


Clip Window



2 Double click a clip to preview it in a clip window.


3 Define IN and OUT points and drag the clip to a video track.

Sequencer (Storyboard View)



4 Drag a video clip to a video track.


5 Drag an audio clip to an audio track.

Start Here!

1 Record video clips, still images, and audio clips using VideoShop's recording tool, then view your clips in VideoShop folders.

6 Switch to time view to edit the movie by clicking the storyboard/time view button.


Sequencer (Time View)



7 Add a title track by clicking the add track button and choosing Title Track from the pull-down menu.




8 Select a region on the title track where text should appear, and open a text window by pressing the text window button.




Quick Reference

Canvas Window



Preview the movie in the canvas window by clicking the play button in the canvas window or by pressing the space bar.

9 Enter text and insert it into the title track by pressing the insert text button.


10 Apply a transition effect by selecting a region across two video clips, then clicking the transition effect button.




Track Operations




1 Collapse and expand a track by clicking the upper half of the track identifier.




2 Change track options by clicking the lower half of a track identifier.




3 Reposition a track by clicking and dragging the left side of the track identifier.




4 Reposition a clip by clicking and dragging its bottom edge.



5 Fade audio in and out by selecting the rubber band in an audio track and dragging with the pointed finger tool.











Shortcuts

KEY	ACTION
Sequencer Shortcuts:	
Space bar	Start and stop clip
ENTER	Set insertion point at current point in movie
Right arrow	Go to next frame
Left arrow	Go to previous frame
Up arrow	Move up one track
Down arrow	Move down one track
⌘ -	Storyboard view
⌘ +	Time view
⌘ 1	Go to beginning of movie
⌘ 2	Go to end of movie
⌘ 3	Go to IN
⌘ 4	Go to OUT
⌘ + drag & drop	Only drop in video portion of synchronized clip
⌘ + right arrow	Advance one tick
⌘ + left arrow	Rewind one tick
Shift + space bar	Play reverse
Shift ENTER	Select from current point in movie to insertion point or end of selection
Shift + right arrow	Extend selection one frame to right
Shift + left arrow	Extend selection one frame to left
Shift + up arrow	Extend selection up one track
Shift + down arrow	Extend selection down one track
Shift + arrow tool	Extend selection to right or left in current track
Shift + beginning of clip button	Extend selection to first frame of clip
Shift + next clip button	Extend selection to last frame of clip
Option + space bar	Play selection
Option + arrow tool	Transition tool for a symmetrical selection across two clips
Option + drag & drop	Snap clip to closest cut
Option + magnifying glass	Zoom out
Canvas Window Shortcuts:	
Option + next frame button	Last frame of clip
Option + previous frame button	First frame of clip
Path mode: option + next frame button	Next path point
Path mode: option + previous frame button	Previous path point
Recording Window Shortcuts:	
RETURN or ENTER	Start and stop recording
I	Start recording (IN point)
O	Stop recording (OUT point)
Title Window Shortcuts:	
Option	Toggle to arrow tool
⌘ J	Insert text into sequencer
⌘ A	Select all
Clip Window Shortcuts:	
Space bar	Start and stop clip
Right arrow	Go to next frame
Left arrow	Go to previous frame
Option + grow box	Resize window
Effects Shortcuts:	
Space bar	Start and stop effect playout
Right arrow	Go to next frame
Left arrow	Go to previous frame
Up arrow	Scroll up through list of effects
Down arrow	Scroll down through list of effects
Filter effect: ⌘ Y	Apply filter
Filter effect: +	Advance IN point one frame
Filter effect: -	Decrement IN point one frame
Filter effect: Option +	Advance OUT point one frame
Filter effect: Option -	Decrement OUT point one frame
Transition effect: ⌘ T	Apply transition
Transition effect: + / Option +	Increase transition duration
Transition effect: - / Option -	Decrease transition duration
Desktop Shortcuts:	
Option + double click on media	Open media element and close parent folders
Option + close box	Close current window and parent folders
Command + click on window title	Menu of parent folders
Right arrow	Next media element
Left arrow	Previous media element
