



Upgrading to Mac OS 9.2.2 or Mac OS X v10.1.3

DVD Studio Pro requires either Mac OS 9.2.2 or Mac OS X v10.1.3 or later to run. The following explains how to upgrade to the appropriate version of the Mac OS used on your computer.

To upgrade to Mac OS 9.2.2:

Before installing DVD Studio Pro 1.5 on Mac OS 9, you must upgrade to Mac OS 9.2.2. Updaters are located in the Mac OS 9 Updates folder on the DVD Studio Pro DVD. You can upgrade from Mac OS 9.0.4 or later.

- If you're upgrading from Mac OS 9.0.4, you must first run the Mac OS 9.1 updater. Next, upgrade to Mac OS 9.2.1 using the Mac OS 9.2.1 updater. Finally, run the Mac OS 9.2.2 updater.
- If you're upgrading from Mac OS 9.1, first run the Mac OS 9.2.1 updater, then the Mac OS 9.2.2 updater.
- If you're upgrading from Mac OS 9.2.1, run the Mac OS 9.2.2 updater.

To upgrade to Mac OS X v10.1.3 or later:

You must have Mac OS X v10.1 or later installed on your computer before you can upgrade to Mac OS X v10.1.3. You must be connected to the Internet to perform the upgrades described in steps 1 through 3. All three upgrades must be performed in order, one after the other.

- 1** If you're upgrading from Mac OS X v10.1, open System Preferences, click the Software Update icon, then install the Security Update 10-19-01. Restart your computer.
- 2** Once the Security Update 10-19-01 has been installed, open System Preferences, click the Software Update icon, then install the Installer Update 1.0.
- 3** Once the Installer Update 1.0 has been installed, open System Preferences, click the Software Update icon, then install the Mac OS X Update 10.1.3. Restart your computer. To check for further updates, run Software Update after Mac OS X v10.1.3 is installed.
