

Hardware Requirements

MacCourses™ will operate on a Macintosh™ 512K, 512K Enhanced, Macintosh Plus, or Macintosh SE. MacCourses will not work on a 128K Macintosh because of the memory it requires. If you have a Hard Disk, it is recommended that you “Shut Down” and switch it off while using MacCourses.

MacCourses also requires that you possess an original MacGolf™ program disk. Your MacGolf disk is needed to play the new golf courses, and MacCourses uses it when exchanging the courses you select.

Software Registration/ Support

Please fill out your registration card and send it in. Your registration card will be used for warranty replacement, future update notification, and to inform you of related products as they become available. We will not support customers whose registration cards we have not received.

Backup Policy

MacCourses is copy-protected, which prevents the ability to make working backup copies of the original disk. Should the original MacCourses disk's media fail, we will replace the disk at no charge provided the original diskette and label are unaltered. How to Install New Courses

There are four 18-hole golf courses to choose from on MacCourses: PCAI International, Cedar Creek, Golden Sands, and Thunder Ridge. MacCourses will exchange a pair of golf courses on your MacGolf disk for a pair of the new golf courses on the MacCourses disk. You will be instructed to copy the original courses from the MacGolf disk to a blank disk of your own (which will be called “MacCourses 2”). After you have gone through the following procedure once, changing courses in the future is a simple process.

To exchange the original courses on your MacGolf disk for two of the new courses on your MacCourses disk:

- Turn your Macintosh computer on (or reset it).
- Insert your original *unlocked* MacCourses disk into the internal disk drive.
- Allow MacCourses to boot until it is ejected and a dialog box appears with further instructions.

How to Install New Courses (cont.)

- You will be asked to insert an unlocked, erasable disk in the internal drive. Insert a blank disk with the write-protect tab slid down (toward the metal plate).
- This disk will eject when finished. Click the “OK” button on the dialog box and label the new disk “MacCourses 2”.
- Now, insert your original MacGolf disk in the internal drive, as requested by the next dialog box. When finished, the MacGolf disk will also eject, and the computer will ask for your new MacCourses 2 disk again.
- Insert your MacCourses 2 disk in the internal drive. After being loaded with the current golf courses from your MacGolf disk, the disk will eject.
- Next, insert your original MacCourses disk in the internal drive as indicated by the next dialog box.
- The disk will eject, and a screen will appear for you to select a pair of the golf courses to install on your original MacGolf disk.
- Choose either of the 2 new sets of golf courses. Click the “Install” button directly across from the pair of courses you want installed, or click “Help” if you need further assistance.

Note: At this time, do not select the Augustina National and Shinook Hills courses, since they are the original courses that are already on your MacGolf disk.

How to Install New Courses (cont.)

- You will then be asked to insert your *unlocked* original MacGolf disk in the internal drive. After you do this, the computer will remove the old courses and your MacGolf disk will be ejected.
- Insert your original MacCourses or your MacCourses 2 disk in the internal drive, as prompted. The one requested will depend on which courses you have selected. The disk will eject when finished.
- Finally, insert your original MacGolf disk once again in the internal drive. The disk will be ejected. The exchange of golf courses is now complete.
- Click on the “Quit” button when it appears. Your computer will shut down (reset).
- You are now ready to reinsert your original MacGolf disk in the internal drive and play MacGolf as usual, but with the new courses you have chosen.

Note: The start-up screen and the “Fore” will be permanently deleted from your original MacGolf disk. This change is made to allow enough room on the disk for the new courses. Disk space is at a premium when using quality digitized sound and graphics.

If You Have Problems

If the courses installation process does not work properly or if you get an error message:

- Reset your Macintosh or turn it off and on again, *keeping your mouse button pressed down* until the disk is ejected.
- Check to see that your Macintosh meets the hardware requirements on page 2.
- Reinsert your original MacCourses disk in your internal disk drive.
- Be sure you are inserting your original MacGolf disk when your computer asks for it.
- Be sure your disks (MacGolf, MacCourses, and MacCourses 2) are all *unlocked* whenever changing courses.
- If the problem still persists, contact PCAI.


Changing Courses Again

For future golf course exchanges, insert your MacCourses disk, and follow the instructions as they appear on your screen. You will be prompted for all actions.


Save your MacCourses 2 disk to use anytime you want to reinstall the original Augustina National and Shinook Hills golf courses.
