slick manual

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install Slick 1


- 1 **Quit** iMovie if it is running.
- 2 **Launch** the SlickTransitions & Effects Installer application. The installer works under Mac OS X and OS 9. You will be asked to enter a serial number.
- 3 The Installer automatically places the correct files for either Mac OS X or OS 9 in the correct folders for you automatically.

installation tips

Under OS X, if you get an error message appears stating insufficient privileges to make changes, log out and log back in as the administrator of your Mac OS X computer. The Installer needs to place a support file in the :Library:CFMSupport folder. For more information, see "Working as an administrator" in Mac Help.

You can also select the CFMSupport folder, select Get Info (Command-I) under the File menu, and check to see that you have Read & Write Privileges for this folder.

Under OS 9 if you get an installation error that a folder can not be found, the iMovie Plugins folder has been removed or the name of the folder has been changed. Please make sure that there is a folder named Plugins inside the iMovie Resources folder and that there is a Transitions folder inside the Plugins folder.



very slick transitions


Use a Slick transition to add a smooth or creative change from one video clip to another

Click on a transition name to get a **thumbnail view** of a few frames of the transition - a handy way to see a transition before applying it.

You can also adjust the duration of the transition with the **speed slider**.

Many Slick transitions also support a **direction control button** that changes the direction of the transition.

To apply the transition, **drag** the transition name or thumbnail to the desired location in the clip viewer.



very slick effects

Using Slick effects is a fun way to change the look and feel of your iMovie video footage. It's like applying a Photoshop® filter to each frame.


In the clip viewer, **select** the video clip you want to change.



Click an effect name and a few frames of a video **thumbnail view** will appear with the effect applied.

Control how the effect gets applied over time with the **Effect In and Effect Out sliders**.

Slick effects also provide **control sliders** to adjust the parameters of each effect. Applicable sliders will appear automatically when the individual effects are selected, but not all of the effects have control sliders.



Click the **Apply** button to apply the effect.



troubleshooting

- ▶ **The Slick Transitions and Slick Effects don't appear in the Transitions or Effects tabs in iMovie.**

The plug-in files are not placed in the correct location. Please re-install the software. Also, check to see if there are multiple copies of iMovie on your Mac.
- ▶ **When iMovie is launched, the error message "The plugin XXX" is too old".**

There are different versions of the Slick plug-in for OS 9 and OS X. If you manually installed the plug-ins files, the incorrect version may have been installed. Remove the Slick plug-in and re-install the software.
- ▶ **When iMovie is launched, the error message "Something is wrong with the plugin XXX" appears.**

When a Slick plug-in is being loaded, the support files can not be located. Please re-install the software.
- ▶ **When I try to install the Slick Vol.1 software, an error message appears stating the I don't have sufficient privileges to make changes.**

Log out and log back in as the administrator of your Mac OS X computer. For more information, see "Working as an administrator" in Mac Help.
- ▶ **Why do the transitions and effects start with the "§" character?**

The § character is used to distinguish the Slick Transitions and Effects from the ones provided by Apple.
- ▶ **Can a transition or effect that I don't want to use be removed?**

Yes, just go to the Slick Vol.1 Plug-ins folder and remove the transition or effect plugin file.





Camcorder

Make your movie look like it is being viewed through a camcorder. Frame guides and record indicator are displayed.

Slider controls the brightness of the "interlace" lines. At the highest brightness the lines do not appear.

Line Brightness Low High



Diffusion

Creates a less-focused, impressionistic paint-like view.

Slider controls the intensity of this effect over duration of the clip.

Start Amount Low High
End Amount Low High




Edge Detection-B&W

Applies an edge detection filter to a monochrome version of the video.

Slider controls the edge thickness.

Edge Thickness Thin Thick



Edge Detection - Color

Applies an edge detection filter to the video.

Slider controls the edge thickness.

Edge Thickness **Thin** **Thick**



Emboss

Creates a metallic 3-D effect.

Slider controls the depth of 3-D effect.

Amount **Low** **High**



Film Noise - B&W

Gives video an aged film look. This version converts movies to black and white.

Dust random dust particles on the film

Hair like dust but longer, thinner particles

Scratches random vertical lines

Dust **None** **Lots**
Hair **None** **Lots**
Scratches **None** **Lots**



Film Noise-Faded color

This version de-saturates colors giving a faded, aged film look.

Dust random dust particles on the film

Hair like dust but longer, thinner particles

Scratches random vertical lines

Film Noise-Saturated Colors

Super-saturates colors to look like aged or early color film.

Dust random dust particles on the film

Film Noise-Sepia

This effect applies a red-brown tone and gives video an aged film look.



Jittery TV

Makes your video look like it is viewed on an old TV with poor reception. Image is noisy and shaky with a rolling bright line through it.

Slider controls the reception quality.

Source Integrity Good Bad



Lens Flare

Simulates light reflecting from the camera lens.

There is no control slider for this effect.



Mosaic

Creates pixelated tiles of your video clip.

Control sliders adjust the tile size and how the size varies overtime.

Start Tile Size Small Large
End Tile Size Small Large



Posterize

Reduces the number of colors in the clip.

Slider controls the number of colors displayed.

Posterize Low High



Solarize

Applies a solar effect to the video.

Slider controls the intensity and point of solarization.

Solarize Amount Low High

Solarize Point Low High



Video Noise

Adds static to the clip

Slider controls the intensity of this effect over duration of the clip.

Start Amount Low High

End Amount Low High



X-Ray

Gives a film negative effect.

There is no control slider for this effect.



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
