Installation

WINDOWS

1. Insert the Miss Spider disk into your CD-ROM drive. Wait a moment and a window will appear on your screen, displaying three buttons: "Install", "Quit" and "Options".

NOTE: You can change the target disk for the installation by clicking on "Options". Then select the local disk in which you would like to install the game using the left and right arrows at the bottom of the window.

2. Click on the "Install" button to start installing the game. The files will be copied from the disk to your computer.

3. If QuickTime 6 is not already installed on your computer, a message will be displayed asking you if you would like to install it. Click on the "Install" button to launch the installation of QuickTime 6.

NOTE: If QuickTime is already installed, the installation of the game will be complete at that point. Click on "Play" to start playing the game.

MACINTOSH

1. Insert the Miss Spider disk into your CD-ROM drive. The CD-ROM icon will appear on your desktop.

2. Double-click on the CD-ROM icon and the CD-ROM window will open.

3. Click on the "Installer" icon. A window will appear on your screen, displaying three buttons: "Install", "Quit" and "Options".

4. Click on the "Install" button to start installing the game. The files will be copied from the disk to your computer.

INSTALLATION OF QUICKTIME 6

Follow the instructions of the QuickTime 6 installer. Click on "Next" to continue the installation. You can safely accept the installation default settings. These settings can be modified later.

Uninstalling

WINDOWS AND MACINTOSH

1. Insert the Miss Spider disk into your CD-ROM drive. A window allowing you to "Play" or "Quit" will appear on your screen.

2. As indicated at the bottom of the window, press "U" while holding down the "Shift" key on your keyboard to uninstall the game. A message asking you to confirm that you want to uninstall will appear.

3. Click on "Yes" to confirm. The game will be uninstalled and the files of the game removed from your computer.



Introduction

Join Miss Spider's Sunny Patch Friends on four exciting scavenger hunts filled with fun and challenging activities. Help Bounce, Squirt, Shimmer and Dragon find all the things on the lists Miss Spider gives to each of them. As you help the "best bug buddies" visit the whimsical, miniature world of Sunny Patch you will also meet many other characters from the Miss Spider's Sunny Patch Friends TV series.



Two ways to play!

When you start the game you can choose between two game options: "Complete Game" and "Activities Only". If this is the first time you are playing we recommend the "Complete Game". Later you may want to just play your favourite activity; in that case you should select "Activities Only".



Before you begin...

If you have selected "Complete Game" you have a few choices to make before you begin to play the game. First you need to choose an icon to identify your saved games. Write your name under the icon if you wish. (Four different players can save up to 8 games each).



Then, you must choose the difficulty level for the activities. If you are not sure what level to choose, we suggest that you start with level one.



The Cozy Hole

Here you will meet Miss Spider and the best bug buddies: Shimmer, Squirt, Bounce and Dragon. Choose which bug buddy you will help first. You can always make your way back to the Cozy Hole and pick a different character. Each scavenger hunt can be interrupted and continued later.



The Scavenger Hunts

Once you have chosen a best bug buddy, you will explore Sunny Patch to find all the items on the list.

The Scavenger Hunt List

During the scavenger hunts, a leaf-shaped button will appear on the bottom left of the screen. Click on the leaf to see the list of items you must gather to complete the scavenger hunt.

Your inventory

On the right hand side of the screen there is a hidden panel. It will open automatically when you pick up an item. You can also open and close it any time by clicking on the blue button of the panel.

Options

At the bottom of the inventory panel you will see a picture of Miss Spider. If you click on it you will be taken to the options screen.

(See the description of the Options section below).

Getting back...

When you are on a scavenger hunt and you want to go back to the Cozy Hole click on the sign with Miss Spider's picture on it. To go from one exploration area to another, just click on the sign representing that area.



Options Screen

The Options screen gives you the following choices:

New Game

Starts a new game (Careful: your current game will not saved).

Load Game

Click on this button if you want to load a previously saved game.

Save Game

Click on this button to save the game you are now playing.

Credits

Click here to see the names of the people who have created this fun game.

Volume

Here you can adjust the volume of the sound.

Quit

Click here when you are ready to leave the game.



Automatic saving

When you quit the game, your progress will be automatically saved. To continue the game, click on the same mushroom icon you selected in your last game. On the following menu screen, click on the "Load Game" button. Your most recent game is represented by the leaf icon at the bottom centre of the screen. Click on it and you will start the game from where you were the last time you played.



Keyboard Commands

SPACE BAR

Can be used to skip animations, activity instructions and the movies at the beginning and end of the game. Be careful, most of this content is really entertaining so you won't want to miss anything.

ESC

CTRL + Q (Windows),
APPLE + Q (Mac)

Keeping these keys pressed will allow you to quit the game.

Activities

There are nine different activities to be discovered and completed. There are two activities in each of the four scavenger hunts. The ninth activity is only available if you finish the four scavenger hunts successfully and it is not available in the Activities menu.
