

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## **Installation Instructions**

### **PC Installation**

1. Turn off all virus-protection programs.
2. Insert the CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive. The Take-Home Tutor runs directly from the CD except for some basic software that will be installed on the your PC. AutoRun automatically runs the installer. If AutoRun is disabled, double-click on the My Computer icon. Then, double-click on the CD-ROM icon, then double click on the Setup icon.
3. Once the installation is complete, click on "Yes" if you want to start the program, or click on "No" if you do not want to start the program.
4. To play: A folder titled "Take-Home Tutor 1" was created in the Start menu that contains a folder named after the CD-ROM title. In this folder, you will find the program icon and an Uninstall icon. Click on the program icon to launch.
5. Turn on all virus-protection programs.

### **To Uninstall**

Go to the "Take-Home Tutor 1", folder in the Start menu, locate the folder with the CD-ROM title, and click on the Uninstall icon. You can choose an automatic or custom uninstall.

## Mac installation

1. Turn off all virus-protection programs.
2. Insert the CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive. The Take-Home Tutor runs directly from the CD except for some basic software that will be installed on the your Mac. AutoRun automatically runs the installer. If AutoRun is disabled, double-click on "Install" to install the CD onto your hard drive. Make sure the "install location" is the name of your hard drive.
3. Once the installation is complete, click on "Yes" if you want to start the program, or click on "No" if you do not want to start the program.
4. To play: Double-click on the program name icon on your desktop.
5. Turn on all virus-protection programs.

## To Uninstall

Open your hard drive to "Applications." Drag the folder titled "Take-Home Tutor 1" into the trash. Drag the program name icon on the desktop into the trash.

## About This Program

The *¡En español!* Take-Home Tutor is a comprehensive interactive tutor for individual study that supplements the *¡En español!* program. It enables you to improve your Spanish by having a tutor by your side.

The Take-Home Tutor helps you focus on specific activities for each *Etap*a. It provides leveled practice, A (Basic), B (Average) or C (Challenge), allowing you to progress at your comfort level and improve your performance at your own pace.

At any time in the program, you have access to an interactive audio glossary, animated grammar explanations, verb charts and McDougal Littell's website, Classzone.com. At any point during the program, you can receive a session report to track your performance. Each *Etap*a component contains the following sections:

### **En contexto**

*En contexto* uses video to improve your comprehension skills and vocabulary activities to reinforce your new words.

*Video* In the video section, you can view short video clips with a running script of the text. Each clip is followed by an activity.

*Activities* You can review the new vocabulary you've learned with multiple choice and fill-in-the-blank activities. If an image is required to complete an activity, you can click on the magnifying glass to enlarge the image.

### **En vivo**

*En vivo* uses video dialogs with follow-up questions to develop your listening and speaking skills. You can read and record the script, then compare your Spanish pronunciation to the video.

## Grammar

These activities focus on each unit's grammar points, progressing from close to open-ended activities. Some grammar activities are instantly scored. Open-ended activities allow you to personalize your answers. Remember, if you want to review any grammar concept, click on the Grammar Explanations button at the bottom of the screen.

## Vocabulary

The Vocabulary section offers you two different ways to practice your vocabulary:

*Flashcards* You can practice your vocabulary with the interactive flashcards. Each *Etap*a has approximately 50 audio flashcards that you can use to practice and hear new words. Remember, you always have access to the Glossary at the bottom of your screen.

*Activities* Here, you have numerous types of vocabulary practice that range from matching to fill-in-the-blank activities. If there is an image-based activity, use the magnifying glass icon to enlarge the image.

## Listening

You can strengthen your comprehension by listening to short Spanish audio segments and answering follow-up questions.

## Reading

You will read passages or review images to answer follow-up questions. You can check your answers against sample responses. Remember, if an image is required to complete the exercise, click on the magnifying glass icon to enlarge the image.

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
