MAC OS AND WINDOWS USER'S GUIDE

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS — MAC OS

- Any color-capable Mac OS computer with a 68030 (25-Mhz) or higher processor.
- At least 8 Mbytes of installed RAM (4,600K free)
- A 13-inch (640×480) or larger color monitor
- A double-speed CD-ROM drive
- System 7 or later

SETTING UP — MAC OS

Automatic Installation

Double-click on the Louvre Installer icon to automatically install *The Louvre for Kids* folder and the necessary extensions onto your computer. The installer will copy the program onto the root level of your hard drive or allow you to select/create a folder in which to copy the program.

Manual Installation

You can manually install the program and extensions by following the instructions below. These instructions assume a basic familiarity with Macintosh interface conventions. If you're just getting started with your computer and find the operations described below confusing, please refer to the documentation

that came with your computer.

To manually install this title, follow these steps:

1. Drag the *The Louvre for Kids* folder from the CD to your hard drive.
2. Open the System Extensions folder on the CD to show the extensions necessary or recommended for use with this title.
3. If you don't already have these extensions installed, or are unsure, drag the appropriate icons one-by-one to your System Folder icon and drop them there. The Macintosh will guide you through the rest of the installation. If you install any extensions, restart your computer to make them active. If you have an older version of QuickTime already installed, you will need to manually delete this extension before installing the new version.

GETTING STARTED — MAC OS

Important Note: If you have a Power Macintosh with only 8 MBytes of installed RAM and are experiencing performance problems, please refer to "About The Louvre for Kids" in the Documentation folder on the CD. This document will instruct you in how to change program settings for best performance.

To launch the program double-click the *Louvre for Kids* icon in *The Louvre for Kids* folder on your hard disk.

- PC-compatible computer with a 486DX-66 or faster processor
- 8 MBytes of installed RAM (minimum)
- 640×480, 256-color display
- MPC2-compatible CD-ROM drive (double-speed)
- MPC2-compatible sound card with speakers or headphones
- Mouse
- MS-DOS operating system version 5.0 or later
- Microsoft Windows version 3.11 or Windows 95
- MS-DOS CD-ROM Extensions (MSCDEX) version 2.2 or later
- QuickTime for Windows (version 2.1.0 or greater)

SETTING UP — WINDOWS 3.11 AND WINDOWS 95

These instructions assume a basic familiarity with Windows 3.11 or Windows 95 interface conventions. If you're just getting started with your computer, and find the operations described below confusing, please refer to the documentation that came with your computer.

You can install *The Louvre for Kids* software from the Windows 3.11 Program Manager or the Windows 95 Desktop. No matter which method you use, the installer will add a *The Louvre for Kids* icon to the Voyager-96 program group.

Installing the Software from the Windows 3.11 Program Manager

1. Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive according to the drive manufacturer's instructions.
2. Choose Run from the File menu.
3. Type d:\setup.exe, where d: is your CD-ROM drive.
4. Click OK.
5. Follow directions in the Setup dialog boxes to complete the installation.

Installing the Software from the Windows 95 Desktop

1. Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive according to the drive manufacturer's instructions.
2. Choose Run from the Start menu.
3. Type d:\setup, where d: is your CD-ROM drive.
4. Click OK.
5. Follow directions in the Setup dialog boxes to complete the installation.

GETTING STARTED — WINDOWS

To launch *The Louvre for Kids*, double-click *The Louvre for Kids* icon in the Voyager-96 group.
