

### Installing the Software from the Windows 3.1 Program Manager

1. Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive according to the drive manufacturer's instructions.
2. Choose Run from the File menu.
3. Type d:\setup.exe, where d: is your CD-ROM drive.
4. Click OK.
5. Follow directions in the Setup dialog boxes to complete the installation.

### Installing the Software from the Windows 95 Desktop

1. Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive according to the drive manufacturer's instructions.
2. Choose Run from the Start menu.
3. Type d:\setup, where d: is your CD-ROM drive.
4. Click OK.
5. Follow directions in the Setup dialog boxes to complete the installation.

- At least 8 Mbytes of installed RAM (5,000K free)
- A 13-inch (640×480) or larger color monitor
- A double-speed CD-ROM drive
- System 7

## SETTING UP — MAC OS

These instructions assume a basic familiarity with Macintosh interface conventions. If you're just getting started with your computer, and find the operations described below confusing, please refer to the documentation that came with your computer.

To install this title, follow these steps:

1. Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive according to the drive manufacturer's instructions.
2. Drag the *Starry Night* icon from the CD to your hard disk.
3. Open the System Extensions folder on the CD to show the extensions necessary or recommended for use with this title.
4. If you don't already have these extensions installed, or are unsure, drag the appropriate icons one-by-one to your System Folder icon and

drop them in. Your computer will guide you through the rest of the installation. If you install any extensions, restart your computer to make them active. If you have an older version of QuickTime already installed, you will need to manually delete this extension before installing the new version.

## SETTING UP — WINDOWS 3.1 AND WINDOWS 95

These instructions assume a basic familiarity with Windows 3.1 or Windows 95 interface conventions. If you're just getting started with your computer, and find the operations described below confusing, please refer to the documentation that came with your computer.

You can install the *Starry Night* software from the Windows 3.1 Program Manager or the Windows 95 Desktop. No matter which method you use, the installer will add a *Starry Night* icon to the Voyager-95A program group.
