Over 100 new transitions, effects and titles are included with Slick Volume 3. Many of these state-of-the-art plug-ins are not only a first for iMovie, but also not available on any other video editing platform. An of course, the Slick plug-ins preserve iMovie's simplicity and ease of use.

install Slick Vol.3

- 1 **Quit** iMovie if it is running.
- 2 **Launch** the Slick Volume 3 Installer application. The installer works under Mac OS X and OS 9. You will be asked to enter a serial number.
- 3 The Installer automatically places the correct files for either Mac OS X or OS 9 in the correct folders for you automatically.

installation tips

- ◆ **Under OS X**, if you get an error message appears stating insufficient privileges to make changes, log out and log back in as the administrator of your Mac OS X computer. The Installer needs to place a support file in the :Library:CFMSupport folder. For more information, see "Working as an administrator" in Mac Help.

You can also select the CFMSupport folder, select Get Info (Command-I) under the File menu, and check to see that you have Read & Write Privileges for this folder.

- ◆ **Under OS 9** if you get an installation error that a folder can not be found, the iMovie Plugins folder has been removed or the name of the folder has been changed. Please make sure that there is a folder named Plugins inside the iMovie Resources folder and that there is a Transitions folder inside the Plugins folder.




very slick transitions

Use a Slick transition to add a smooth or creative change from one video clip to another.

Click on a transition name to get a **thumbnail view** of a few frames of the transition- a handy way to see a transition before applying it.

You can also adjust the duration of the transition with the **speed slider**.

To apply the transition, drag the transition name or thumbnail to the desired location.



Some transition names are followed by the (Δ) character. These transitions can take advantage of a "location" feature in iMovie 2.1.1 or later. By clicking in the Thumbnail preview area, a different variation of the transition will be used.

very slick effects

Using Slick effects is a fun way to change the look and feel of your iMovie video footage. It's like applying a Photoshop® filter to each frame.

In the clip viewer, select the video clip you want to change.



Click an effect name and a few frames of a video **thumbnail view** will appear with the effect applied.

Control how the effect gets applied over time with the **Effect In and Effect Out** sliders.

Slick effects also provides a **control slider** to adjust parameter(s) of each effect. Applicable sliders will appear automatically when the individual effects are selected, but not all of the effects have control sliders.

Click the Apply button to apply the effect.



very slick titles

Slick titles greatly expand the ways that you can incorporate text to punctuate your iMovie


Click on a title name to get a **thumbnail view** of the title.

The Speed slider adjusts the duration of the title. For some titles that “move”, the Pause slider sets the time the title stays still.

The Font sliders change the font choice and the size of the text.

The text field contains the contents of the title

To apply the title, drag the title name or thumbnail to the desired location.

slick vol.3 effects reference



Color Tint (dark)

Change the tint of the clip to a desired color. This version replaces the black and gray shades with the color selected in the sliders.



Color Tint (light)

Change the tint of the clip to a desired color. This version replaces the white and light shades with the color selected in the sliders.



Drops - Bubble Bath

Add monochrome bubbles or rings to your video.

Sliders change the density, size and speed of the bubbles.

Drops - Bubble Gum

Add colored bubbles or rings to your video.


Sliders change the density, size and speed of the bubbles.



Drops - Flash

Add monochrome circles to your video.

Sliders change the density, size and speed of the circles.



Drops - Lava Lamp

Add colored circles to your video.

Sliders change the density, size and speed of the circles.

Drops - Rain Dance

Add a splash of rain to your clip.

Sliders change the density, size and speed of the ripples.



Fisheye

Applies a fisheye filter to give a bulge looks at the center of the screen. Looks nice when the video has a horizontal pan.



RGB

Adjust the RGB values to color correct or give that special colored look. Sliders control the R, G and B values independently.



slick vol.3 effects reference



Rotate/Scale

Rotate and/or scale video. Very useful when the footage was shot with the camera in a portrait position. Sliders adjust the angle, vertical scale and horizontal scale.



SoftPaint

Transform a video into a painting in motion! Adjust the brush size and thickness of the "painted" lines. Complex image processing takes a bit, but the results are worthwhile.



troubleshooting

- ◆ **When iMovie is launched, the error message “Something is wrong with the plug-in XXX” appears.**

When a Slick plug-in is being loaded when iMovie is launched, the support file for the software can not be located. Please reinstall the Slick software.

- ◆ **When iMovie is launched, the error message “the plug-in XXX is too old” appears.**

This error message appears when the OS X version of the Slick plug-ins are used under OS 9, or the OS 9 version of the plug-ins are used under OS X. Remove the plug-ins and reinstall the software.

- ◆ **When iMovie is launched, none of the Slick plug-in appear in the transitions, effects or title panels.**

There may multiple copies of iMovie on your hard drive. When you open an iMovie project, it launches a copy of iMovie that does not have the Slick software in its plug-in folder. Search for and remove the extra copies of iMovie.

- ◆ **Why do the transitions and effects start with the “Σ” character?**

The Σ character is used to distinguish the Slick Volume 3 plug-ins from the ones provided by Apple.

- ◆ **Can a transition or effect that I don't want to use be removed?**

Yes, just go to the Slick Volume 3 folder and remove the transition, effect or title plug-in file.
