

Saturday Night Live Goes Political for Windows

Note: The CD-ROM enclosed contains both the Windows and Macintosh versions of the program. However, you will only be able to read and view those files on your copy specific to the platform you are using.

Minimum System Requirements

To install and run **Saturday Night Live Goes Political** for Windows, you must have an IBM PC or compatible that meets these system requirements:

- 486DX/33 microprocessor
- Windows 3.1x or Windows 95
- 8MB of RAM
- 4MB of free hard disk space
- 2X CD-ROM drive
- Video display capable of at least 640x480 resolution with 256 colors (16-bit recommended)
- SoundBlaster 16-bit or compatible multimedia sound card
- Mouse required

Saturday Night Live Goes Political will not run on any 286 or 386 processor.

Installing and Running on Windows 95

QuickTime™ for Windows

To run **Saturday Night Live Goes Political**, you must have QuickTime™ for Windows, version 2.03 installed.

Which Version of QuickTime™ for Windows Do You Have Installed?

To determine which version of QuickTime™ for Windows you have installed:

- Select the **Start** button from the Taskbar
- Select the Settings group.

- Select the Control Panels folder.

If the QuickTime™ icon is present within this group, you have a version of QuickTime™ for Windows which is NEWER than version 2.03. You will NOT want to install the QuickTime™ version we have supplied. (See **Installing the Program** below.) If the QuickTime™ icon does not exist in this group, then you either have the correct version of QuickTime™, an older version, or none at all. If this is the case, you WILL want to install the version of QuickTime™ we have supplied. (See **Installing the Program** below.)

Installing and Running on Windows 3.1x

QuickTime™ for Windows

Saturday Night Live Goes Political for Macintosh

Minimum System Requirements

To run **Saturday Night Live Goes Political** for Macintosh you must have a Macintosh computer that meets these system requirements:

- 68040-25mhz based Macintosh LC, Quadra, Centris, Performa, or Powerbook or any Power Macintosh
- System 7.1 of the Macintosh OS
- QuickTime™ & QuickTime™ PowerPlug version 2.1 (included)
- 8MB of RAM
- 2X speed CD-ROM drive
- Color monitor capable of at least 256 colors (thousands recommended) and 640x480 resolution
- Mouse required

Saturday Night Live Goes Political will not run on any 68030-based or earlier Macintosh.

Installing and Running on Macintosh

QuickTime™ for Macintosh

To run **Saturday Night Live Goes Political**, you must have QuickTime™ for Macintosh, version 2.1 installed.

Which Version of QuickTime™ for Macintosh Do You Have Installed?

To determine which version of QuickTime™ for Macintosh you have installed

- Open your Extensions folder, located within your System Folder.
- Select/highlight the QuickTime™ item.
- From the File menu, select Get Info.

If your version is older than 2.1... you must install QuickTime™ for Macintosh, version 2.1

- Restart your computer while holding down the Shift-Key.
- Locate QuickTime™ (and QuickTime™ PowerPlug if you have it).
- Drag it into the Trash.
- Empty the Trash.
- Restart your computer.
- Insert the **SNL Goes Political** CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive.
- Open the **put into system f** by double-clicking on it.
- Select both items and drag into your Extensions folder.
- Restart your computer.

If you do not have QuickTime™ for Macintosh installed ... you must install it.

- Insert the **SNL Goes Political** CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive.
- Open the **put into system f** by double-clicking on it.
- Select both items and drag into your Extensions folder.
- Restart your computer.

If you already have QuickTime™ for Macintosh, version 2.1 or a newer version of QuickTime™ installed ... then continue.

Installing the Program

You do not have to install **Saturday Night Live Goes Political** for Macintosh.

Running the Program

- Insert the CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive.
- After the **SNL** group displays, double-click on the icon titled **SNL Goes Political**.

If your Macintosh meets the minimum system requirements, the program will launch.

You must leave the **SNL Goes Political** CD-ROM in your CD-ROM drive to play **Saturday Night Live Goes Political**. You will need your mouse and keyboard.

