## 1. Welcome to Solitaire Mania!

Thank you for choosing Solitaire Mania. We know you're going to enjoy this collection of 25 unique games—all part of the most entertaining solitaire game pack available!

**System Requirements:** Solitaire Mania requires any Macintosh with 2MB RAM running System 7.0 or later. A color monitor is also required, but Solitaire Mania will run on displays with as few as 16 colors or shades of gray (such as those found on some PowerBooks).

## 2. Getting Started

The installation process begins with the icon labeled *Check Me Out!* on the Solitaire Mania CD-ROM. Please double-click this program and follow the steps as you are prompted on-screen.

Once you've completed the above steps, you should know that there are two ways to run Solitaire Mania—from the CD-ROM or, if you prefer, from your hard drive.

So how do you know which option is right for you? Installing Solitaire Mania on your hard drive will keep the program convenient and will allow it to open more quickly but will require 1 MB to 6 MB of hard disk space.

If you wish to install Solitaire Mania on your hard drive, just drag the image of the Solitaire Mania CD-ROM onto your hard drive. A new folder called *Solitaire Mania* will be created. Depending upon constraints of hard disk space, you should note that only the Solitaire Mania program is required, but we recommend that you keep the user guides and Goodies files on your hard drive, too.

## 3. Cool Stuff You Can Do

**Customizing Solitaire Mania:** A big part of the fun of Solitaire Mania lies behind the Options command on the Preferences menu. Choose it to select from more than 100 alternate backgrounds and 100 alternative card backs. Just click on the left or right arrow to make a change.

**Saving Games:** You can save a game at any time and resume play later. Or, just for posterity, save a grueling game you've won. To do so, choose the Save As command from the File menu.

**Sample Games:** Speaking of saved games, we've included sample games, all of which have been won, so you can unravel the secrets of successful solitaire play. To open a sample game, choose the Open Game command from the File menu and locate the desired game inside the Sample Games folder on the Solitaire Mania CD-ROM. You may then choose the Redo All command from the Edit menu to see how the game was originally won.

**Questions?** For answers to technical and game play questions, consult the Solitaire Mania User Guide or Solitaire Mania Game Guide—both provided inside the User Guide folder. The latter user guide goes into great detail describing each game individually. You should remember, of course, that some games are not easily won.
