

This QuickStart card describes how to install a default configuration of SoftWindows™ 95. You will need about 200 Mbytes of free disk space.

If the installation fails, set the **Extensions Manager** control panel to **System 7.x.x** and then try installing again.


1 Read the ReadMe file

- Insert the **SoftWindows 95** installation CD.

Before proceeding we recommend you double-click the **ReadMe SoftWindows** icon on the installation CD for any additional information.

2 Run the installer

- Double-click the **Installer** icon.
- When the welcome screen appears click **Continue...** to display this dialog box:




- Click **Install**, and then follow the installation instructions displayed on the screen.

3 Create a hard disk file

Unless you are upgrading an existing hard disk file, the following dialog box allows you to create a file to act as the hard disk for SoftWindows.

Note that if you have been supplied with the SoftWindows 95 1.0 CD the hard disk file is created with a fixed size of 129 Mbytes, and the size you set is ignored.



- Click **Create** to create a hard disk file of the recommended size.
- Follow the instructions displayed on the screen, changing disks if necessary.

4 Change CDs


During the installation you will be prompted, when necessary, to change CDs.

- Insert the specified CD.

The installer then copies the Windows files to your hard disk, and this takes several minutes.

5 Set up memory for SoftWindows

This dialog box then allows you to set up the amount of memory allocated to SoftWindows, and the size of the Windows desktop:



- Click **OK** to set up SoftWindows with the recommended settings for your Macintosh.

6 Personalize SoftWindows

This dialog box then appears, allowing you to personalize your copy of SoftWindows:

Your serial number is located on the back of the CD jacket.

- Type in your name and company.
- Enter the serial number from the back of the installation CD jacket.

If there is no serial number on the CD jacket see the enclosed Activation Card for details.

Alternatively, click **Time Limited Demonstration** to evaluate SoftWindows for a limited period.

- Click **OK** to save your details.
- When a dialog box confirms that installation was successful click **Quit**.

7 Run SoftWindows

- Double-click the **SoftWindows™ 95** icon.

If you are using US system software the Registration program will then run, to help you register your copy of SoftWindows. Refer to the *SoftWindows Installation and User's Guide* for information about how to proceed.

Otherwise please complete and return your registration card to Insignia.

8 Windows configuration

The first time you run SoftWindows a series of updates will automatically reconfigure Windows 95 for optimum performance.

If an **Unable To Proceed...** warning appears:

- Click **Continue** to continue.

The MS-DOS SWUPDATE program will then run to add Insignia drivers and update your configuration, and Windows 95 will start.

If a **New Hardware Found** dialog box appears:

- Select **Do not install a driver** and click **OK** to continue.

Windows 95 will then run a batch file in an MS-DOS window, which will take several minutes, and Windows 95 will restart.

If you are asked to enter a Windows password:

Enter Windows Password

Type a name to identify yourself to Windows. Enter a password if you want to.

Tip: If you don't enter a password, you won't get this prompt again at startup.

The Windows 95 desktop will then be displayed.

Note that Windows 95 will load virtually instantly the next time you run SoftWindows if you choose the TurboStart option when you quit. This also allows you to continue work in the applications you were previously using.
