on a set of capitals which originated in the 19th century German magazine, Munchner Jugend. The characters are made up of bizarre human and animal faces growing out of pieces of wood with floral backgrounds. The font is very clear and will go well with just about any serif or art nouveau text font.

Heat/LightStack by Lyle Doe

This is an informative stack for elementary science about the source of heat and light energy on Earth.

Bird Gallery by Clare Shumway

Open this extraordinary album with 18 color photographs of a variety of birds: Anhinga, Canada Gosling, Carolina Wren, Great Egret, Greenbacked Heron, Mute Swans, Brown Pelican, Red-shouldered Hawks, Redhead Duck, Roseate Spoonbills, Tricolored Heron, Tufted Titmouse, White Ibis and Male Wood Duck.

Piston v1.0 by C.K. Haun

DepthMaster v1.0 by Victor Tan

With this handy extension you can now set what monitor bit depth and sound volume you want an application to be launched. It will also restore the previous monitor bit setting and sound volume level when quitting an application that required a change. You can also set what monitor bit depth you wish your Macintosh to start up in. Requires System 7.x.

Coloring Book v1.1 by Jim Allison

In this unique coloring book you can color your own pictures and play sounds that accompany the pictures. A Nite Lite section simulates the popular children's toy in which colored plastic pegs are placed into a black pegboard to make pictures. A small light bulb illuminates the peg-picture from behind. Requires 13" color monitor.



KEY TO SYMBOLS

Application

An application is a program that does not require any other program to run.

HyperCard

The information is arranged like pages in a book (called a stack). Requires HyperCard or HyperCard Run-Time.

Font - Typefaces.

Types to expect are Type 1, Type 3, and TrueType.

INIT/CDEV

INIT (Initialization Resource — also called a startup document): Program that automatically loads into your computer upon each bootup.
CDEV (Control Panel Device): Files in the System Folder located in the Control Panel of the Apple Menu. Each CDEV corresponds to a particular System setting.
