

## “Sunday...that One Day”™

Welcome to the Adventures of Andrea and Alexander. You and your child will have hours of wholesome fun as you explore the interactive world of Millcreek Cove where characters and objects spring to life with a click of the mouse.

### Getting Started


#### Windows

To Install in Windows:

- 1 Insert the CD-ROM disc (printed side up) into your CD-ROM drive.
- 2 Choose Run from the File menu.
- 3 Type D:\SETUP in the text box. (Be sure to substitute the appropriate letter designation of your CD-ROM drive.)
- 4 Follow the instructions that appear during installation. An icon for “Sunday . . . that One Day” will be created in a new group called “Andrea and Alexander.”  
To play, double-click the “Sunday . . . that One Day” icon and the fun will begin.

#### Macintosh

- 1 Insert the CD-ROM disc into your CD-ROM drive (printed side up). An icon labeled “Sunday . . . that One Day CD” will appear on the desktop.
- 2 Open the “Sunday . . . that One Day CD” volume.
- 3 Double-click the icon labeled “Sunday . . . that One Day” to begin playing.



When you choose READ, your pointer will disappear and the story will begin. The story will continue screen by screen to the end. When the story ends, your pointer will reappear and you will have the option to start over or quit. (Hint: Press Esc anytime to interrupt the story.)



Clicking on PLAY lets you read and explore each screen one at a time. Use the mouse to click on different items and watch them come to life. Look carefully! There are many surprises on each screen. For example, try clicking on the corner of Annie's bedspread.




To move from one screen to the next in “Play” mode and on the Options screen, click the forward or the backward carrot arrows.

To return to the Main Menu in “Play” mode, click on the lettuce, at the bottom center of the screen.



Choosing OPTIONS takes you to the Options screen. Click the carrot arrows to cycle the screens and display the screen you want to go to. Then click OK to go to that screen in "Play" mode. Or, click Return to go back to the Main Menu.



## Technical Notes

### Shortcut Keys

Esc will take you to the Quit screen from any screen in the story. The Quit screen gives you the option to begin again. Ctrl-Q (Command-Q for Macintosh) will exit the program.

### System Requirements

Windows: MPC or 100% compatible, 386sx processor (486 recommended), 4 MB RAM (8 MB recommended), SVGA color monitor (640 x 480 256 color), Windows 3.1, MPC compliant double-speed CD-ROM drive, Sound Blaster or 100% compatible sound card, speakers or headphones.

Macintosh: 68030 or better, or Power PC, double-speed CD-ROM drive, 5 MB RAM (6 MB recommended), 640 x 480 256 color monitor System 7.

### Performance

Performance will vary depending on your particular computer. If the story runs slowly, you may find it helpful to close other applications. Macintosh users may also find it helpful to disable some Control Panels and Extensions to free up additional memory.

### Screen Savers

Screen savers may interrupt the story. Be sure to disable your screen saver software before beginning the story.

Caution: If you use headphones or amplified speakers, please check the sound levels before beginning the story to avoid doing any damage to your ears or audio equipment.
