


Macintosh Macintosh LC or Macintosh II family CPU with 12" or larger color monitor, 4MB RAM, hard disk with at least 1MB of free space, CD-ROM drive with a minimum data transfer rate of 150KB / sec, System 6.0.7 or later. QuickTime™ 1.6 Init included on the disc.

INSTALLATION

Windows Launch Microsoft Windows. From the Program Manager, launch the File Manager by double clicking the "**File Manager**" icon. Select the CD-ROM drive and choose "**Open**" from the file menu. Double click "**Setup.exe**" to begin installation. The default name of this directory is "**WM**."

Macintosh Drag the "**Wildebeest-HD**" folder from the CD-ROM to your hard disk.

LAUNCHING THE PROGRAM

Windows Launch Microsoft Windows; double click the "**InterOptica**" group icon; and double click the "**Wildebeest**" icon in the group.

Macintosh Double click the "**Click Me**" icon inside the "**Wildebeest-HD**" folder on the hard disk.
