## TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS – MACINTOSH

- Any color Macintosh (25-MHz 68030 or better recommended)
- 3,500 of available RAM (at least 8 MB installed)
- 13-inch (640×480 resolution) or greater color monitor
- CD-ROM drive (double-speed recommended)
- System 7

## SETTING UP – MACINTOSH

Before you can use *Ephemeral Films*, you must

- Copy *Ephemeral Films* to your hard drive
- Install the QuickTime and Sound Manager extensions, if necessary

## Getting Ready to Install Software from the CD

1. Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive according to the drive manufacturer's instructions.
2. Double-click the CD's icon. A window showing its contents will open.

Everything you may need to install appears in this window. Keep it open until you're finished setting up.

## Copying *Ephemeral Films*

To copy *Ephemeral Films*, drag the Ephemeral Films icon from the CD window to your hard drive.

## Installing Extensions

*Ephemeral Films* requires QuickTime 2.0 and Sound Manager 3.0. If you have a Power Macintosh, you also need the QuickTime PowerPlug 2.0. All extensions are in the QuickTime and Sound Manager folder on the CD.

### INSTALLING QUICKTIME 2.0

To install QuickTime 2.0, drag the icon for QuickTime 2.0 to your system folder and drop it. The Macintosh will guide you through the rest of the installation.

If you have a Power Macintosh, you must also install the QuickTime PowerPlug. To do so, drag the QuickTime PowerPlug to your System Folder and drop it. The Macintosh will guide you through the rest of the installation.

### INSTALLING SOUND MANAGER 3.0

To install Sound Manager 3.0 and the new Sound control panel, drag the icons for each item over the System Folder and drop them. The Macintosh will guide you through the rest of the installation.

## TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS – WINDOWS

- 486SX-25 or higher processor
- 640×480 256-color display (accelerator recommended)
- 4 MB RAM (8 MB recommended)
- MPC2-compatible CD-ROM drive and sound card with speakers or headphones
- Microsoft Windows 3.1, MS-DOS 5.0 or later

## SETTING UP – WINDOWS

You can install the software using Program Manager or File Manager. No matter which method you use, the installer will add an Ephemeral Films icon to the Voyager group in Program Manager.

### Installing the Software from File Manager

1. Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive according to the drive manufacturer's instructions.
2. From within the Windows File Manager, click on the drive icon for your CD-ROM drive to display the disc's files.
3. Double-click on the SETUP.EXE file to run the Setup program.
4. Follow the directions in the Setup dialog boxes to complete the installation.

### Installing the Software from Program Manager

1. Choose Run from the File menu.
2. Type *d:\setup.exe*, where *d:* is your CD-ROM drive.
3. Click OK.
4. Follow directions in the Setup dialog boxes to complete the installation.

## GETTING STARTED

To launch *Ephemeral Films*, double-click the Ephemeral Films icon.

### Selecting a Movie

To select a movie at the Table of Contents, click its title.

To select a film while viewing another film, click Contents and select from the displayed list.

To go to the next or previous movie in a section, click the arrows to the right or left of Contents.

### Watching a Movie

#### FOR MACINTOSH...

To start or stop the movie, click the mouse over the movie.

To hide or display the movie controller, hold down the mouse button over the movie and select from the list.

To enlarge the size of the movie, click Bigger. To reduce the size again, click Smaller.

#### FOR WINDOWS...

To start or stop the movie, click the left mouse button over the movie.

To hide or display the movie controller, click the right mouse button over the movie.

To enlarge the size of the movie, click Bigger. To reduce the size again, click Smaller.

### Selecting a Related Movie

Related movies are not available for every movie in *Ephemeral Films*.

#### FOR MACINTOSH...

To select from the list of related movies, hold down the mouse over the Related Movies button and select from the list.

#### FOR WINDOWS...

To select from the list of related movies, click the Related Movies button and select from the list.

### Getting Help

#### FOR MACINTOSH...

To turn help on and off, press **⌘-?** or select Help from the Ephemeral menu.

#### FOR WINDOWS...

To view the help file, press F1.
