Calculate a checksum and a CRC32 on both the data and resource forks of any file you drop on the application icon. This is useful if you want to compare two files that are not on the same machine without having to copy them over a network or modem connection.

Have Hyperdog roll over, sit-up, and beg!

### DISK THREE

#### ☞ MenuChoice by Kerry Clendinning

This Control Panel device enables hierarchical menus under the Apple menu. With it you can quickly open applications, control panel devices, and documents of all kinds.

#### ◆ MacNote by Peter H. Jergens

This program acts as a post-it-note system for the computer. No more little sheets of paper all over your desk!

### FEATURE PROGRAM

#### ◆ NIH Image v1.51

This image processing and analysis program can acquire, display, edit, enhance, analyze, print and animate images. It will read and write TIFF, PICT, PICS and MacPaint files, providing compatibility with many other applications, including programs for scanning, processing, editing, publishing and analyzing images. Many standard image processing functions are supported, including contrast enhancement, density profiling, smoothing, sharpening, edge detection, median filtering, and spatial convolution with user-defined kernels up to 63x63. This program also incorporates a Pascal-like macro programming language, providing the ability to automate complex, and frequently repetitive, processing tasks.

#### Documents for NIH Image

#### ☞ ARME by Leander Harding

The huge dam over your mountain town has broken, and everything is being washed away! In anticipation of a dam break, your town commissioned six large robotic arms, lettered A through F, and stationed them on towers throughout the town. It is your job to use arm "E" to save the town.

#### ◆ Parrot v1.0b1 by Bernard Bernstein

Parrot listens to the sound input device, remembers everything it hears, and plays everything back in a random order. If your Mac has stereo capability, the program will also randomly choose a speaker to play each sound. The more memory the program has allocated, the more sounds it will remember.

#### ☞ PrintChoice by Kerry Clendinning

This Control Panel device provides a quick way to rechoose a printer without going back into the Apple chooser.

### KEY TO SYMBOLS

#### ◆ Application

An application is a program that does not require any other program to run.

#### ☞ HyperCard

The information is arranged like pages in a book (called a stack). Requires HyperCard or HyperCard Run-Time.

#### ☞ Font - Typefaces.

Types to expect are Type 1, Type 3, and TrueType.

#### ☞ INIT/CDEV

INIT (Initialization Resource — also called a startup document): Program that automatically loads into your computer upon each bootup.

CDEV (Control Panel Device): Files in the System Folder located in the Control Panel of the Apple Menu. Each CDEV corresponds to a particular System setting.