Note: Returning to the Voting Booth from each game is as easy as selecting **Voting Booth** at the bottom of the gaming area.

Newt's House

How about it? Try to pass the Contract with America. Set your speed level (Freshman, Incumbent or Statesman) and select **Start Game**. Move your cursor over Newt. Move him left or right by dragging your mouse. Try to hammer out as many bills, amendments, and yes, even fellow politicians, as you can while you still are in office by clicking on your mouse. Hurry, the goal is as many as possible before lunch! Watch your score and rating climb as you try to renew America.

If you get off to a bad start and want to restart, select **New Game**.

To pause the game, simply move the cursor to any point below the speed setting.

Return to the Voting Booth by selecting **Voting Booth** at the bottom of the game.

Road To The White House

President Clinton has escaped the Secret Service and will try to eat his way home. Help him by controlling his pathway back to the White House. To start the game use your arrow keys to move Bill around the grid while the Secret Service agents chase him at every corner. If you get him close enough to home don't be surprised if the First Lady makes a guest appearance to try to catch her burgergobbling husband.

Chart his course carefully, because once the Secret Service agents catch Bill, they will not let him go. Eating the "bonus" pill, however, protects him from them for a limited time. He has five neighborhoods to eat through before he returns home.

Pause the game at any time by pressing "P" or by clicking on the PAUSE button. Change your game speed at any time by pressing "S" or by clicking on the SPEED button.

Watch the score climb as you get closer to home and closer to victory.

Return to the Voting Booth by selecting **Voting Booth** at the bottom of the game.

Politico Puzzle

Choose your puzzle and then race the clock to put the pieces back together again. Be careful or time will run out as you try to piece together your fallen leaders. Use the mouse to select the piece you would like to move or try turbo mode by using the arrow keys to slide your pieces around.

If you just aren't getting anywhere and you'd like a hint, simply select the View button to see the puzzle fully assembled. Select Return to resume.

Return to the Voting Booth by selecting **Voting Booth** at the bottom of the game.

Party Agenda

Work with gravity to please your party's leader by collecting as many party buttons as you can. The object of the game is to move game piece rows over to allow your buttons to fall. Move the rows strategically and your buttons will eventually fall to the bottom, tallying points for your side as they do. The first party to collect 10 buttons wins.

First, you must select which party you want to join. The computer becomes your opponent as a member of the other party. Democrats are always on the left in blue and Republicans on the right in red. Remember your color. When it's your turn to move a row, arrows will appear in your party color. Make your move by selecting one of the arrows. Selecting an arrow shifts the row of game pieces in the corresponding direction. Selecting an arrow which points left, for example, will shift the row of game pieces one position to the left. Pieces pushed off one side of the board will be pushed onto the other. Your opponent's colored arrow will then appear and he will make his move.

Return to the Voting Booth by selecting **Voting Booth** at the bottom of the game.

Games Help

Additional help for each game is available by clicking on **HELP**.

Volume

Raise or lower the sound by using the 1-7 number keys on your keyboard.

Quit and Help



Help text is available to you at any time. Simply select **HELP**. Additional help for each game is available by clicking on **HELP** from within each game.

Select **Quit** to exit **Saturday Night Live goes Political**.

Note: You cannot Quit the program or access Help from within the Campaigns area. To do either, simply return to the Voting Booth by selecting **the flashing Voting Booth button**. See **Elections** above.

Troubleshooting

Video appears grainy or of bad quality on Windows

You are running in a low-resolution color-display mode (256 colors). You need to switch to a higher one if your video hardware supports it.

Using Windows 95:

- Right-select your mouse on the desktop
- Select **Properties**.
- From the Display Properties page, select the **Settings** tab
- From the Color Palette group, select **High Color 16-bit**
- Select **Apply**.

You will now have to restart Windows 95 for this change to be implemented.

NOTE: A 24-bit or better color depth setting is not supported.

Using Windows 3.1x:

Video is choppy or rough.
