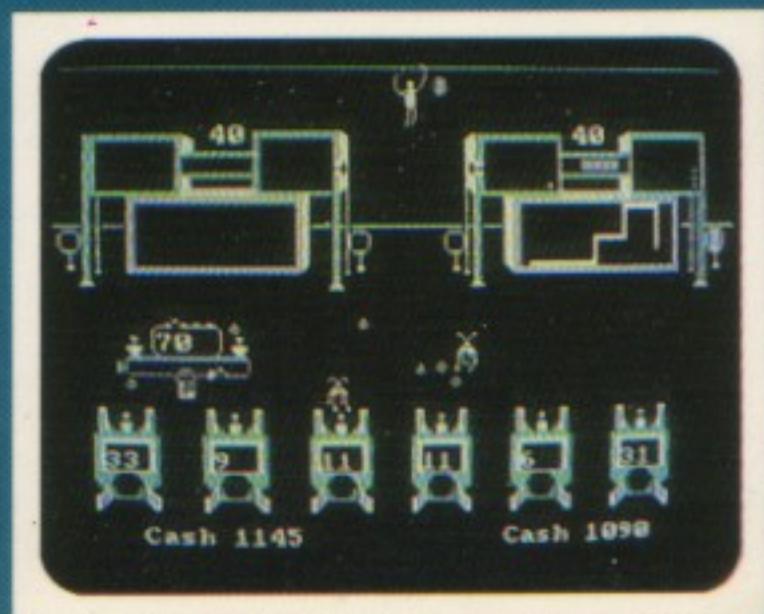

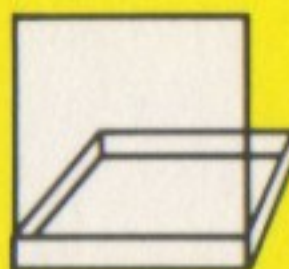

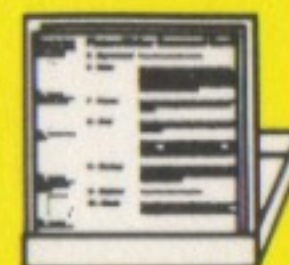
1. Remove contents from box and place aside.



2. Fold lid of box back.



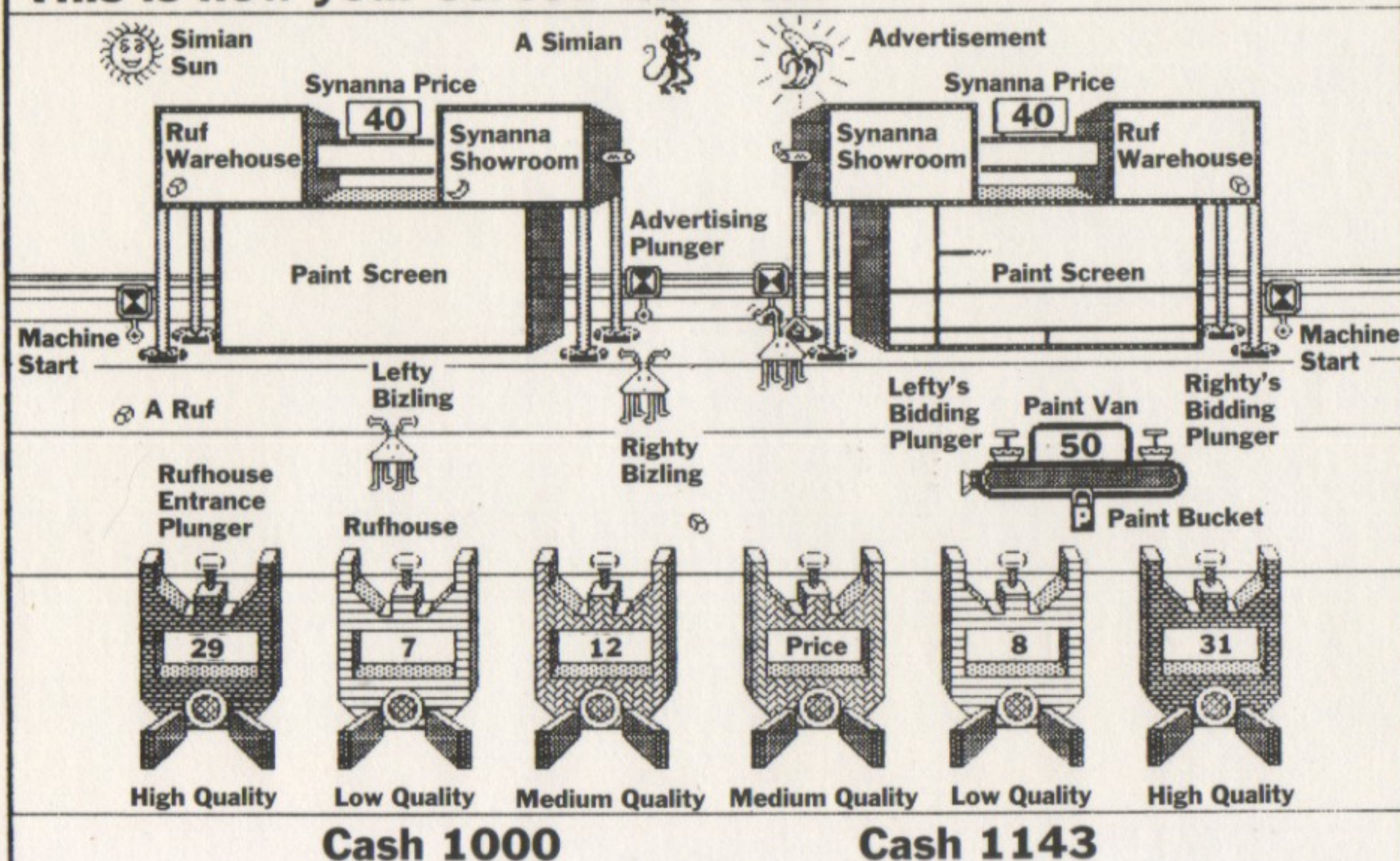
3. Fold this command card so it fits into easel pocket.



