◆ Font - Typefaces.

Types to expect are Type 1, Type 3, and TrueType.

◆ INIT/CDEV

INIT (Initialization Resource — also called a startup document): Automatically loads into your computer upon each bootup.

CDEV (Control Panel Device): Files in the System Folder located in the Control Panel of the Apple Menu. Each CDEV corresponds to a particular System setting.
