

Installation Instructions for Dr. T's Sing-A-Long Kid's Classics®

Windows:

This product contains a Master installer utility for a convenient installation.

Follow these instructions to get started.

1. Insert the program CD into the CD-ROM drive.
2. From Windows' Program Manager, select **Run** from the **File** menu.
3. In the Run dialog box, type **D:\INSTALL.EXE** (note the spelling, no "A") and press **Enter**. **D** represents the CD-ROM drive letter. If your letter is different, substitute accordingly (e.g., **E:\INSTALL.EXE**).

From the screen that is displayed, select the items that you wish to install and click on **Install** to continue. The documentation for this product is included in an on-line format. To view this file you need to install the Viewer at least once. The file is called **MANUAL.PDF** and is located in the sub-directory on the CD (e.g. **D:\MANUALS\MANUAL.PDF**).

Macintosh:

1. Place the program CD into the CD-ROM drive.
2. Double click on the CD icon to display the contents.
3. Double click on the **Kids Classics** program icon to run the program.

The documentation is supplied in an on-line format. To access the manual, you need to install the Viewer utility to your hard drive at least once. To do so, double click on the **ACROREAD.MAC** icon in the CD window and follow the on screen instructions to complete the installation. Launch the Viewer application and access the manual file **MANUAL.PDF**, which is located in the **MANUALS** folder on the CD.