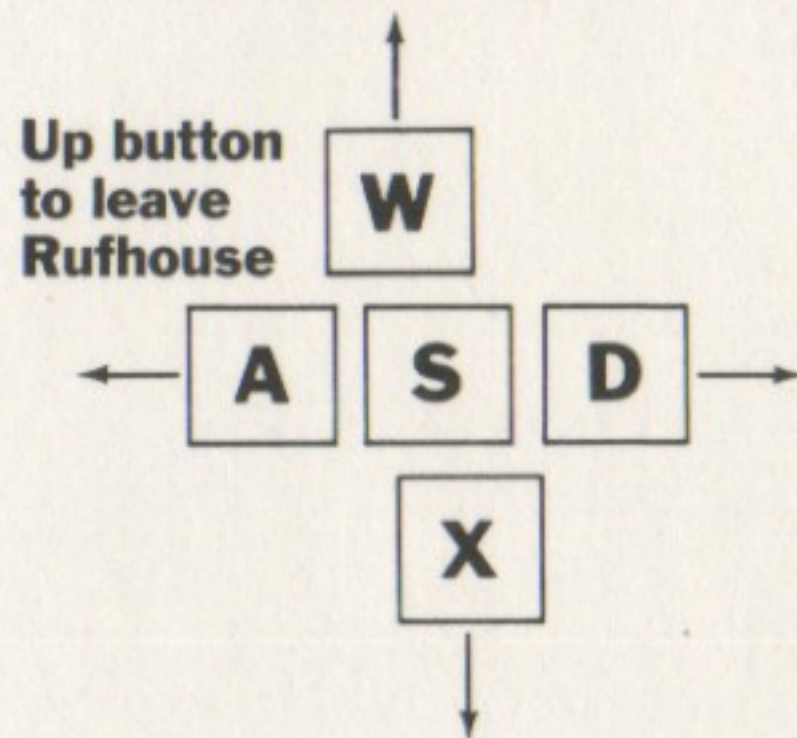
4. Place card or manual in pocket.

