MINIMUM TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS – PC

- PC-compatible computer with a 486DX-2 or faster processor
- 16 MB of installed RAM (minimum)
- A 13-inch (640x480) or larger color monitor
- CD-ROM drive
- sound card with speakers or headphones
- Mouse
- Microsoft Windows version 95 or later

INSTALLATION

Installing the Software

1. Insert the *Making More Music* CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive in your computer.
2. Choose **Start, Control Panel, Add New Programs, CD/Floppy**.
3. Click **NEXT**.
4. You will see **MMMINSTALL.EXE** highlighted. Click **FINISH**.
5. You will see **Program Files\Making More Music** highlighted. Click **INSTALL**.
6. The installer will now look to see if you have *QuickTime*. If it detects *QuickTime** it will continue and say **completed**. Click **CLOSE**.
7. You will be prompted that you may have to restart the computer after installation. Click **OK..**
8. Now you are installing *Making More Music*. The prompt will start with “welcome...” Click **NEXT**.
9. Then the prompt will start with “setup will install Making More Music...” Click **NEXT**.
10. Finally you will be prompted “Setup will add program icons...” Click **NEXT**.

11. The installation will complete itself and start *Making More Music*. It is now installed and functional; however, you must now choose **QUIT** from the main menu of *Making More Music* and restart your computer. The installer has placed a music notation font in your system folder which will not be active until the computer is restarted.

If you do not have QuickTime, the most recent version will be installed. Follow the installation prompts and, when given a choice between minimum and recommended, choose **RECOMMENDED.*

STARTING MAKING MORE MUSIC

1. Make sure the *Making More Music* CD is in your CD-ROM drive.
2. From the **Start** Menu, click the *Making More Music* shortcut.

Help is available in every section of the program. Click the “?” (question mark) button in the lower right portion of the screen. A movie will appear providing a tutorial on the appropriate section of the program.

MINIMUM TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS – MACINTOSH

- Any color-capable Macintosh with 68040 or faster processor
- At least 16MB of installed RAM with 6MB free RAM (more to access the Internet from within *Making More Music*).
- A 13-inch (640x480) or larger color monitor
- External speakers or headphones
- CD-ROM drive
- Mouse
- System 7 or later

SETTING UP

To install this title, follow the steps on the following page:

1. Insert the CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive.
2. Double-click on the ***Making More Music*** CD-ROM icon on your desktop.
3. Double click the ***Making More Music Installer*** icon and follow instructions. You will be required to restart your computer before using the program. This is because the installer has placed a music notation font in your system folder which will not be active until the computer is restarted.

*Note: Making More Music requires that QuickTime Musical Instruments be installed. If you do not have QuickTime already installed, open the QuickTime installer folder and double-click the **Installer** icon. Choose the **RECOMMENDED** install.*

STARTING MAKING MORE MUSIC

1. Make sure the ***Making More Music*** CD is in your CD-ROM drive.
2. Open the ***Making More Music*** Folder on your hard drive and double-click the ***Making More Music*** icon.
