WINDOWS INSTALLATION

The Star Warped installation program :

- Installs Star Warped.
- Registers your product online (optional).
- Configures Star Warped to launch your browser to the Star Warped web site (optional).
- Installs QuickTime™ for Windows (optional).

To install Star Warped, follow these steps:

NOTE: If your CD-ROM drive is designated by a letter other than "D:", enter the appropriate drive letter in place of D: below.

1. Start Microsoft™ Windows if it's not already running.
2. Insert the Star Warped CD-ROM in the CD-ROM drive.
- 3a. For Windows 3.1: From the Program Manger menu select FILE, then RUN. In the Command Line, type **D:\SETUP.EXE** and click OK.
- 3b. Windows 95 with AutoPlay enabled will run Setup automatically when the CD-ROM is placed into the drive. Otherwise, to install Star Warped manually, select START in the Windows Taskbar, and then RUN. In the box labeled OPEN, type **D:\SETUP.EXE** and click OK .
4. After the Star Warped files have been copied to your hard drive, read the information in the scrollable window. You can also read this information in the Read Me file copied to your hard drive.
5. When you click the "Finish" button, Browser Setup will begin.
6. After Browser Setup finishes, QuickTime installation will begin.

In steps (3) - (6) above, follow the instructions on your screen.

- If you don't currently subscribe to an Internet Service Provider, or you would like to use the Netscape Navigator™ 3.0 browser, you may choose to install the AT&T WorldNet™ Service software included on the CD-ROM. Please see the printed insert for more details.
- If you install a new browser to use with Star Warped after installation, you need to run Browser Setup from your hard drive. Please see the enclosed "Online Guide" for information about going online from Star Warped.

- Windows 95 users have the option of installing either the 16-bit or 32-bit version of Star Warped. If you experience video or audio problems, you may choose to install the 16-bit version, after you have uninstalled the 32-bit version.
- The 32-bit version of Star Warped requires 32-bit QuickTime, and the 16-bit version of Star Warped requires 16-bit QuickTime. Please see the Read Me file for information about installing QuickTime version 2.1.2 from the CD-ROM.

Running Star Warped

1. Start Microsoft Windows if it's not already running.
2. Insert the Star Warped CD-ROM in the CD-ROM drive.
- 3a. For Windows 3.1: From the Program Manger, open the Star Warped program group and double-click "Star Warped."
- 3b. Windows 95 with AutoPlay enabled will run Star Warped automatically when the CD-ROM is placed into the drive. Otherwise, select Start on the Windows Taskbar, select Programs, select Start Warped and then select "Star Warped."

To run Death Star Destructo, double-click (Windows 3.1) or select (Windows 95) "Death Star Destructo." The Star Warped CD-ROM is not required.

Before Running Star Warped:

- Set your display to 256 colors at 640x480 resolution.
- Exit all running programs (including screen savers).

MACINTOSH INSTALLATION

To install Star Warped, follow these steps:

1. Insert the CD-ROM in the CD-ROM drive.
2. Double-click the "Install Star Warped" icon. Click "Continue" when you see the opening Star Warped graphic.
3. Read the information in the scrollable window and then click "Continue."
You can also read this information in the Read Me file which will be copied to your hard drive. Click "Continue."
4. After the Star Warped files have been copied to your hard drive, click "Next" to continue. The Browser Setup program will begin.

In steps (3) - (4) above, follow the instructions on your screen.

- If you don't currently subscribe to an Internet Service Provider, or you would like to use the Netscape Navigator™ 2.0 browser, you may choose to install the AT&T WorldNet™ Service software included on the CD-ROM. Please see the printed insert for more details.

- Star Warped requires the QuickTime and QuickTime PowerPlug (PowerPC's only) extensions. Please see the Read Me file for information about installing QuickTime version 2.5 from the CD-ROM.

Running Star Warped

1. Insert the Star Warped CD-ROM in the CD-ROM drive.
2. Open the "Star Warped" folder, then double-click the Star Warped icon or the Death Star Destructo icon.

To run Death Star Destructo, Open the "Star Warped" folder, then double-click the Death Star Destructo icon. The Star Warped CD-ROM is not required.

Before Running Star Warped:

- Set your display to 256 colors at 640x480 resolution.
- Turn off Virtual Memory.
- Quit all open applications (including screen savers).
- Disable all systems extension except Apple CD-ROM, QuickTime, QuickTime PowerPlug (PowerPC's only) and Sound Manager (System 7.1 only).

Starting Death Star Destructo

1. Start Microsoft Windows if not already running.
2. Place the Star Warped disc in the CD-ROM drive.
3. For Windows 95, select Start on the Taskbar, choose Programs, select the Star Warped folder and click on the "Death Star Destructo" icon to run the desktop game.
4. For Windows 3.1 or Macintosh, select the Star Warped folder on your desktop and click on the "Death Star Destructo" icon to run the desktop game.

NOTE: If you are experiencing problems, be sure to disable all screen savers.

Use the “Room” and “Panel” dymo label buttons in the lower left and right hand corners throughout the game to easily navigate between the Control Panel and bedroom scenes.



Hint: Look for the three parody CD-ROM games that you can’t access directly from the Control Panel.




BRIAN'S BEDROOM
