- RAM requirements:

"Smithsonian's America" requires 3.5 Megabytes of free RAM to run.

- System 7.0.x, on the average, uses 2 Megabytes of RAM. This means you have to

have a computer with at least 5.5 Megabytes of total RAM to run this product.

- System 6.0.x, uses approximately 750 K. This means that you need about 4.5

Megabytes to run this product under System 6.0.x

- Increasing Performance:

These measures will help if "Smithsonian's America" is playing slowly or if you are

experiencing problems with playback of QuickTime movies.

- Turn off any "screen savers" which could slow down your Macintosh.

- If your Macintosh is on a network, log off of the network.

- Remove any non-Apple Control Panels and Extensions.

- System 7.0 only:

You may be able to increase the amount of available RAM by reducing the size of the

Disk Cache, which is always turned on.

Here's how:

- a) Open the "Memory" Control Panel.
- b) Set the disk cache to its minimum size.
- c) Restart your Macintosh.

Turn off Virtual Memory.

Here's how:

- a) Open the "Memory" Control Panel.
- b) Set "Virtual Memory" to "off".
- c) Restart your Macintosh.
