We hesitated for a long time before deciding to go public. However, since our journalist, Jack Lorski, and his friend disappeared, events have suddenly started gathering pace.

Arnaud Ivan, SKL Network's CEO, received a CD-ROM and a video excerpt at his home address, which has made us take all of this very seriously.

An in-depth analysis of these elements finally convinced us that our employee and his friend have been kidnapped. We believe this kidnapping could be linked to the case of MP Kourievski.

After conducting a whole series of tests in a specifically dedicated lab, we finally succeeded in determining the minimum system requirements to make the Phoenix's black CD-ROM work:

### PC Requirements

Pentium 333 MHz processor

Windows® 95, 98, 2000, Me, XP

700 MB hard drive space

64 MB RAM

16 MB graphics card

Minimum display resolution: 800 x 600

8x CD-ROM drive

16-bit sound card (Soundblaster™ compatible)

Recommended display: 32bit

Recommended display resolution: 1024 x 768

Internet connection required (*minimum 56.6 KB modem*)

### MAC Requirements

OS/8.6 and above (OS X, classic mode only)

700 MB hard drive space

64 MB RAM

Minimum display resolution: 800 x 600

8x CD-ROM drive

Recommended display resolution: 1024 x 768

Internet connection required (*minimum 56.6 KB modem*)

For security reasons and in compliance with legal requirements, we have had to control access to the Phoenix's CD-ROM.

To use it, you must:

- Run the setup procedure from the SKL Network CD-ROM PC or Mac, depending on the system that you are using)
- Complete the online registration process in our database

### Setup procedure

The setup procedure is extremely straightforward.

Insert the SKL CD-ROM into your drive (PC or Mac, depending on the system that you are using), click on the Install button and follow the instructions.

Note: we found that the Phoenix's CD-ROM needs QuickTime™ 6 and Shockwave Player 9.0. If you do not have these programs on your computer, you will be prompted to install them.

### Registering in the SKL Network database

*Note: you must be connected to the Internet to register.*

#### // Login and email address

Your login and email address are used as unique user identifiers.

Warning ! each email must be unique to each user. Should you wish to make the Phoenix's CD-ROM accessible to one or more people, you must create new accounts and set up other email addresses. For further information, please refer to "User email management" below. If required, you are free to create new email addresses by clicking on our partner's link (MSN Hotmail) and following the online instructions.



**// Email program**

If you wish to use a specific program to consult your emails, please check the corresponding box and select your program's name.

If you access your emails via a website (free mail service, internet provider's site, and so on), please check the online box.

Important: once your registration is complete, a password will be sent to the specified email address. You will have to use it whenever you run the Phoenix's CD-ROM.

**// User email management**

When selecting this option, you can:

- Create new accounts to allow other people to access the Phoenix's CD-ROM.
- Modify your email address.
- Remove your registration details from the SKL Network database.

Warning: once your registration details have been deleted, you will no longer receive updates on the investigation.

**RUNNING**

To run the Phoenix's CD-ROM, you will only be asked for your login and the password that you received at the email address specified during registration.

After exiting, simply insert the black CD-ROM directly to restart the program.

To make the Phoenix's CD-ROM more user-friendly, we asked experts to add some basic browser tools, which are now available after several hours of hard work.

**Toolbar**

To activate the toolbar created by our team of experts, simply click on the white button on the left side of the screen. You can move the toolbar up and down.

**// Email**

Run your email program directly from the CD-ROM.

**// Internet**

Run the Internet browser directly from the CD-ROM.

**// Films**

Check out the video excerpts that have already been opened.

**// Minimise**

Minimise the CD-ROM's window in order to use other applications (Internet, emails...).

**// Exit**

Exit the Phoenix's CD-ROM. Your progress will automatically be saved. You can use the "Back" option if you selected Exit by mistake.

**// Moving the toolbar**

Drag and drop to move the toolbar up and down.

**// Deactivate the toolbar**

Click on the extremities of the toolbar to deactivate it.

## Phoenix's interface

### // The Phoenix's messages

As indicated by a psychologist working for our investigation team, the Phoenix seems to be urging us to go to a specific point. That is probably the reason why he prepared several messages to guide us.




Once these messages disappear from the screen, you can read them again by clicking on the question mark in the top-right corner of the screen.

### // Navigation

An in-depth analysis of the CD-ROM has led us to think that it is divided into several "levels" or "strata", with each one comprising a number of modules (such as Tetima, Ustichos or Syro for the first level).

We cannot be sure whether these modules have to be completed in a specific order, but based on our initial observations, each module can be performed in any order without any noticeable impact.



We have noticed that when a module is open, all you have to do is click on its name down on the screen to return to the current level's main menu.

### // Instability and display problems

Our analysts have noticed that using the Phoenix's CD-ROM for long periods of time might sometimes lead to instability problems (abnormal display or refresh errors).

According to our computer experts, this does not have any effect on the integrity of your computer's system or data.

To avoid such problems, we would advise you to use the ESC key to access the "BACK - EXIT" menu option and then return to the main interface. Should these problems persist, exit the CD-ROM and rerun it.

As you will quickly notice, you will need to search the Internet in order to complete several parts of the Phoenix's CD-ROM.

## SKL Network site

To increase our chances and save precious time, our experts have made several tools available on our site:

### // Optimised search engine

Thanks to the support of our partner, we have developed a search engine that takes account of the most frequent searches relating to the Phoenix's CD-ROM. The results of the most popular requests generally appear at the top of the list.

### // Translator

We realised that several foreign language sites may be a valuable source of information. Use this tool to run the automatic translation feature for the pages that you wish to translate. As these translations are performed by software, they may be approximate.

### // Wordpad

By entering your login and password, you can jot down your notes in the wordpad. Therefore, you can carry on with your online enquiries anywhere, even if you do not have the Phoenix's CD-ROM with you.

### // Advanced use of search engines

If you are looking for an exact phrase in a search engine, use quotes. For example, searching for white house will give you all the pages containing the words 'white' and 'house'. Searching for "white house" (with quotes) will give you all the pages containing the phrase "white house".