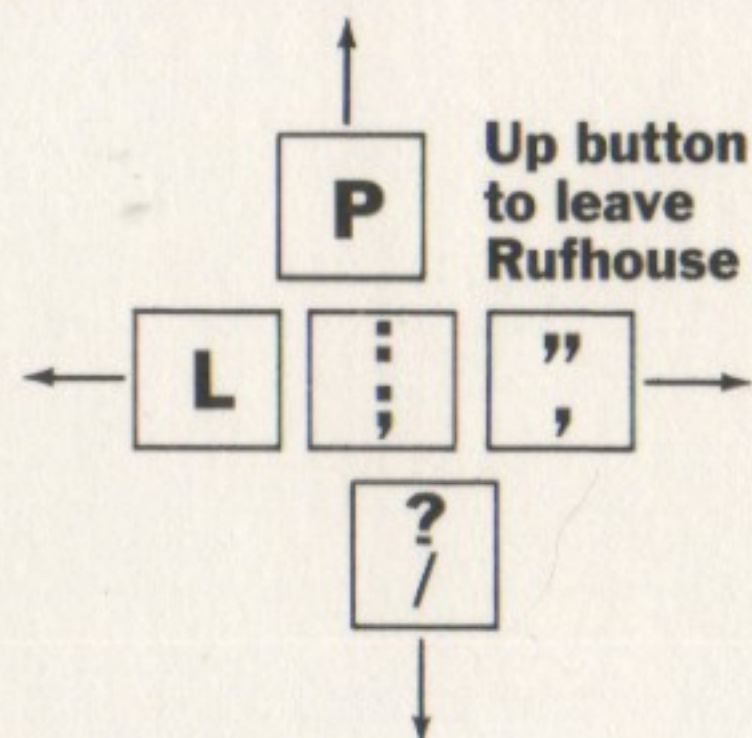

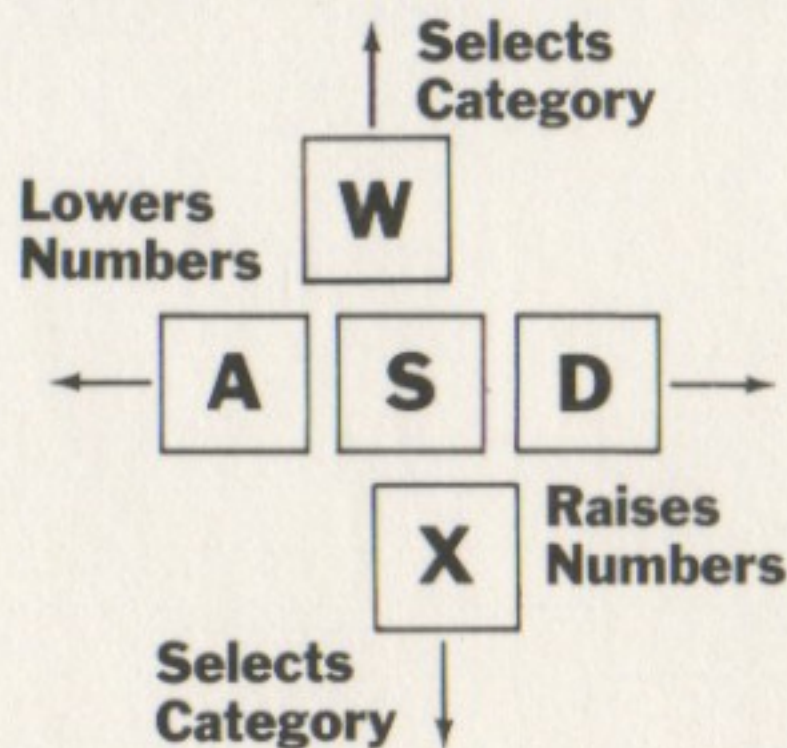
S and **:** are Plunger Buttons

What If Machine and Price Setting



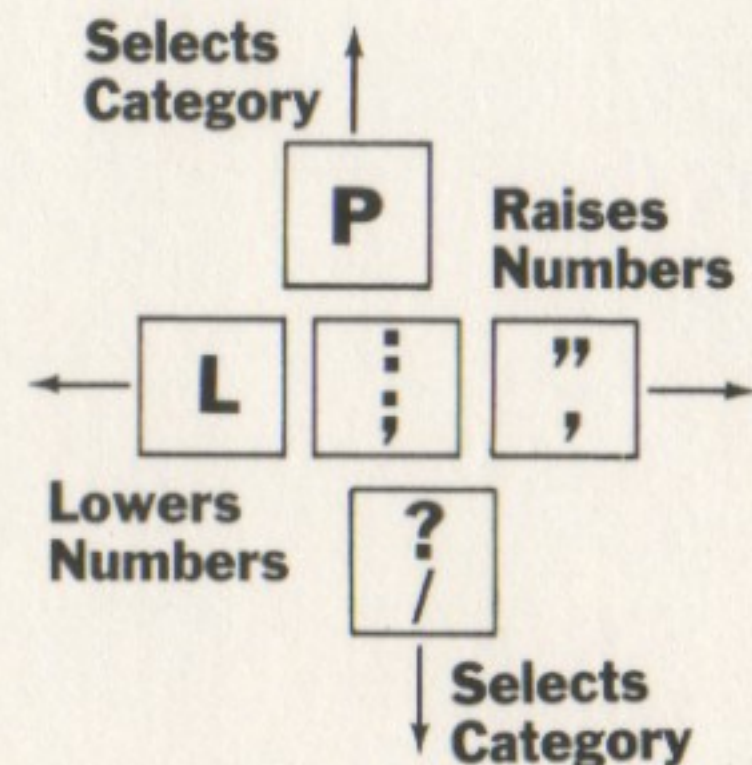
S **:**

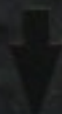
