Cheneau

Cheneau by Dan Carr

Type 1 - Cheneau has the quality of free-hand drawing and serifs are not duplicated or pasted on.

FUNK

Funk by John Hopper IV

TrueType - This smooth and tall font is mainly for printed text and not recommended as a screen font.

Hotshot

Hotshot by Walter Kaffon-Minkel

Type 1 - Hotshot is based on scans from a 1930's sign-painting manual.

KARATE

Karate

Type 1 - Karate has an oriental flavor. Lower case characters are small versions of the upper case set. Numerals and basic punctuation are included. It is best for display and headlines or any use that suggests an international concept.

Application

An application is a program that does not require any other program to run.

HyperCard

The information is arranged like pages in a book (called a stack). Requires HyperCard or HyperCard Run-Time.

Font - Typefaces.

Types to expect are Type 1, Type 3, and TrueType.

INIT/CDEV

INIT (Initialization Resource - also called a startup document): Program that automatically loads into your computer upon each bootup.

CDEV (Control Panel Device): Files in the System Folder located in the Control Panel of the Apple Menu. Each CDEV corresponds to a particular System setting.
