# Discis Books™ QUICK START MANUAL

## INTRODUCTION

Use these "bare bones" instructions to get a quick start with Discis Books. You probably won't require a more detailed manual, but if you would like one, please send \$2.00 to cover postage and handling along with your name and address and we will forward one to you.

The instructions below assume that you are already familiar with Macintosh computers and CD-ROM drives.

- **Important:** For best results, Discis recommends that Discis Books be used with an 8 bit color board. If you have a 4 bit color board, the pictures will be displayed in black and white.

## FIVE STEPS TO GETTING STARTED

1. Turn on your CD-ROM drive.
  2. Start or re-start your Macintosh computer.
  3. Place the Discis Books' CD-ROM in the caddy.  
(If your CD-ROM drive does not use a caddy, refer to the drive's manual).
  4. Insert the caddy in the CD-ROM drive.  
Place the shutter end in first, with the disc label facing up. A window will open showing the contents of the disc.  
(If you need further assistance, refer to the drive's manual.)
  5. Open the Discis Books application.  
To do this, click the "application" icon and choose "open" from the file menu. Double-clicking the icon will also open it. The Discis Book on the CD-ROM will open automatically.
- **Important:** The "Customize" menu will allow you to individualize the book for each reader. If you wish to "hide" the customize menu after you have chosen the defaults, hold down the command key and press delete. With the menu hidden, young readers cannot get into the menu and change the settings. The "Customize" menu will reappear when "command" and "delete" are pressed.

## TWO BASIC PRINCIPLES

Using a Discis Book is easy; there are just two basic principles:

1. You can click on words, pictures, page corners and sentence speakers to make something happen.
2. You can also double-click, or press and hold specific parts of a book to make different things happen.

## ADJUST THE VOLUME

A volume box appears automatically to enable you to adjust the volume of the Book at any time.

1. Click "Test" to hear the current sound level.
2. Click the Volume knob and drag it up or down to increase or decrease the volume.
3. Click "OK" to close the Volume box.

You can interrupt the sound at any time by clicking in the margin at the left of the text.

## HELP

If you do not click the mouse, you will hear the voice of "Help" introducing you to Discis Books. Help will tell you everything you need to know to start using Discis Books.

Go ahead and experiment - just point to anything on the screen and Help will tell you about it. Or, you can turn help off and explore the book on your own. **With Discis Books, you have nothing to fear because you can't break anything or lose the information.**

•Help appears in the menu bar as a question mark (?) To turn Help on, choose "Turn Help On" from the Help menu.

Now it's time to take part in the incredible experience of Discis Books. Enjoy!
